PASO ROBLES, CALIFORNIA

REGION/VINTAGE NOTES

Harvested primarily from our Riboli Creston Vineyard, our 2023 Highlands 41 Cabernet Sauvignon is the truest expression of Paso Robles appellation. This remarkable site, set along the rolling hills of the northeastern Creston District AVA, features steep terrain and soils formed from calcareous marine deposits, still visible through the fossilized shells scattered across the property. These naturally low vigor soils, combined with the cooling maritime breezes that flow through the Templeton Gap, have helped establish the Creston District as a highly regarded sub-appellation for Bordeaux varietals. The 2023 growing season in Paso Robles was defined by abundant winter rainfall and a cooler spring, which led to an extended ripening. Moderate summer temperatures and a later harvest delivered fruit with excellent balance, vibrant acidity, and full varietal expression.

WINEMAKER/TASTING NOTES

Our 2023 Cabernet Sauvignon captures the bold character of Paso Robles' Creston District AVA. This full-bodied wine opens with a deep, inky hue and aromas of dark berries and black plum. Twelve months of oak aging add layers of spice and depth, while smooth tannins and balanced acidity create harmony on the palate. The finish is long and refined, leaving a lasting impression of richness and structure.

SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability is our top priority. Our Paso Robles and Monterey vineyards are certified sustainable by CSWA. At our certified sustainable Paso Robles winery, solar panels provide 100% of the needed electricity, and wastewater is effectively reclaimed and recycled for additional uses.

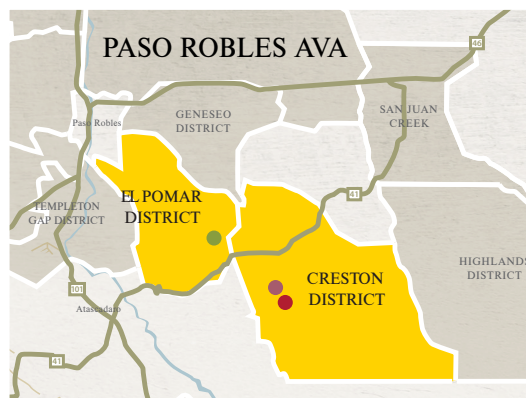
