Santo Signature Cuvee is a Prosecco from Veneto, within the small village of Valdobbiadene, the traditional home of prosecco. All of the grapes that go into Santo are chosen both through the vineyard and winery sorting process and are held to high standards. Warm sunny days and a steep slope allow them to fully ripen, creating beautiful structure and acidity. These wines were chosen for the Santo brand because of the terroir, which cultivates beautiful, complex, refined and sophisticated flavors and styles.

SIGNATURE CUVEE

VENETO, ITALY

The warm and humid Venetian plain is a vast, flat, and fertile area surrounding Venice. However, growing high-quality wine grapes requires less fertile soils to achieve more concentrated flavors. As a result, the best vineyards are situated on steeper slopes with poor soils, which concentrate the berries and produce more intense wines. All Prosecco Superiore DOCG vineyards are located on these slopes, and managing these vines is labor-intensive, requiring over 800 hours of manual work per hectare compared to just 200 hours on the Venetian plain.

All of the grapes that go into Santo Signature Cuvee are carefully chosen both through the vineyard and winery sorting process and are held to high standards. The wine is youthful and meant to drink among family and friends, often shared as an aperitivo or with dessert—due to its bright and light style.
