

2021 RIBOLI FAMILY NAPA VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON



Region/Vintage Notes

The Riboli family has cultivated vines in Napa Valley's renowned Rutherford AVA since 1986. Nestled along the Silverado Trail, this 17-acre estate vineyard is distinguished by Bale Series clay loam soils and a gentle slope. The 2021 growing season brought below-average rainfall, yielding a smaller crop of intensely flavored fruit. A warm, even summer and cool evenings extended the ripening period, concentrating flavors and tannins while maintaining balance and freshness. The vintage delivers wines of remarkable purity, structure, and depth.

Winemaker/Tasting Notes

The 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon was fermented to dryness and matured for 22 months in 100% new French oak barrels from the esteemed cooperages Marques, Berger, Orion, and Remond. It opens with layered aromas and flavors of blackberry, blueberry and cassis, accented by delicate hints of cedar. On the palate, firm yet refined tannins provide structure, leading to a long, elegant finish. True to its Rutherford origins, the wine carries the hallmark "Rutherford dust" character and is crafted for both early enjoyment and long-term cellaring.

Sustainability is a top priority at Riboli Family Wines. Our Napa Valley vineyard is certified sustainable by the rigorous California Sustainable Wine Alliance (CSWA).

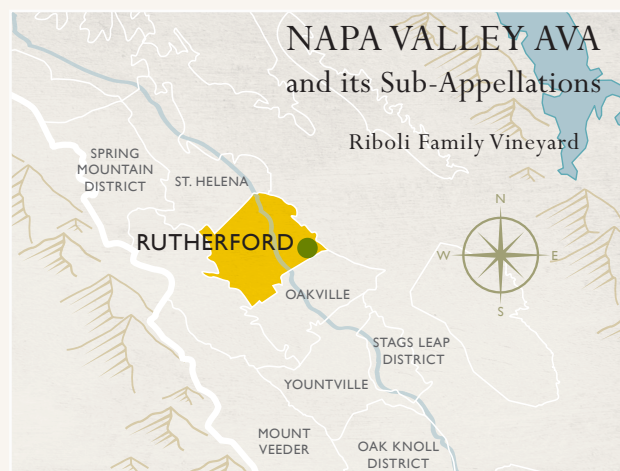
