Step 1

Please inspect table tops and playing surface before putting the game together.

Remove all the contents from inside the carton and verify that you have all listed parts as shown on the part list.

NOTE: Parts are packed inside the table cabinet. Remove the billiards playfield **P23** from Main Cabinet **P1**.

Inside the table cabinet you will find all the parts needed to assemble your table.

Attach the Plastic Pivot Bolts **H11** to the Plastic Pivot Nuts **C5** to each end of Main Cabinet.

Hand tighten the Plastic Pivot Bolts **H11**.

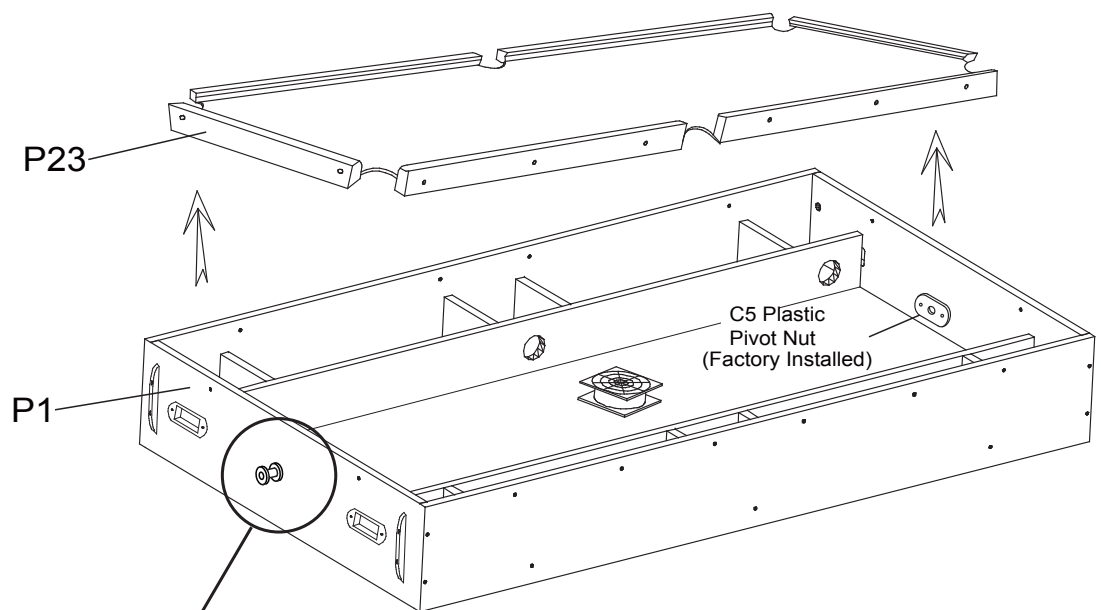
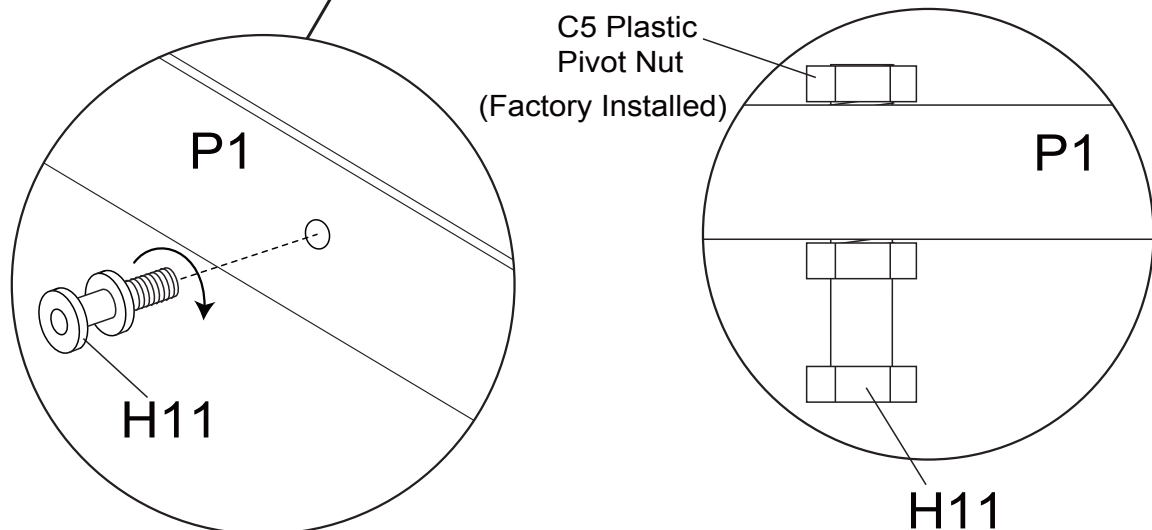

PARTS REQUIRED:

12 pcs - **H13** 3 x 14mm Phillips Round Head Screw
16 pcs - **H12** 3.5 x 28mm Phillips Round Head Screw

2 pcs - **P24** Corner Pocket Shield
4 pcs - **P25** Side Pocket Shield

Step 2 Before Starting Step 3, Double Check That All Loose Table Components Are Removed From The Air Hockey Table Cabinet.

When all the parts are out of the Air Hockey Table Cabinet **P1**, replace the Billiards Playfield **C**.

Attach the Billiards Playfield **P23** by using screws **H12**.

Tighten, but do not strip out Screws H12

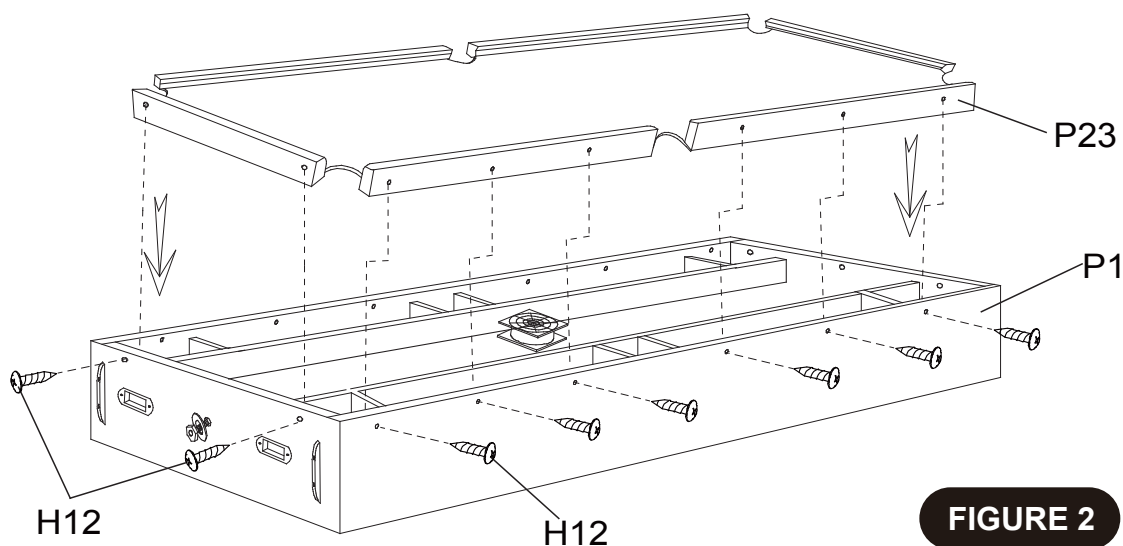

Step 3

Insert Corner Pockets Shields **P24** and Side Pocket Shields **P25** into the the cabinet pockets using Screws **H13**.

Tighten, but do not strip out Screws H13

NOTE: Carefully pull and hold each Pocket Shield tight into the pocket for correct screw installation.

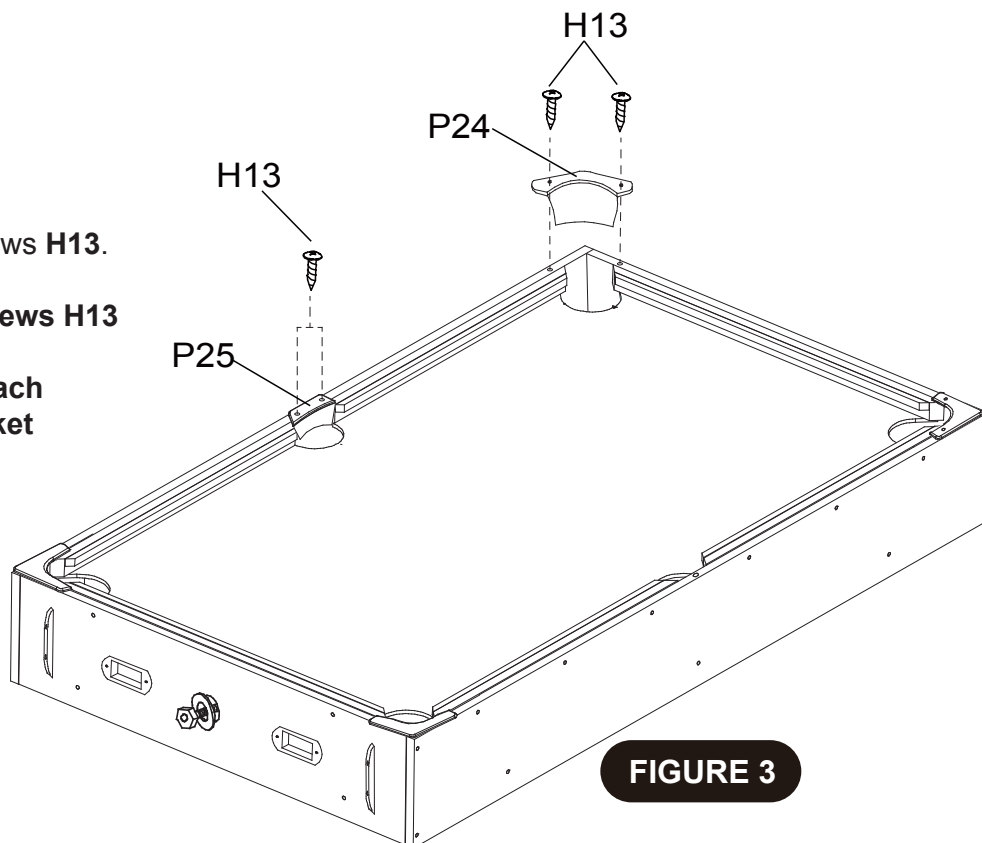


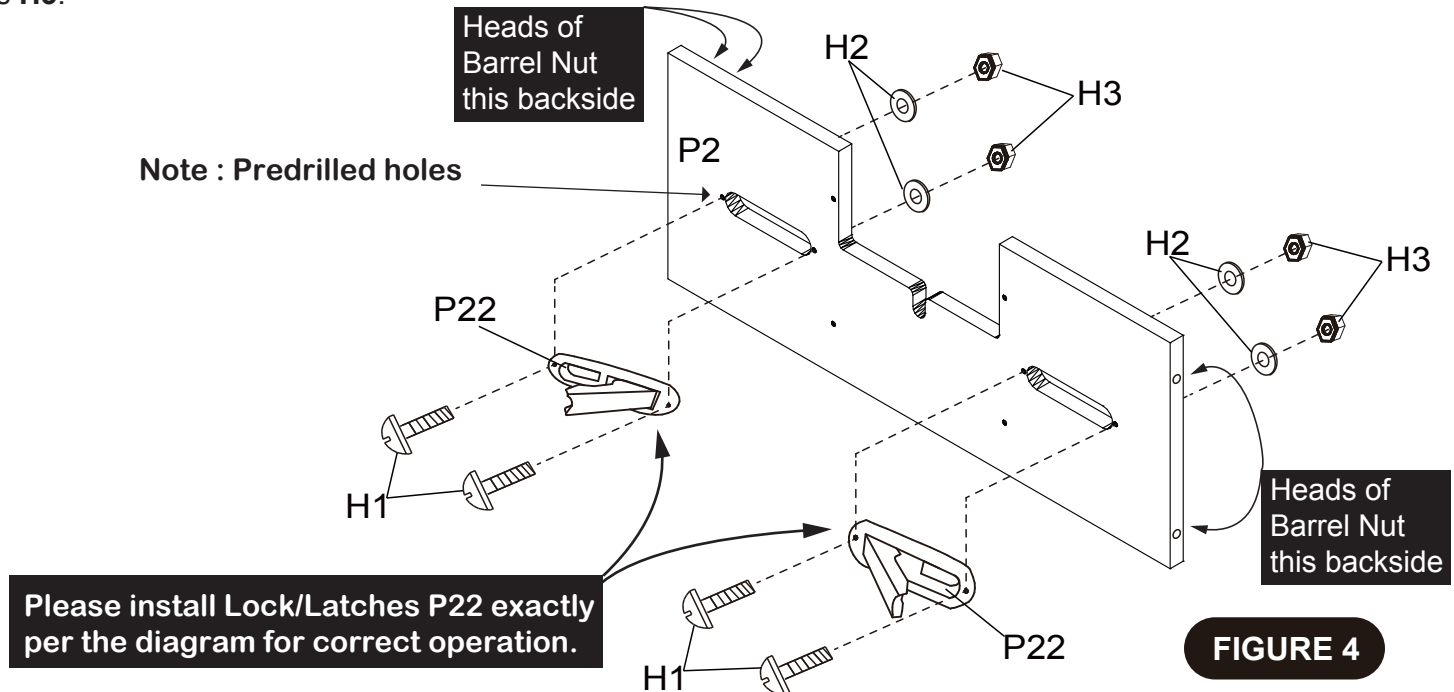

Step 4 (Build 2 Identical Assemblies)

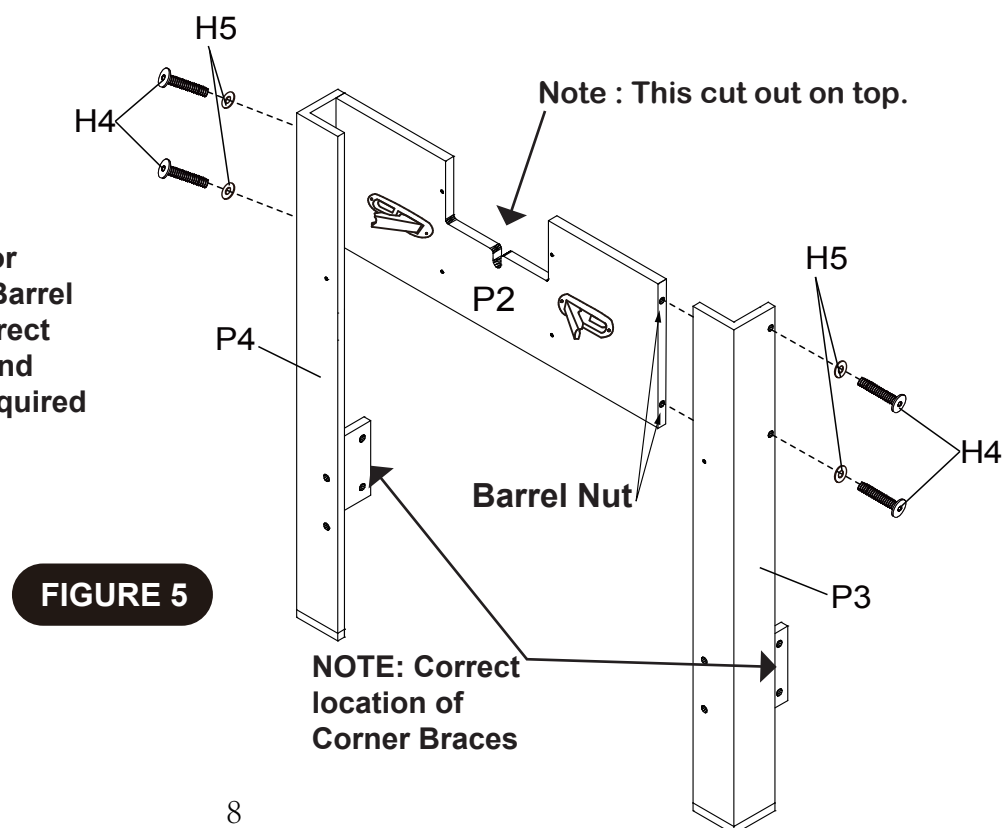
Attach 2 pieces Lock / Latches **P22** into the cut outs on Leg Top End Apron **P2** with Bolts **H1**, Washer **H2** and Nuts **H3**.



Step 5 (Build 2 Identical Assemblies)

Attach the Right legs **P3** and Left Legs **P4** to the Leg Top End Apron **P2** by inserting Bolts **H4** with washers **H5** into the predrilled holes of the leg and into the Barrel Nuts, then tighten, but DO NOT over tighten.

NOTE: Study diagram closely for correct assembly. Check each Barrel Nut with a Bolt H4 to insure correct alignment between Barrel Nut and Bolt H4. Adjust Barrel Nut as required using a screwdriver.



PARTS REQUIRED:

2 pcs - **P9** Ball Storage Board-Lower

2 pcs - **P10** Goal Box

4 pcs - **P20** Leg Leveler

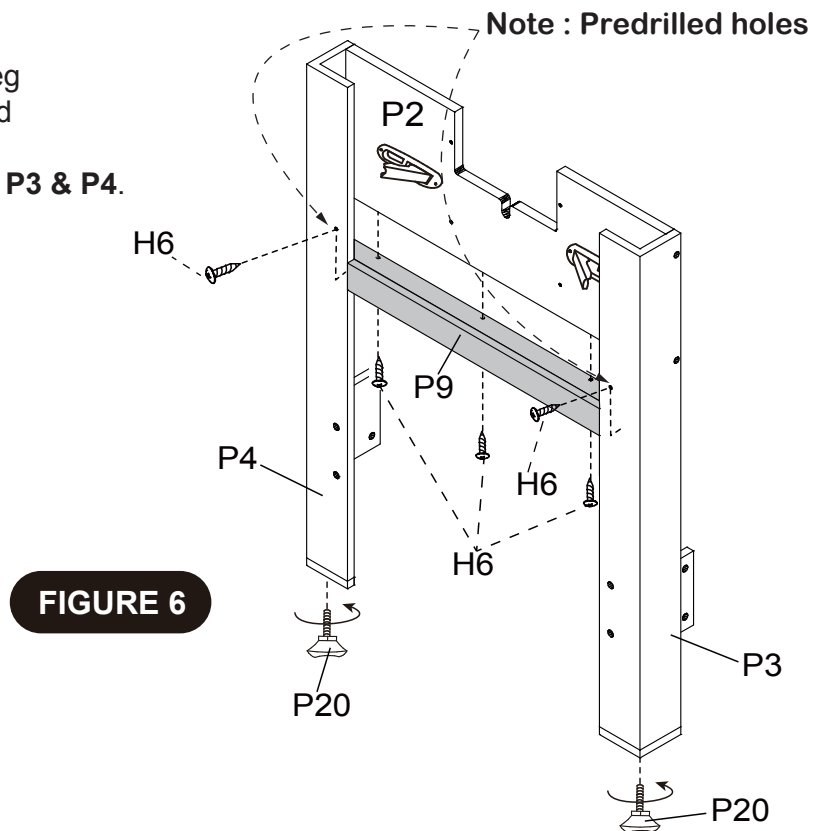
18 pcs - **H6** 4 x 40mm Phillips Round Head Screw

Step 6 (Build 2 Identical Assemblies)

Screw the Ball Storage Board-Lower **P9** to the Leg Top End Apron **P2** using screws **H6** into predrilled holes.

Install leg levelers **P20** to the bottom of each Leg **P3** & **P4**.

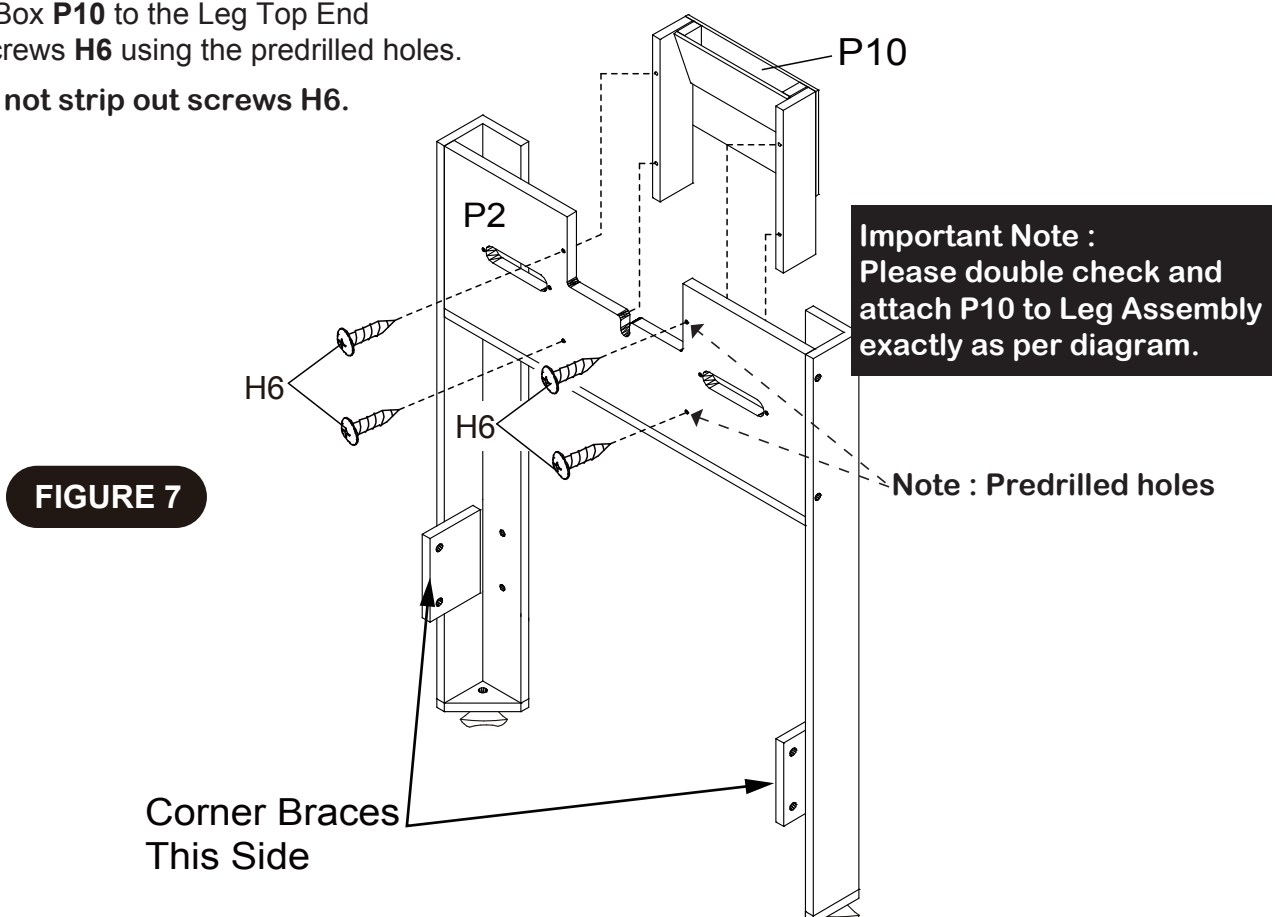
Tighten, but do not strip out screws **H6**.



Step 7 (Build 2 Identical Assemblies)

Attach the Goal Box **P10** to the Leg Top End Apron **P2** with screws **H6** using the predrilled holes.

Tighten, but do not strip out screws **H6**.

2 pcs - **P5** Side Leg Panel

2 pcs - **P7** Center Frame Support

8 pcs - **H6** 4 x 40mm Phillips Round Head Screw

2 pcs - **P6** End Leg Panel

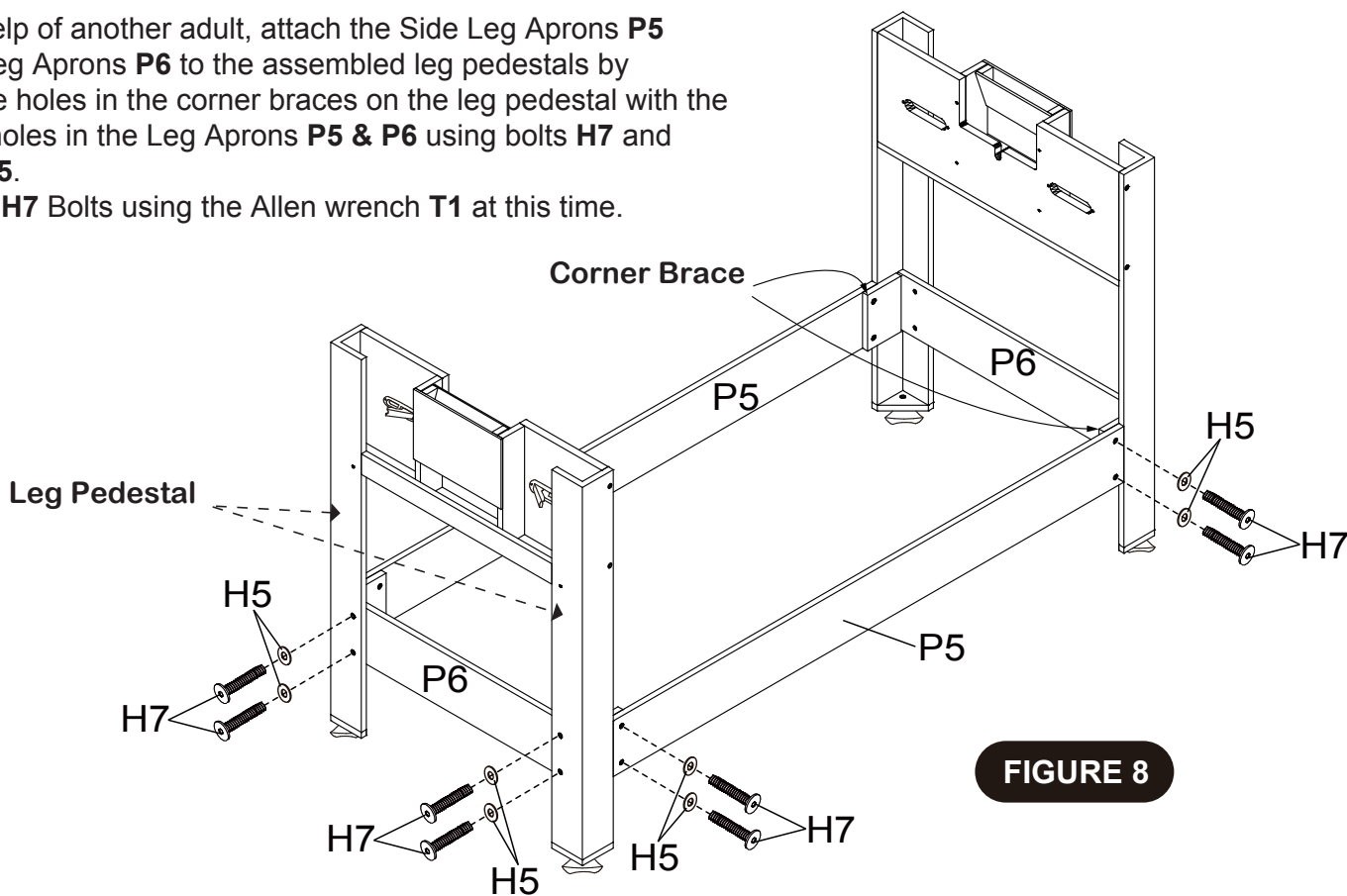

Step 8

With the help of another adult, attach the Side Leg Aprons **P5** and End Leg Aprons **P6** to the assembled leg pedestals by aligning the holes in the corner braces on the leg pedestal with the predrilled holes in the Leg Aprons **P5 & P6** using bolts **H7** and washers **H5**.

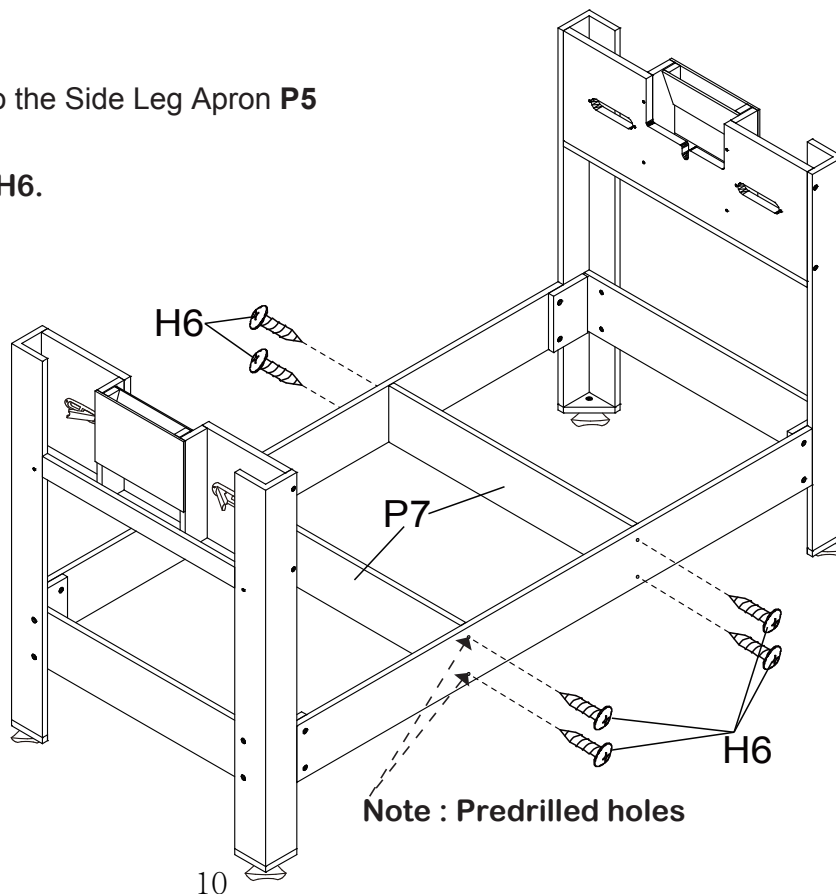
Tighten all **H7** Bolts using the Allen wrench **T1** at this time.



Step 9

Attach the Center Frame Supports **P7** to the Side Leg Apron **P5** using predrilled holes with Screws **H6**

Tighten, but do not strip out screws **H6**.

1 pc - **P1** Main Cabinet

4 pcs - **H8** 3.5 x 14mm Phillips Round Head Screw

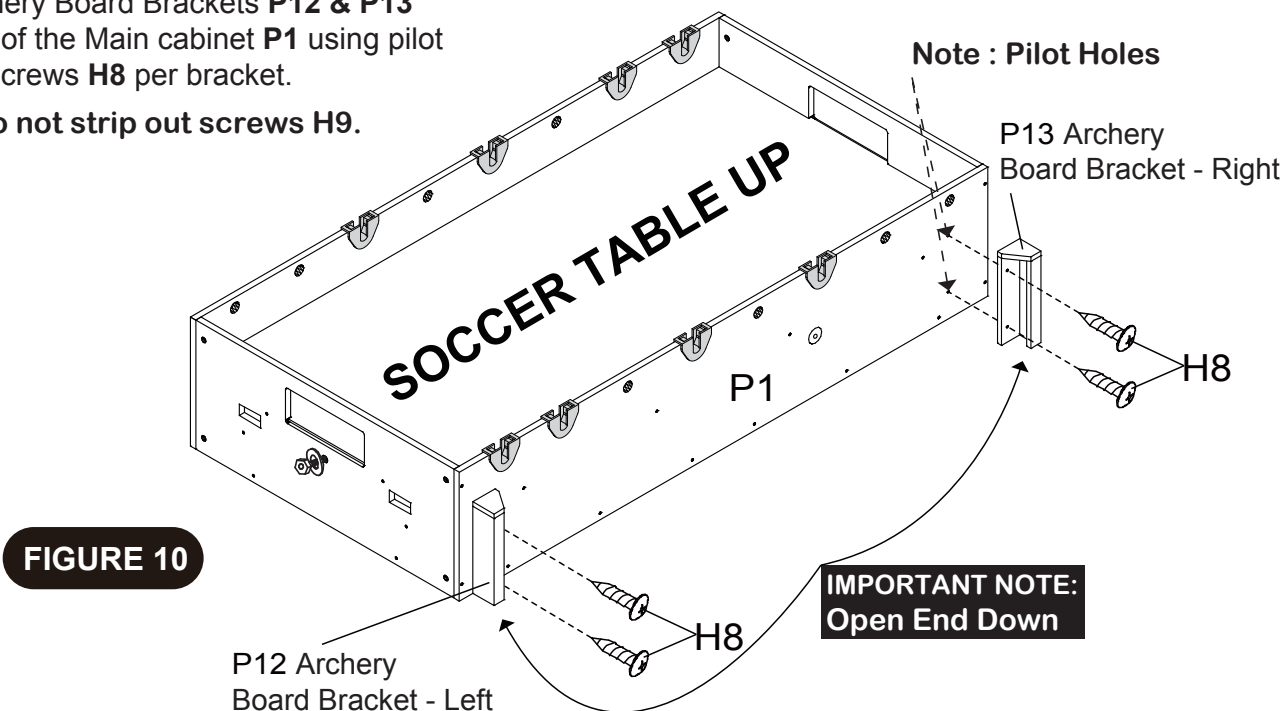

Step 10

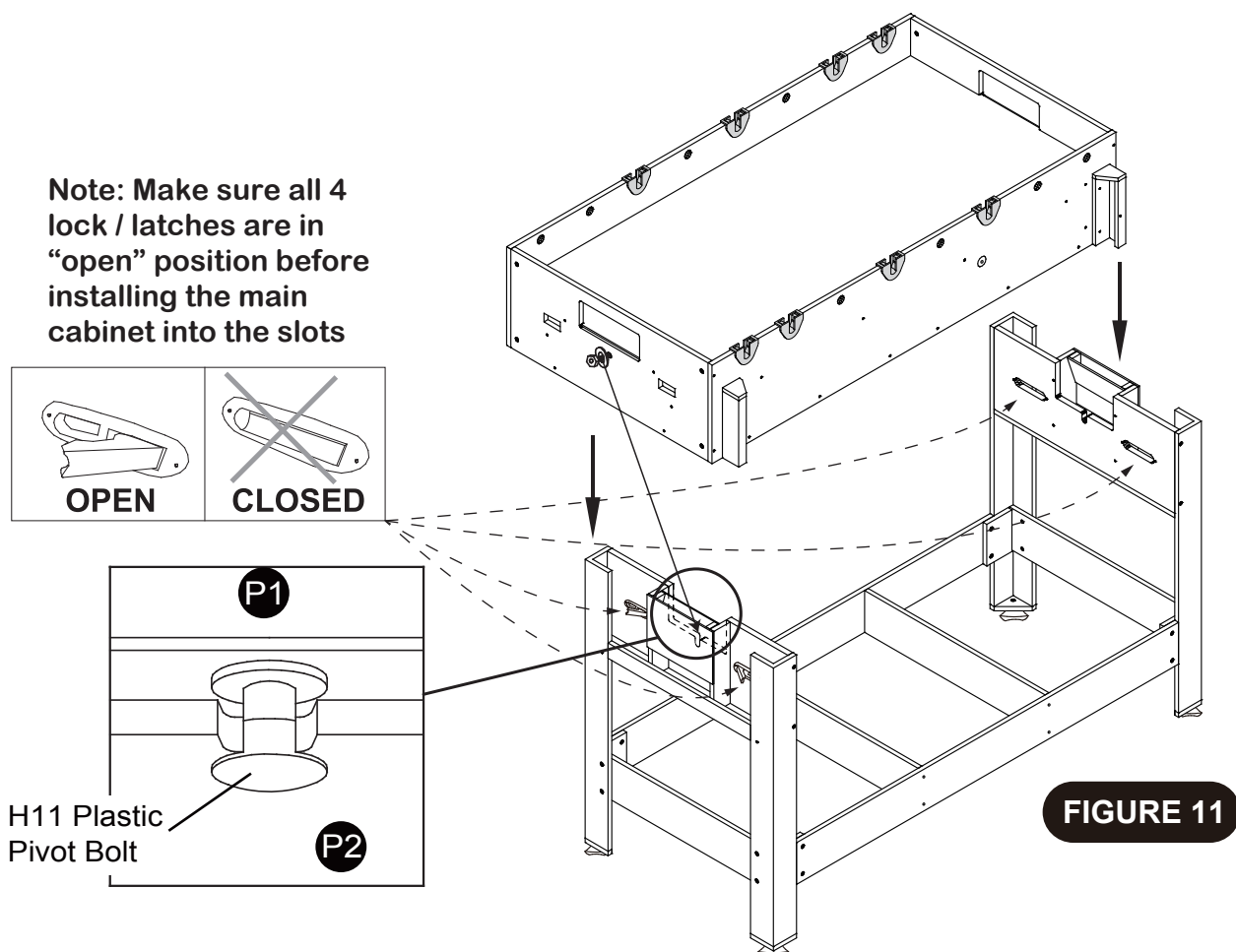
Secure the Archery Board Brackets **P12** & **P13** to the long side of the Main cabinet **P1** using pilot holes with two screws **H8** per bracket.

Tighten, but do not strip out screws **H9**.



Step 11

Attach the Main Cabinet **P1** by sliding the Plastic Pivot Bolts **H11**, already attached to the end's of the cabinet, into the 2 slots on each Leg Top End Apron **P2**. Make sure the plastic pivot bolts **H11** rests in the slots on each end of the Leg Top End Apron **P2**.

2 pcs - **P8** Top Side End Panel

2 pcs - **P21** Manual Scorer

1 pc - **A14** A/C Adapter

12 pcs - **H9** 3.5 x 35 mm Phillips Flat Head Screw

4 pcs - **H10** 3.5 x 25 mm Phillips Flat Head Screw

Step 12

Attach Top Side End Panels **P8** to the assembled leg pedestals by aligning the holes in the Top Side End Panels **P8** with the predrilled holes in the top of the Leg Top End Apron **P2**, and attach with screws **H9**.

Tighten, but do not strip out screws H9.

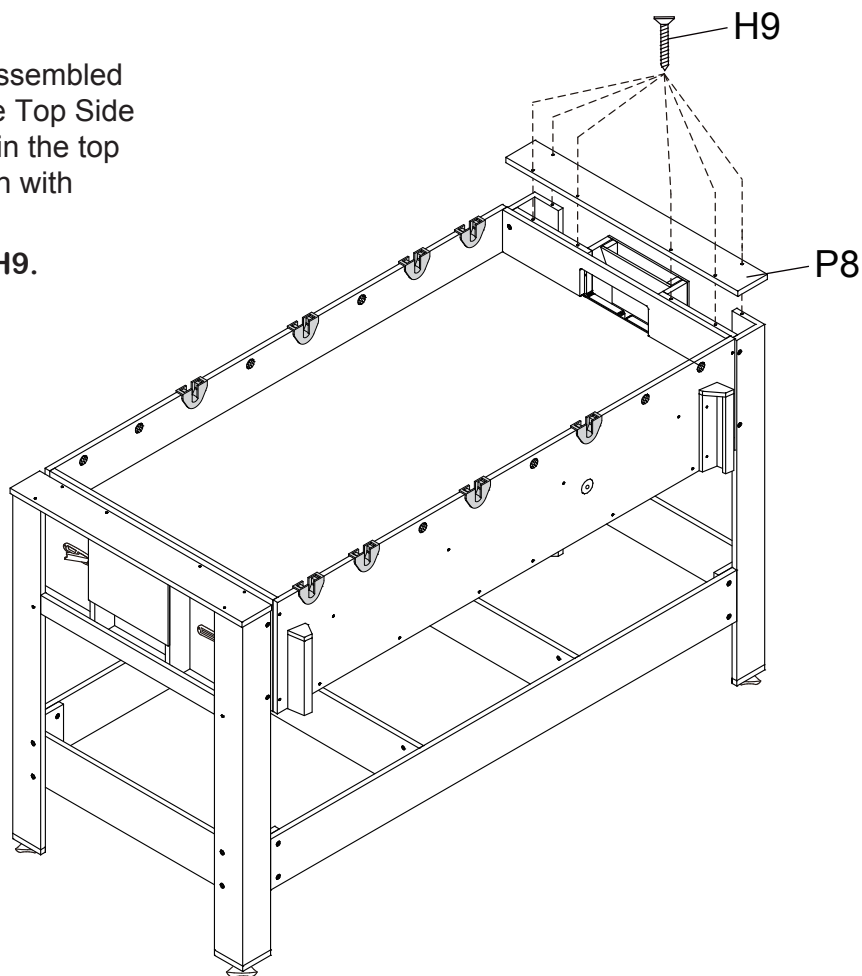

Step 13

Attach Manual Scorers **P21** to the Top Side End Panels **P8** using screws **H10**.

Tighten, but do not strip out screws H10.

Insert the male plug of A/C Adapter **A14** into the female plug of Air Motor on the Side Apron of the Main Cabinet **P1** to play Air Hockey or Air Soccer.

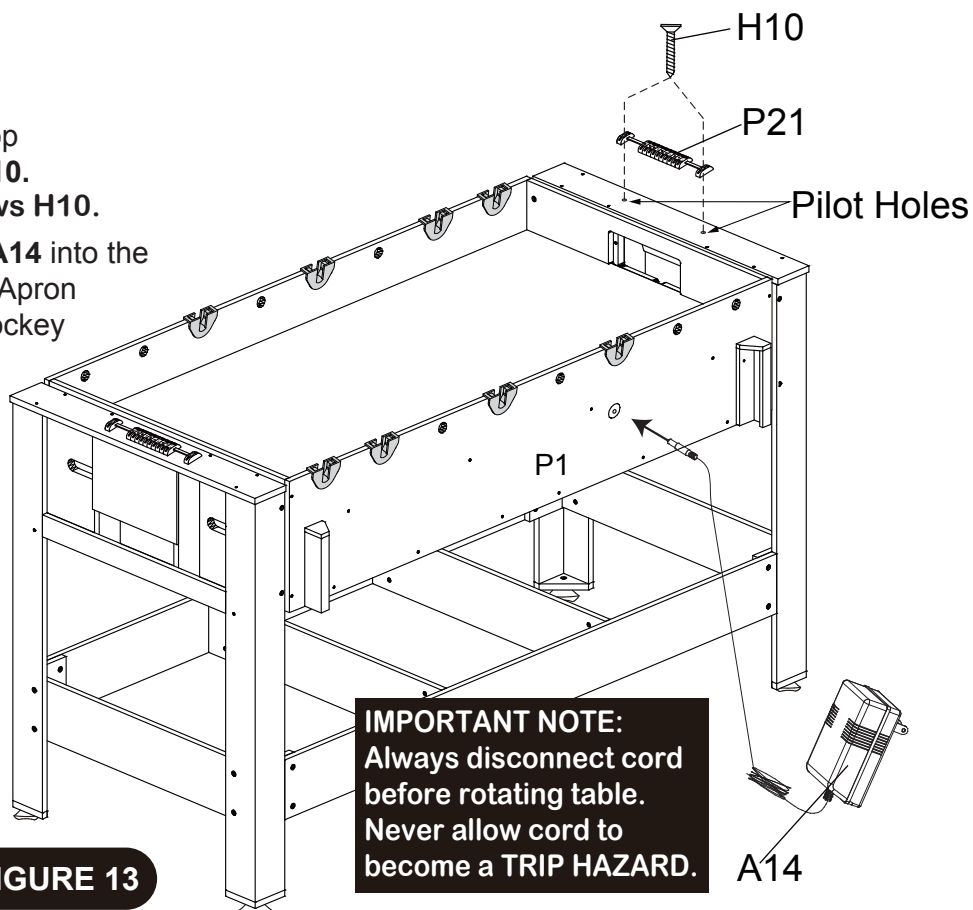

Step 14

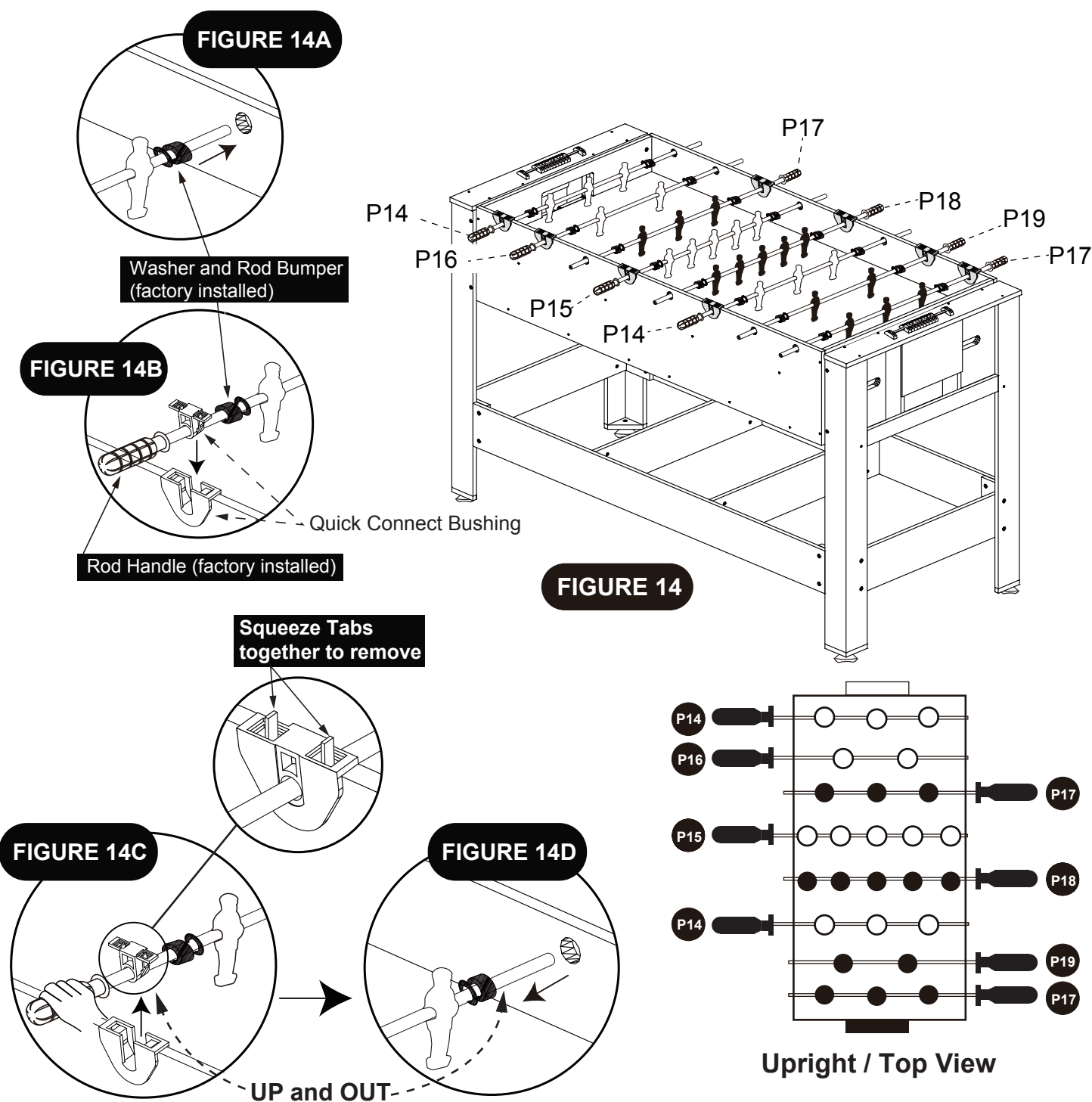
NOTE: STUDY DIAGRAM CLOSELY FOR CORRECT PLAYER PLACEMENT.

FIRST: Insert the Rod into the round bushing hole as shown in **FIGURE 11A**.

Second: Snap the male plug of the Quick Connect Bushing into the female bushing as shown in **FIGURE 11B**.

When you finish playing the Soccer Game, squeeze the taps of the Quick Connect Bushing and remove the Quick Connect Bushing by pulling up. Slide back the rod from the round bushing hole as shown in **FIGURE 11C and 11D**.

NOTE: There will be four handles on each side of the table. It is critical that you set the rods as shown below so the players will be correctly placed.

1 pc - **A1** Table Tennis Net

2 pcs - **A4** Table Tennis Net Post

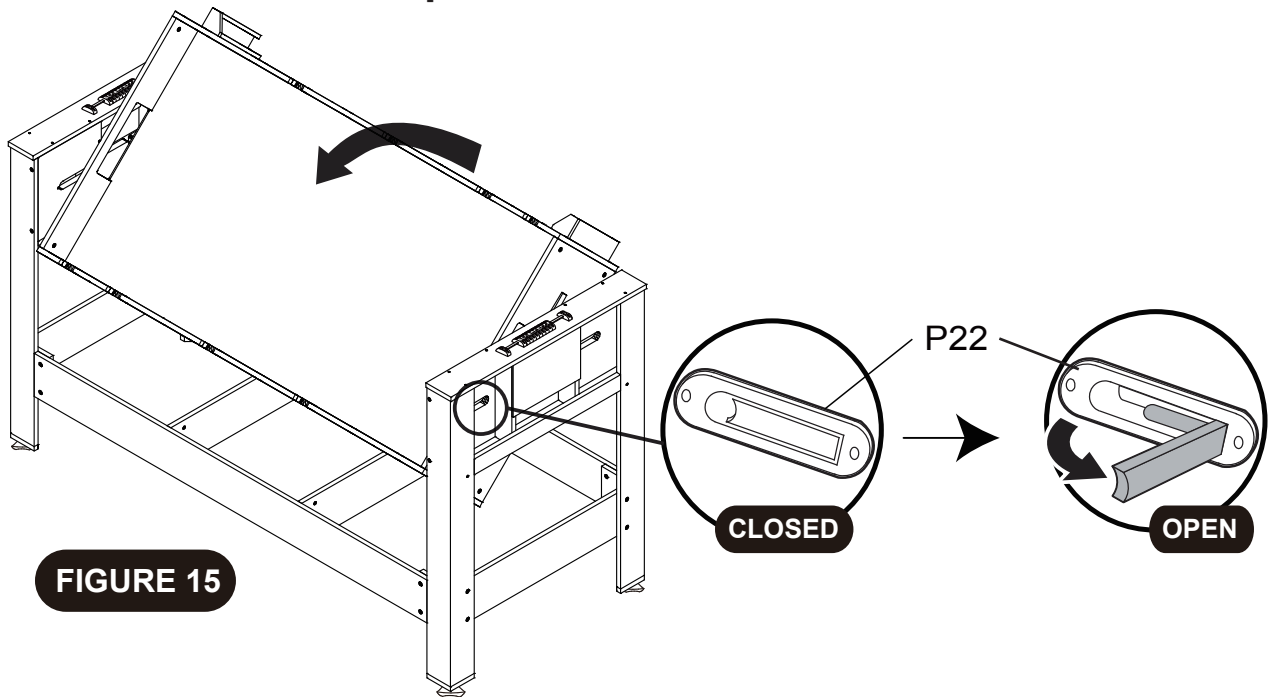
Step 15

Make sure all four Lock /Latches **P22** are in the “open” position.

With the help of the other adult, rotate the table and lock the 4 Lock /Latches **P22** to play the Billiards Game.

NOTE: All Soccer Rods must be removed before rotating the table.

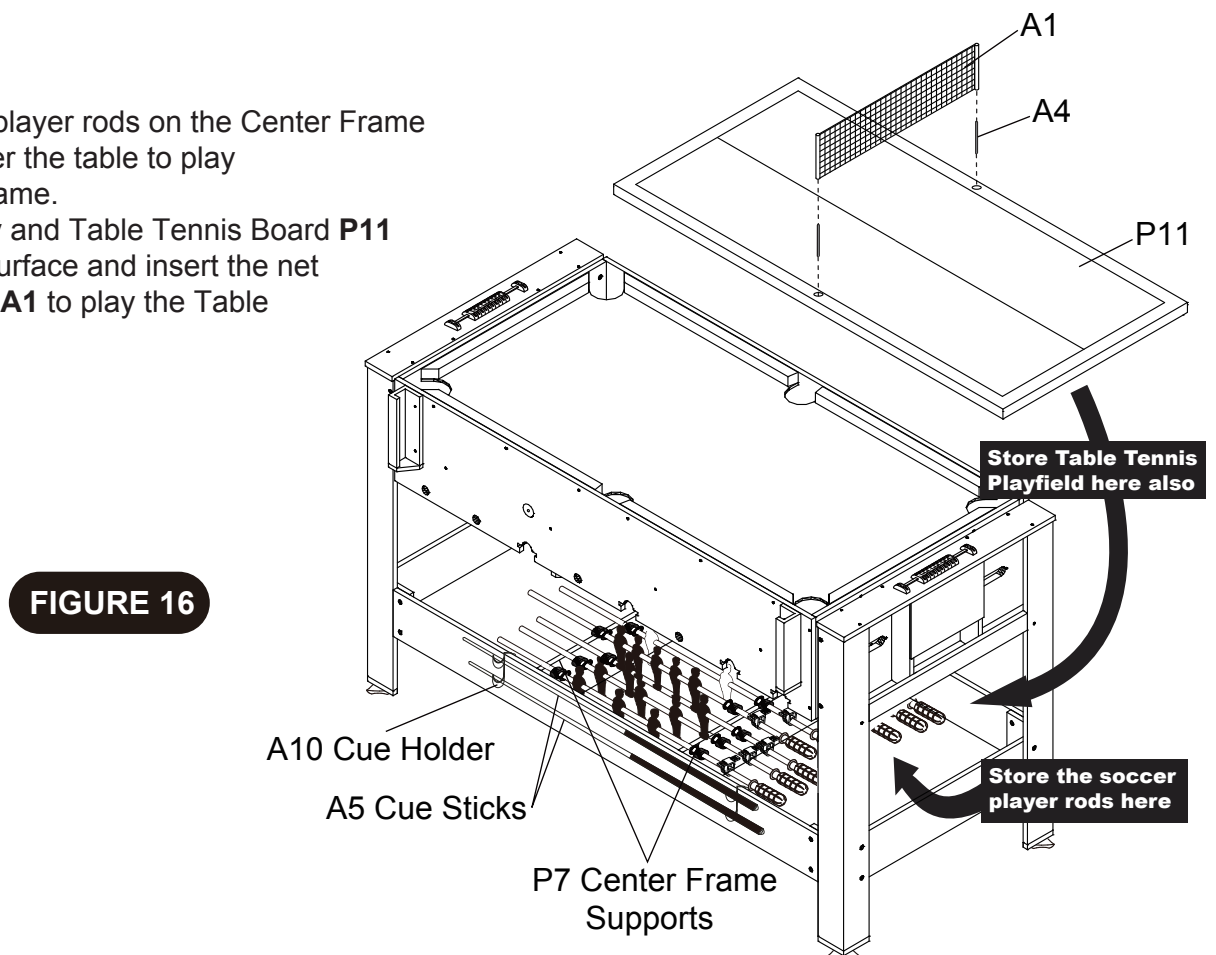
Also make sure A/C adapter cord is disconnected from the table.



Step 16

Store the soccer player rods on the Center Frame Supports **P7** under the table to play the Air Hockey Game.

Place the Archery and Table Tennis Board **P11** onto the Billiard surface and insert the net posts **A4** and net **A1** to play the Table Tennis Game.



Step 17

In order to achieve an open and safe shooting lane for archery, it is recommended to remove and store the soccer player rods as illustrated in **Step 16**.

Slide the Archery and Table Tennis Board **P11** into the Archery Board Brackets **P12 & P13**.

To play archery, players will take turns shooting 3 arrows at the targets per turn. The player with the most points after 3 rounds is the winner.

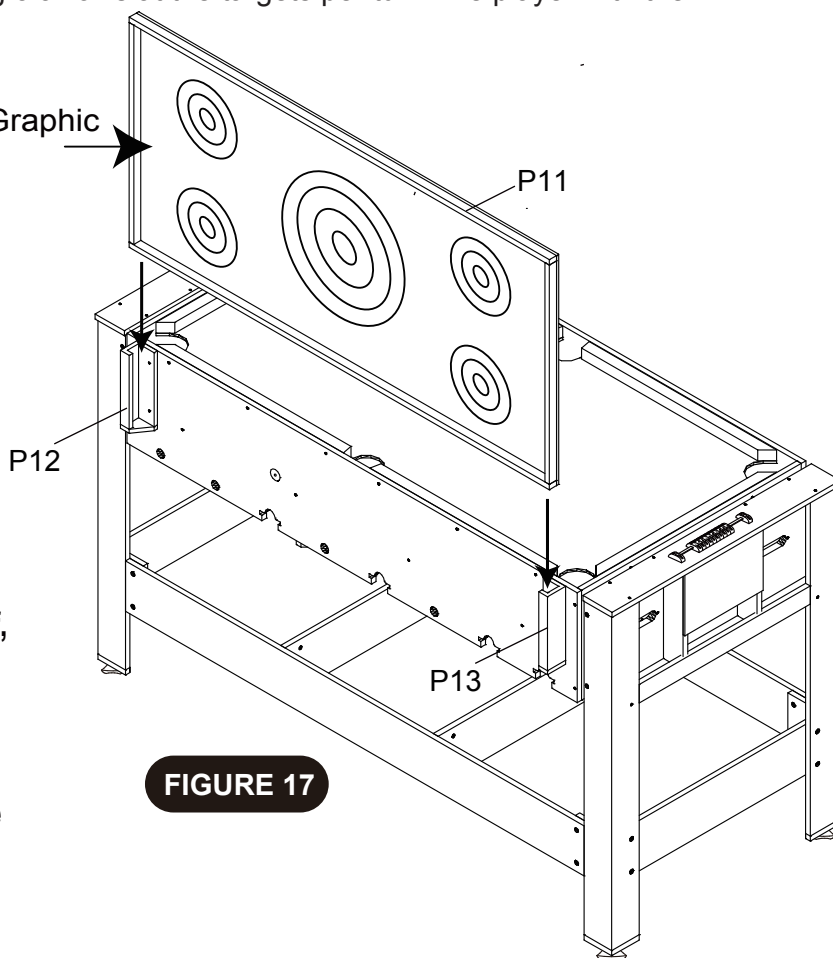

WARNING: Always make sure there are no other people or pets in the path or near surroundings when playing this game because the arrows could cause physical harm or injury.

Shooting arrows should only be at the target.

Adult supervision is highly recommended.

Should the suction cup on any arrow come off, or if the arrow in any way becomes damaged or broken, do not use this arrow and discard this arrow immediately.

NOTE: Slightly dampen the suction cup on the arrow to help make it "Stick".

BONUS AIRZONE SOCCER GAME:

Your 5 in 1 multi game table includes a new bonus game called "AirZone" Soccer.

A new exciting twist on the games of air hockey and foosball.

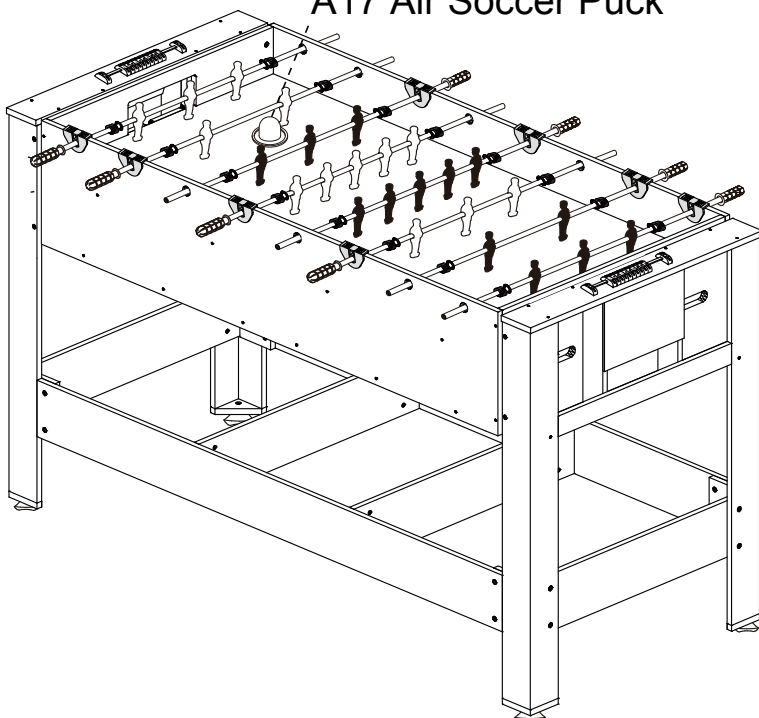
Using the included Air soccer puck (A17) you can now play Air rod soccer on the air hockey playfield.

The "AirZone" playfield provides a cushion of air for a new gaming experience.

The game rules are the same as traditional foosball.

Younger novice players may find this version of air soccer a little easier to play than foosball.

A17 Air Soccer Puck



AIR POWERED HOCKEY:

- 1.This game is designed to be played with two (2) players, one at each end.
- 2.Play begins when the puck is placed on the playing surface. Players must hit the puck with the hand-held pushers and attempt to shoot into the opponent's goal.
- 3.One point is given when a puck is shot into the opponent's goal.
- 4.Winning: the winning goal is accomplished by being the first player to reach a predetermined score or by being the player to score the most points within a given period.

SOCCER:

1. This game is intended for 2-4 players. Competing teams will be on opposite sides of the table from one another.
2. Players must use the player rods to maneuver the ball into your opponent's goal to score one point.
3. Spinning the rods with uncontrollable force is not allowed.
- 4.If a ball comes to a complete stop, a timeout occurs and the ball is dropped into the middle to start play back up again.

Note: Use the ball entry cup for this if provided on your game table

BILLIARDS:

In the course of play, a player must call each shot in advance, by indicating the ball to be made and the pocket into which it will be made. It is not necessary to indicate details such as cushions, banks, caroms, etc. Failure to make the shot as called results in a loss of turn. If the shot is made as called, then any other balls pocketed remain pocketed. However, if the called shot is not made and any other balls are pocketed, then the shooter's ball(s) that were pocketed would be spotted and any of the opponent's balls would remain pocketed.

In order to execute a Legal Shot, the first ball hit must be one of the balls in the shooter's group (stripes or solids) and the object ball must be pocketed or the cue ball or any object ball must come into contact with a rail. (Note: It is legal for the shooter to bank the cue ball off a rail before hitting the object ball.) A player who legally pockets a ball continues play until missing or committing a Foul. Once a player's ball group (stripes or solids) is pocketed, the player may play the 8 ball. Again, the player must clearly indicate the intended pocket, even if it appears obvious. A player who legally pockets all of his ball group and the 8 ball is the winner.

FOULS

1. Failure to execute a legal shot as defined above.
2. A scratch shot (shooting the cue ball into a pocket or off the table)
3. Moving or touching any ball by means other than legal play.
4. Shooting an intentional jump shot over another ball by scooping the cue stick under the cue ball. (A jump shot executed by striking the cue ball above center is legal.)
5. Using the 8 ball first in a combination shot when the table is not open.

TABLE TENNIS:

In singles, the server first makes a good service and then the receiver makes a good return. Thereafter, server and receiver alternately each make a good return. In doubles, the server first makes a good service and the receiver returns the ball. Then the partner of the server makes a good return, followed by the partner of the receiver returning the ball. Thereafter, each player alternately in that sequence makes a good return

ARCHERY:

Players will take turns shooting 3 arrows at the targets per turn. The player with the most points after 3 rounds is the winner.

CARE AND USE OF YOUR SWIVEL TABLE

1. Use only a suitable 120v AC household outlet, and insure the cord is not a trip hazard.
2. For long life and best play from your air hockey table, apply spray furniture polish to clean cloth and wipe down the playfield with air motor running to make the pucks slide faster before first play and frequently thereafter.
3. Use spray furniture polish to clean all exterior surfaces of your billiards table.
4. Use the Billiards Playfield brush provided to clean the cloth on the billiards table.
5. Use a carpenters level to properly level table using the leg levelers.
6. This product is intended for **INDOOR** use only.
7. **DO NOT** operate the motor if the cord is damaged in any way.
8. **DO NOT** sit, climb or lean on the table.
9. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the legs.
10. **DO NOT** set drinks on the table.
11. It is suggested that this table be placed close to wall thus allowing the air motor cord to **NOT** be a trip hazard. Always turn air motor off when table is not in use.
12. If possible, cover table with a pool table cover or sheet when not used to keep playfield clean preventing any dust build up.
