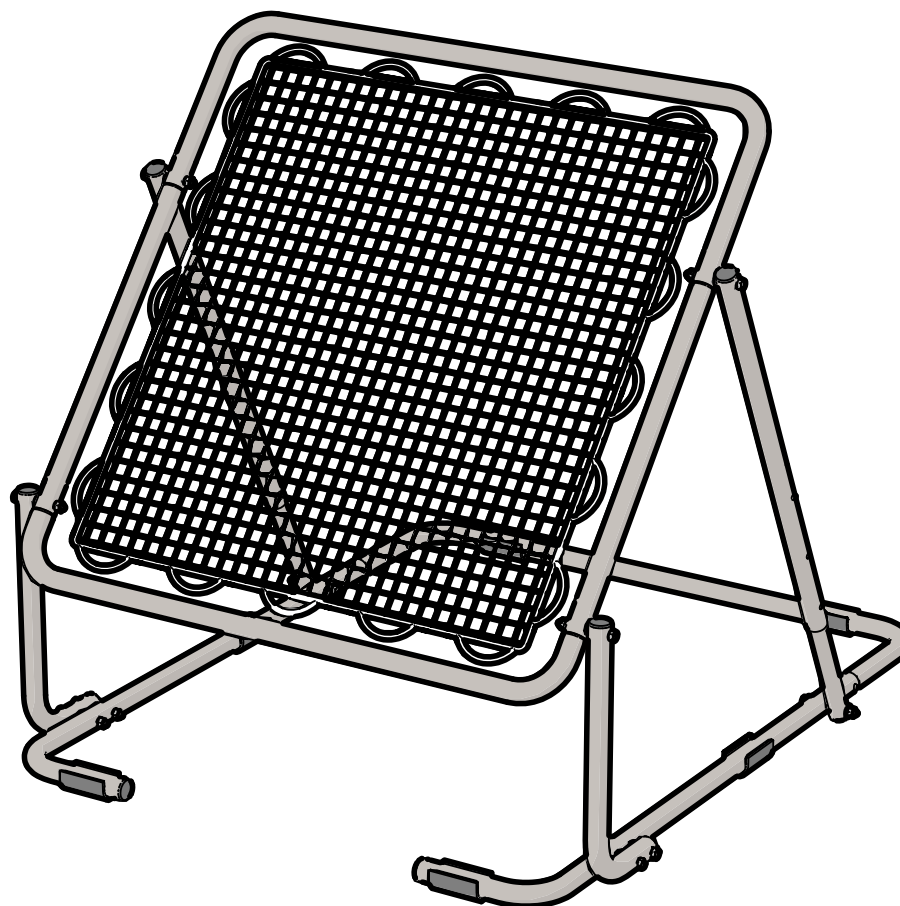

- Pass Back is a rebounder and will propel the ball towards the thrower at high speeds. Be sure that the user and - observers are safely positioned before using.
- When in use, make sure the pass back is set up in a clear area to avoid injury and/or damage to property.
- Do not use pass back for anything other than its intended use.
- Do not stand or jump on net or other parts of the product.
- Do not install the pass back in a location where errant balls could strike or cause damage to people or structures.

- When adjusting the angle via the rear telescoping tubes, do not let go of the supports until the buttons are re-engaged.

3. **To make assembly easier, use the Hardware & Parts Identifiers on pages 4, 5 & 6 to identify and sort all fasteners & Parts. Check all cartons for kits. All hardware may not be located in one kit.**
4. **Do not tighten hardware until instructed to do so. If hardware is tightened too soon, mounting holes may not align and parts may not easily fit together.**
5. **Save these instructions and your proof of purchase (receipt) in the event that the manufacturer has to be contacted for replacement parts.**

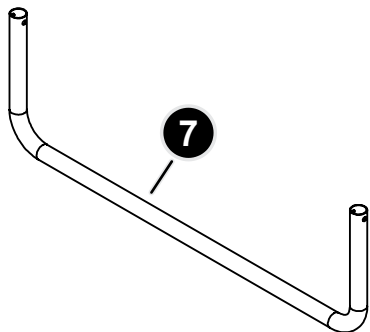


MALE EXTENDING TUBE WITH BUTTON PIN

FRAME ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

PARTS NEEDED

2X ① Base Side Tube

1X ② Back Base Tube

6X ③ Ground Foot

STEP 1

Snap on two Ground Feet (#3) to each Base Side Tube (#1) and Back Base Tube (#2) as shown in Figure 1.

NOTICE

Do not lay the parts on a rough surface until you attach the Ground Feet (#3), as it may scratch the finish or paint.

NOTICE

TWO ADULTS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING ASSEMBLY STEPS.

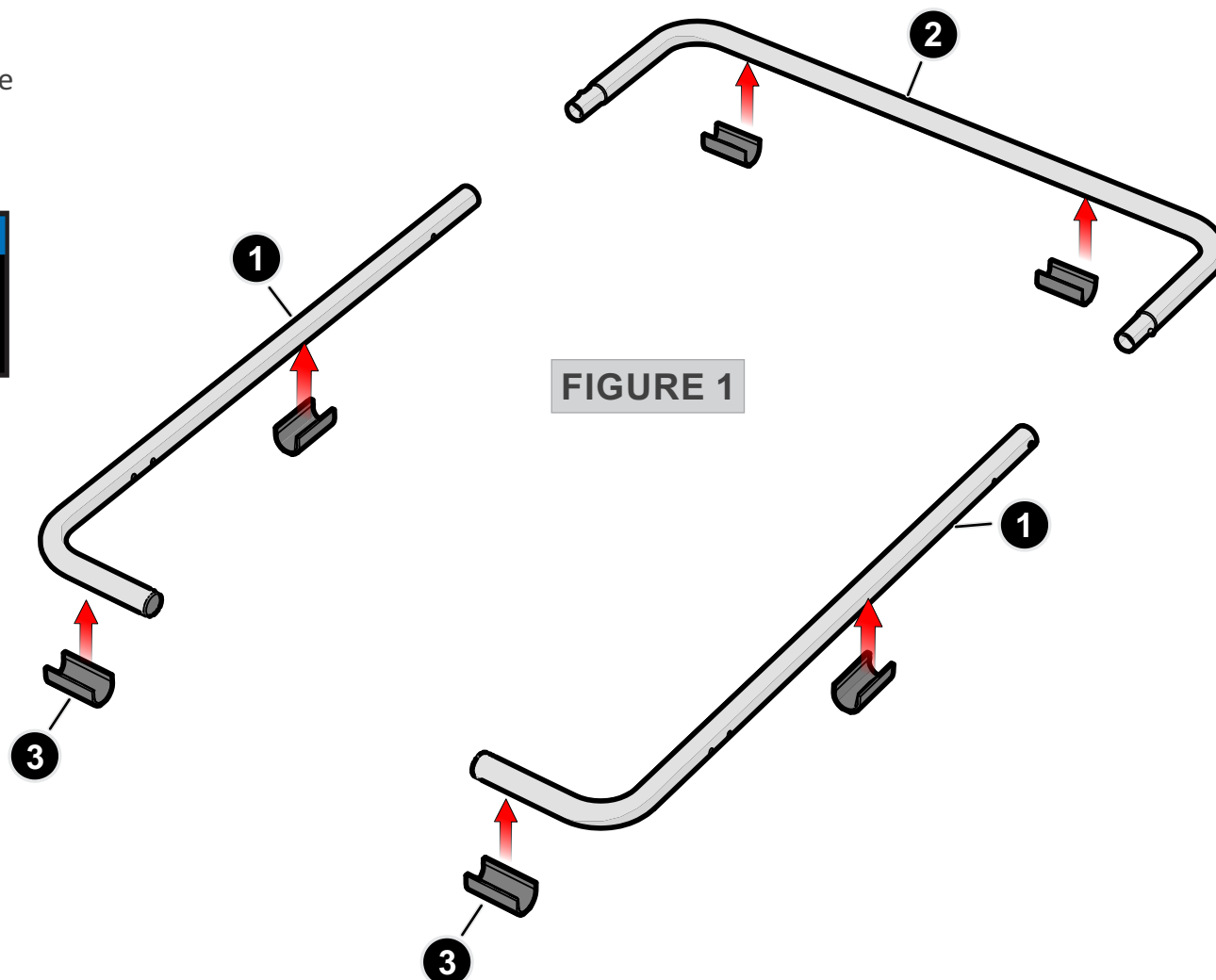

PARTS NEEDED

2X **4** Base Side Raising Tube

STEP 2

Assemble Base Side Raising Tube (**#4**) and Base Side Tube (**#1**) together using hardware as shown in **Detail A**.

DETAIL A

Make sure to place the H5 Nuts on the Base Side Tube side.

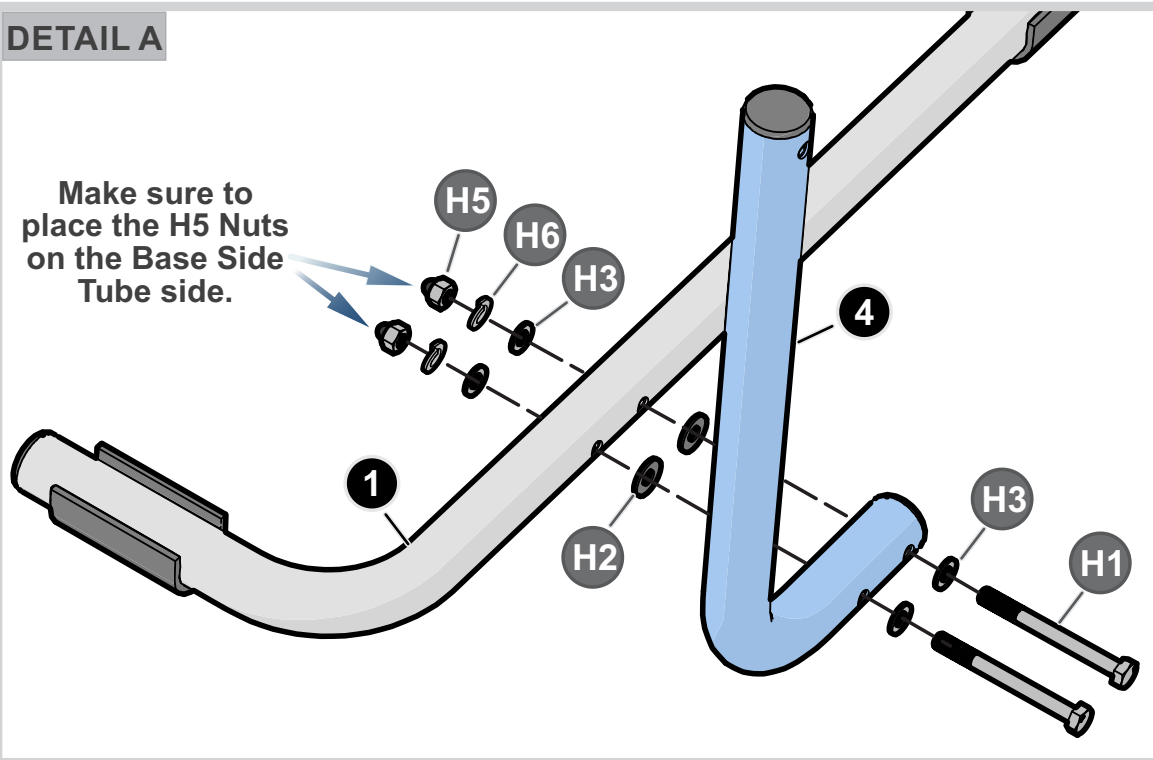
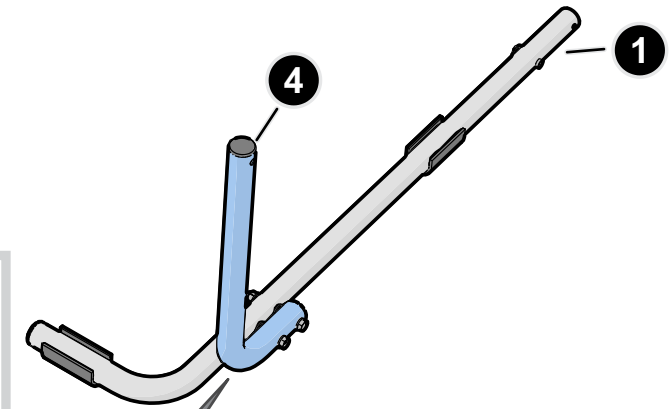

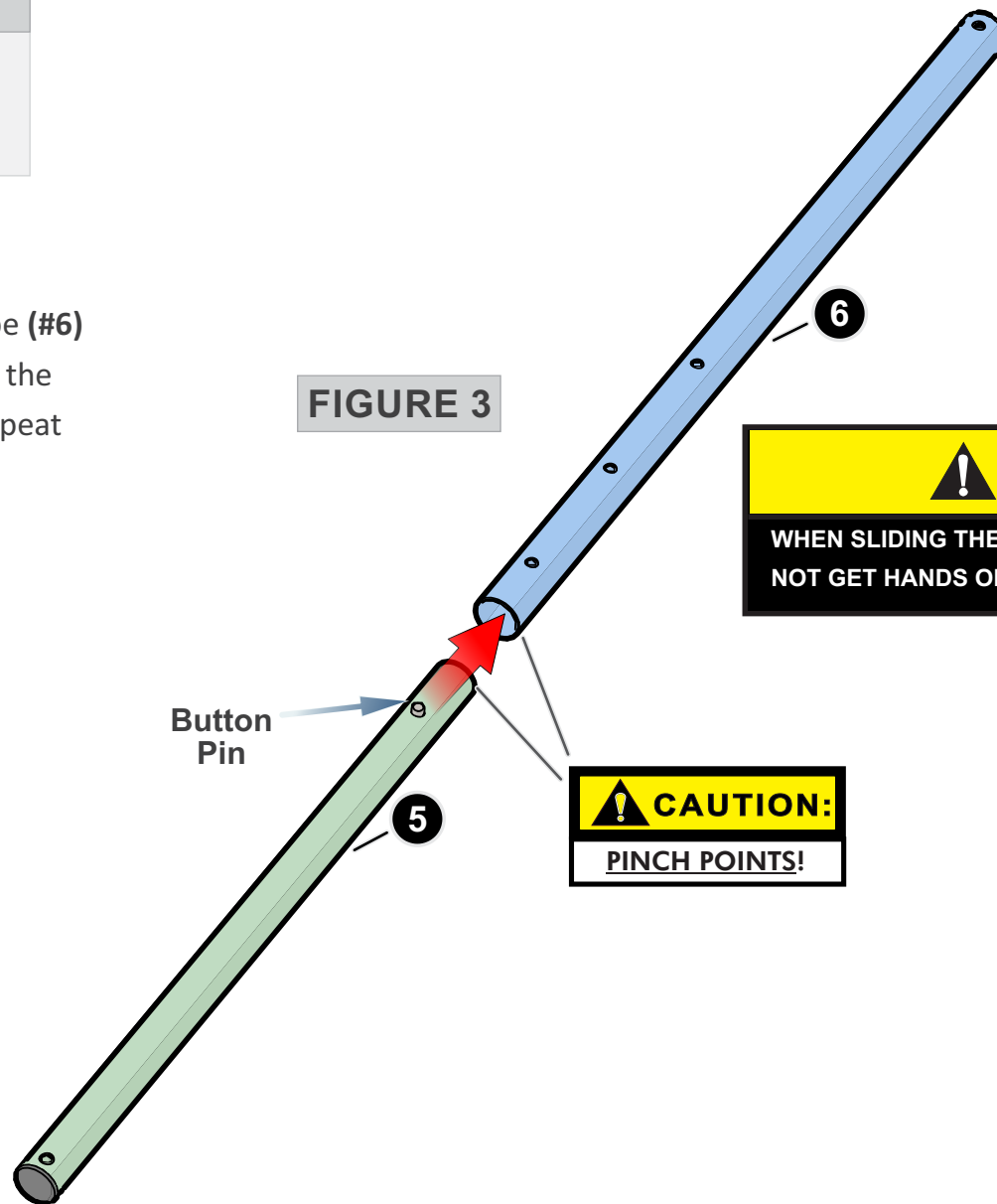
PARTS NEEDED

2X ⑤ Male Extending Tube

2X ⑥ Female Extending Tube

STEP 3

Assemble the Female Extending Tube (#6) and Male Extending Tube (#5) using the Button Pin, as shown in **Figure 3**. Repeat step to make a second assembly.



PARTS NEEDED

2X Extending Tube Assemblies

STEP 4

Assemble Extending Tube assemblies from last step to the outside of the Base Side Tube (#1) with hardware as shown in **Figure 4** & **Detail A**. Lay down both extending tube assembly so they are out of the way for the next step. See **Detail B**.

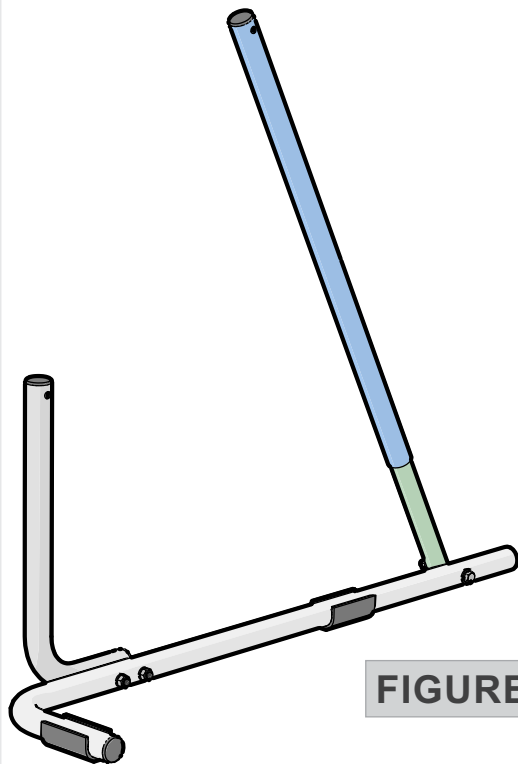
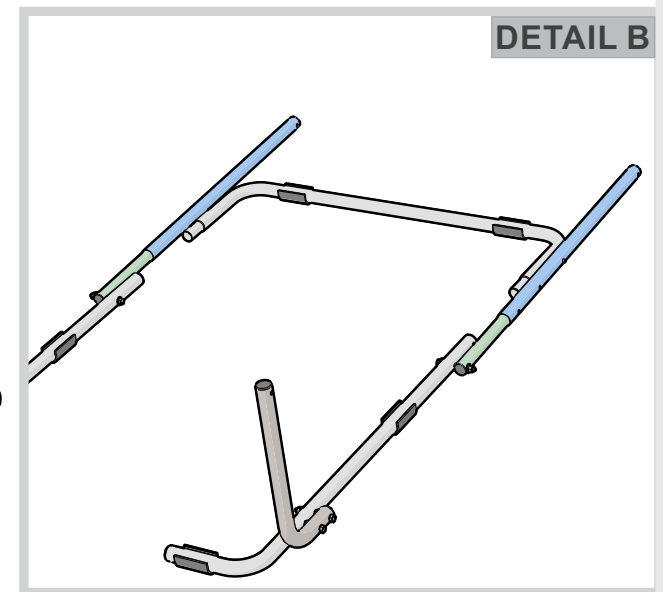
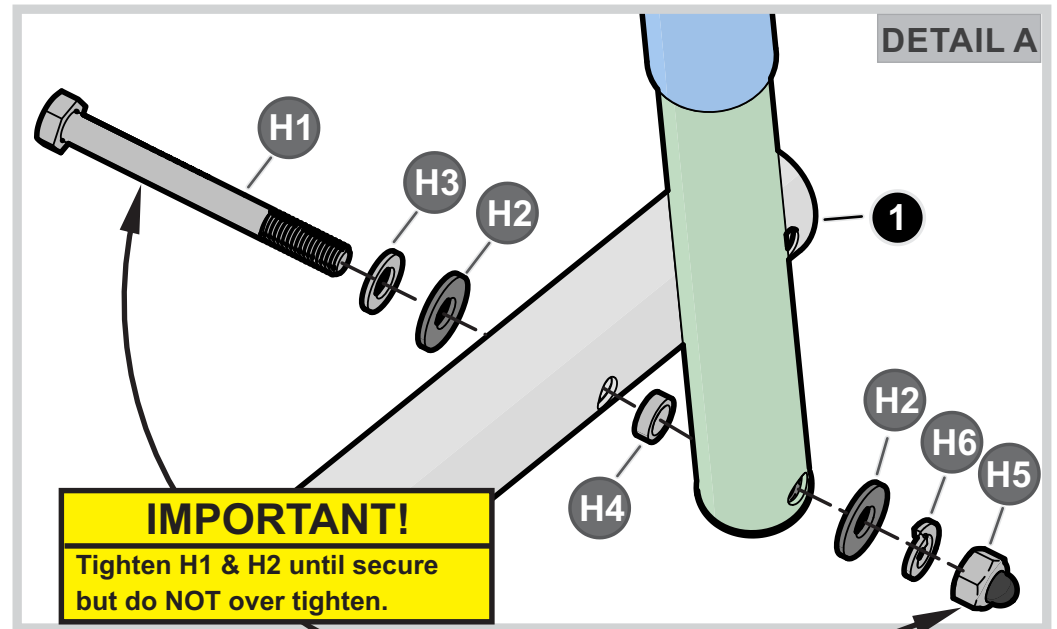

DETAIL B

PARTS NEEDED

1X **8** Bottom Net Frame Tube

2X **9** Side Net Frame Tube

STEP 5

Slide the Side Net Frame Tubes (**#9**) onto each swedge of the Bottom Net Frame Tube (**#8**) and attach them to the Base Side Raising Tube (**#4**) with the hardware as shown in **Detail A**.

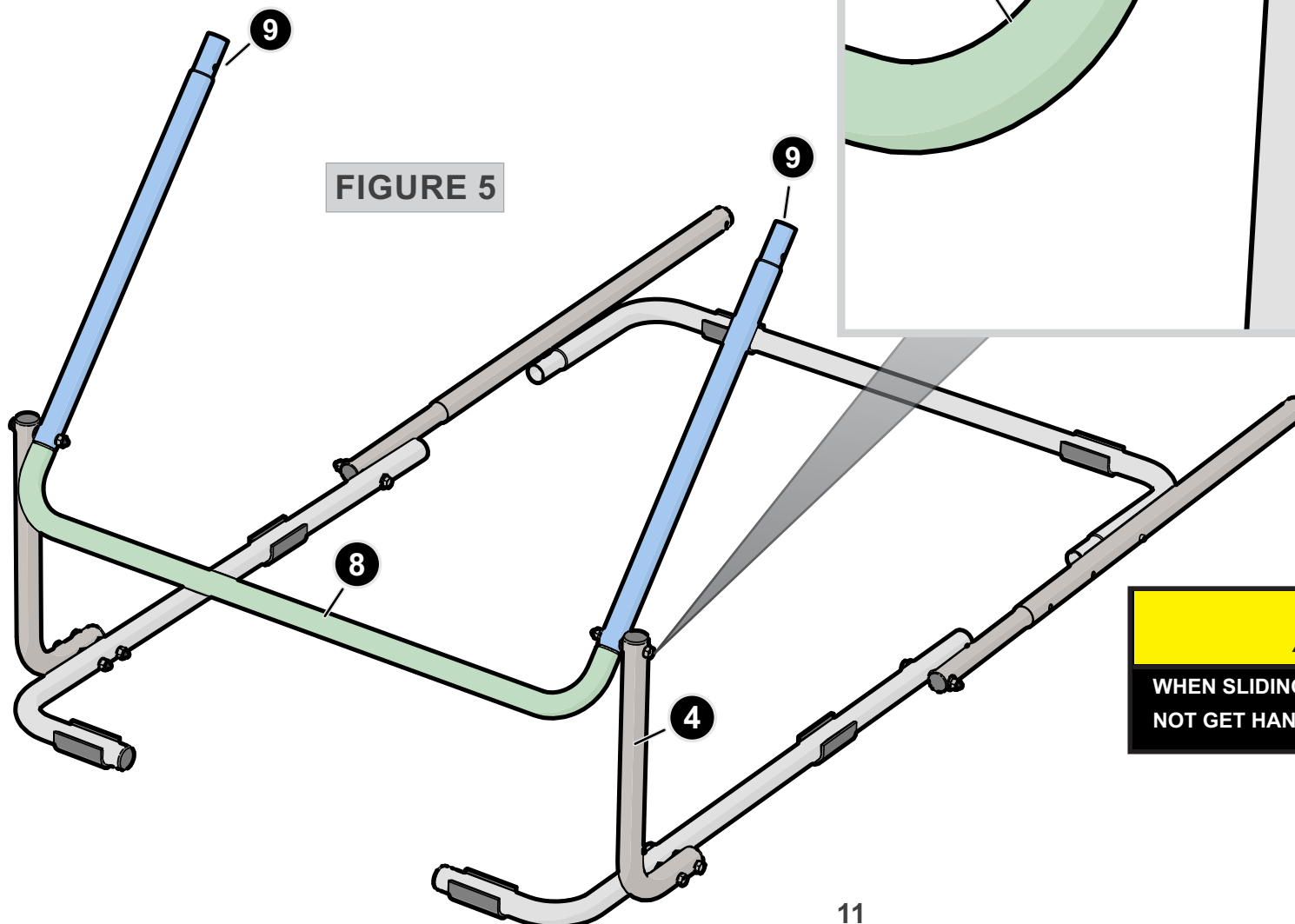
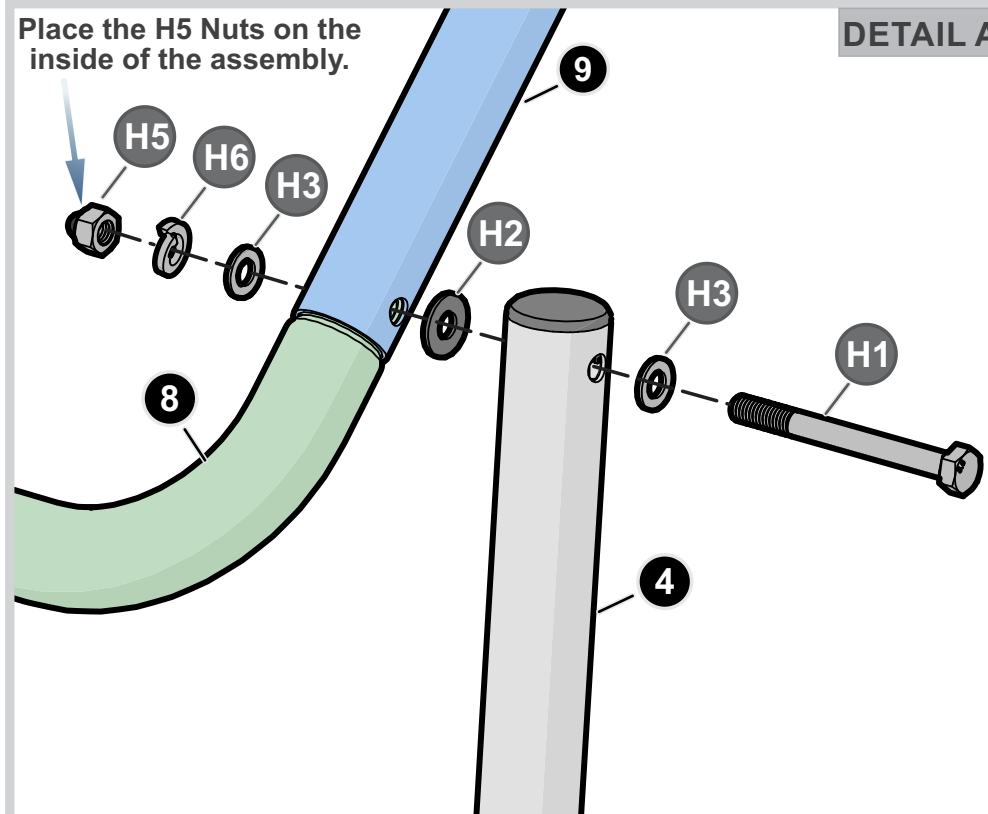

PARTS NEEDED

1X 7 Top Net Frame Tube

STEP 6

Slide the Top Net Frame Tube (#7) onto the swedge of the Side Net Frame Tubes (#9). Then Swing up the Extended Tube Assemblies and attach it with the hardware. See **Detail A**.



Extending Tube Assemblies

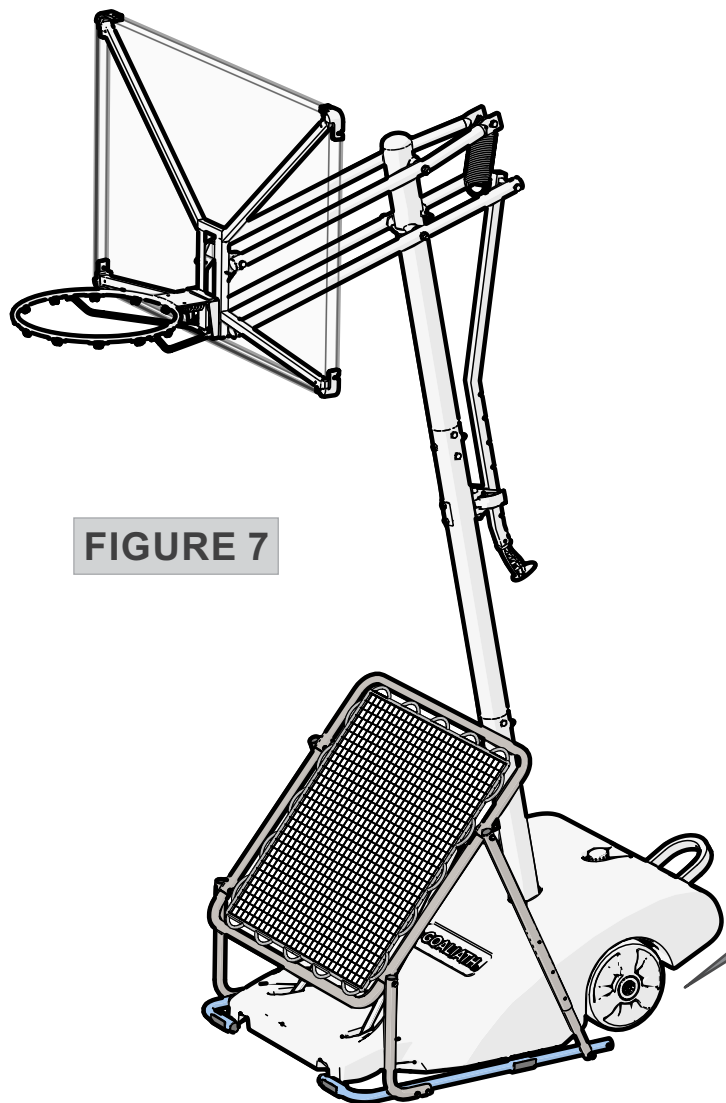

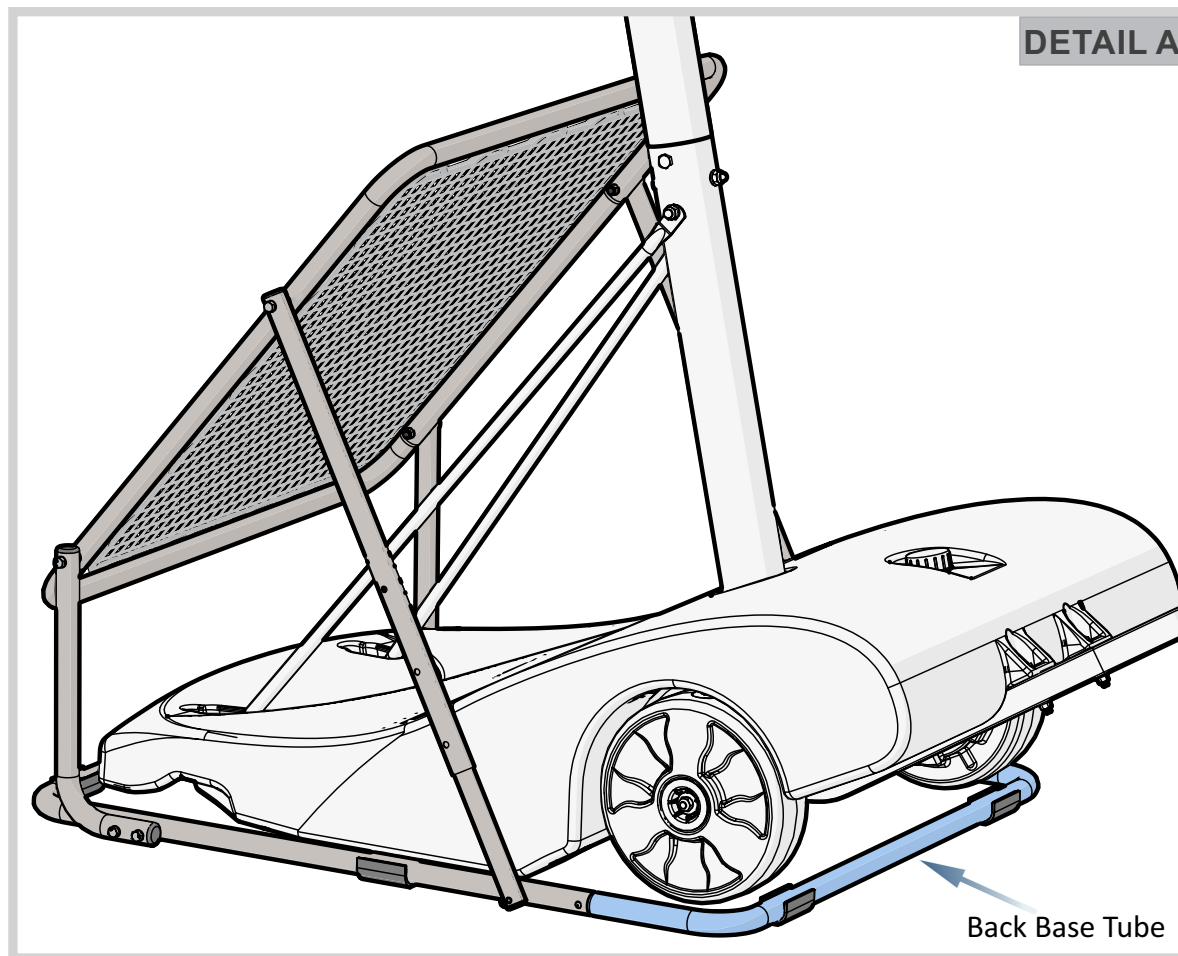
STEP 7

When using with a **Silverback NXT 54 or NXT 50 Portable Basketball System**, the multi-sport rebounder can be used in two different ways around the ballast of the portable system: **A.** The Back Base Tube can be left off, as shown in **Figure 7**. Or, **B.** The Back Base Tube can be positioned beneath the wheels of the ballast, as shown in **Detail A**.

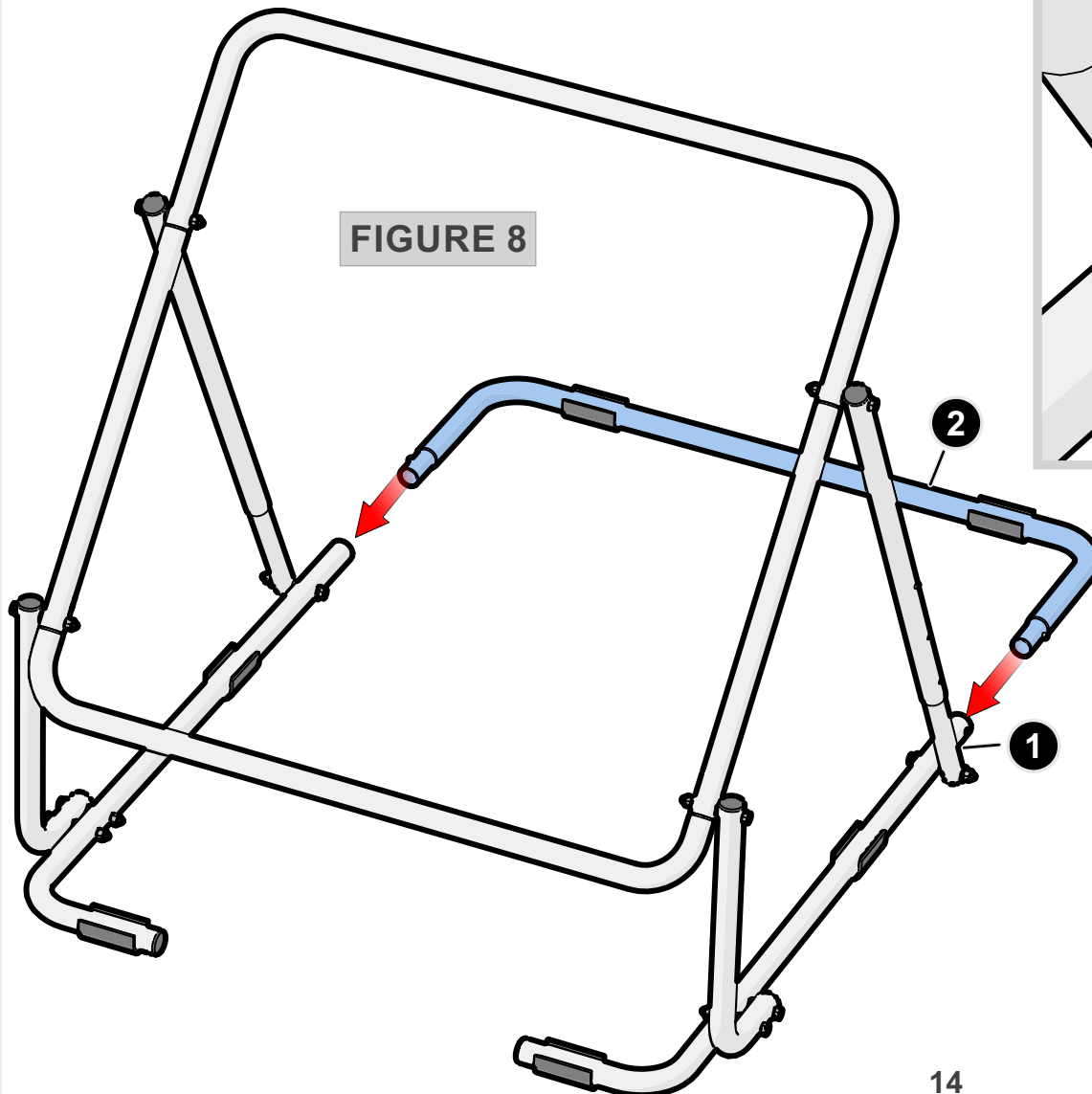

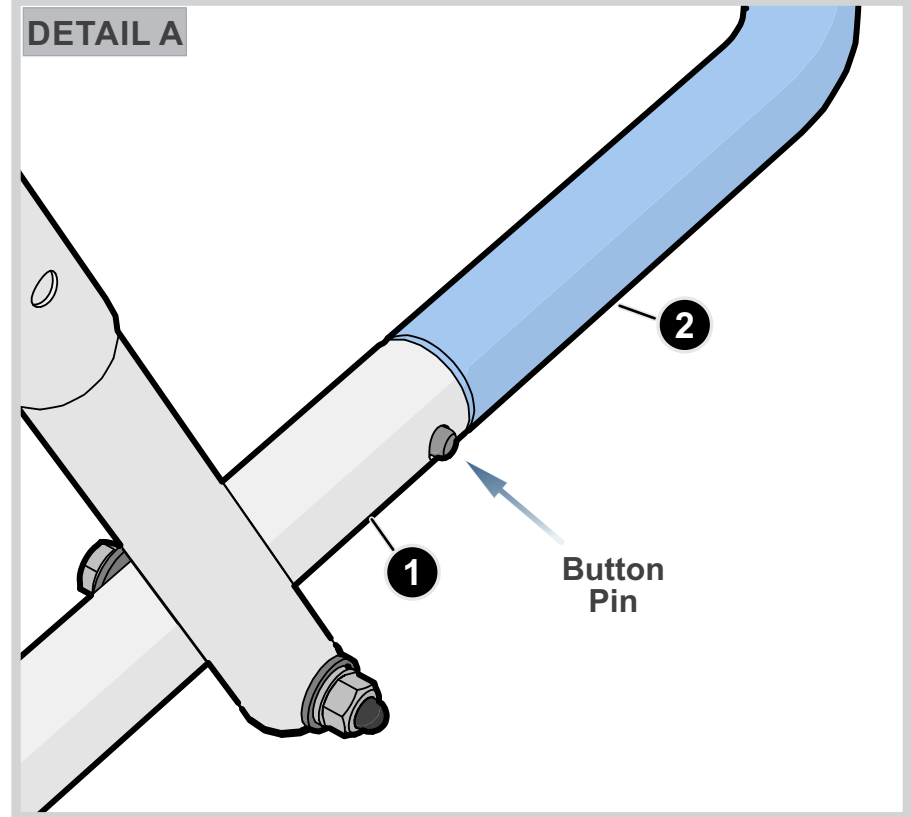

STEP 8

Attach the Back Base Tube (#2) to the Base Side Tubes (#1) using pre-installed button pins as shown in **Figure 8** & **Detail A**.

1X **10** Net

20X **11** Ball Clasps

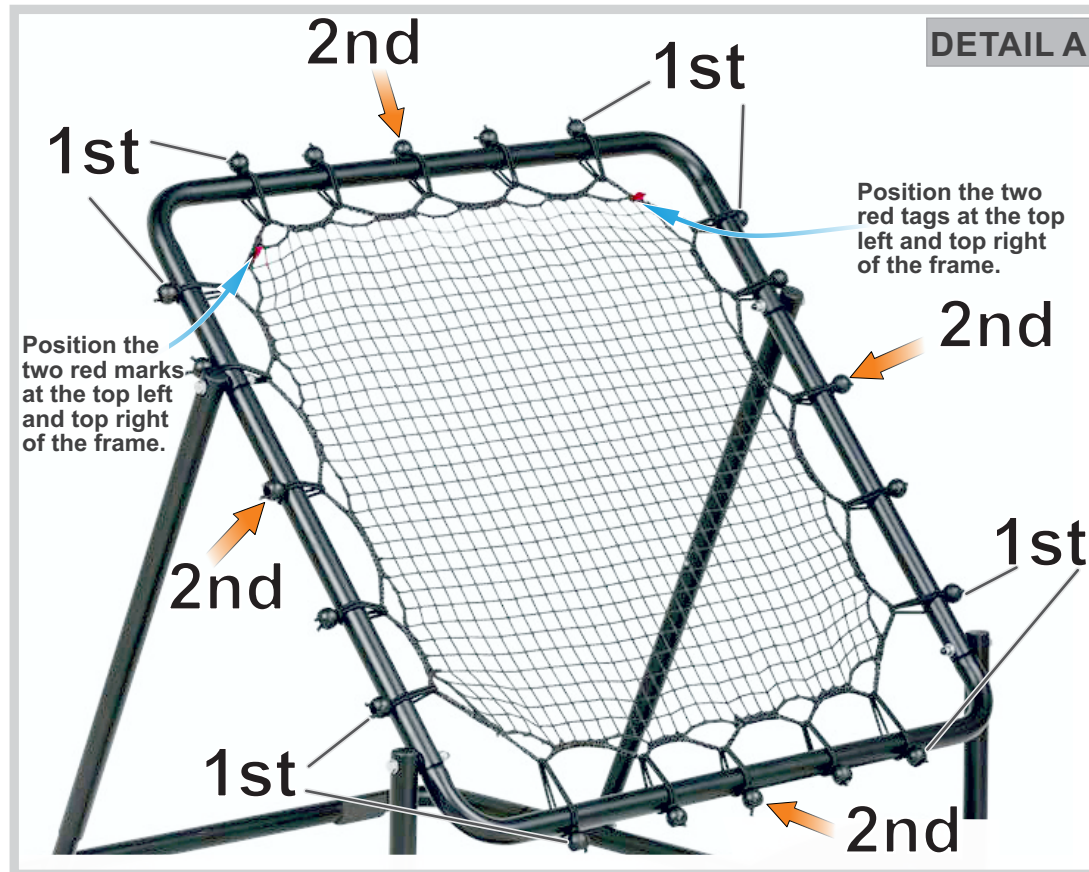
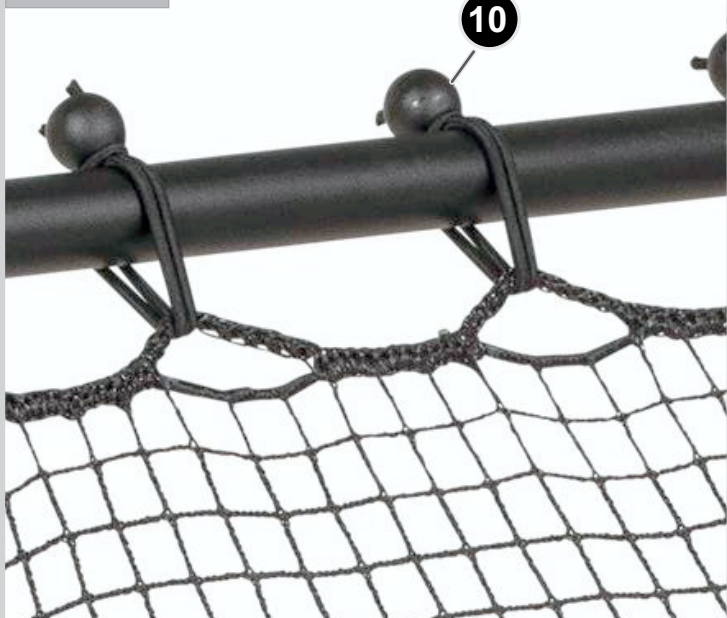
NOTICE

Position the two red tags on the net at the top left and top right of the frame. See Detail A.

STEP 9

To attach the Net (#10) to the frame, begin by connecting two Ball Clasps (#11) to each corner of the frame first. Then, secure one Ball Clasp in each of the center loops of the net. Finally, attach the remaining Ball Clasps (#11) to the open loops of the net. See **Detail A** & **Detail B**.

PARTS NEEDED

2X **12** Black Sand Bag

STEP 10

Fill each Black Sand Bag (#12) with approximately **20 lbs** of sand to make two weighted bags and seal them securely.

NOTICE

Use **ONLY SAND** to fill the Sand Bags (#12). Water is not recommended.

STEP 11

Placing the weighted bags at the front of the system is recommended most of the time. However, bags can also be positioned on the sides or back, provided that the trainer remains stable. See **Detail A**.

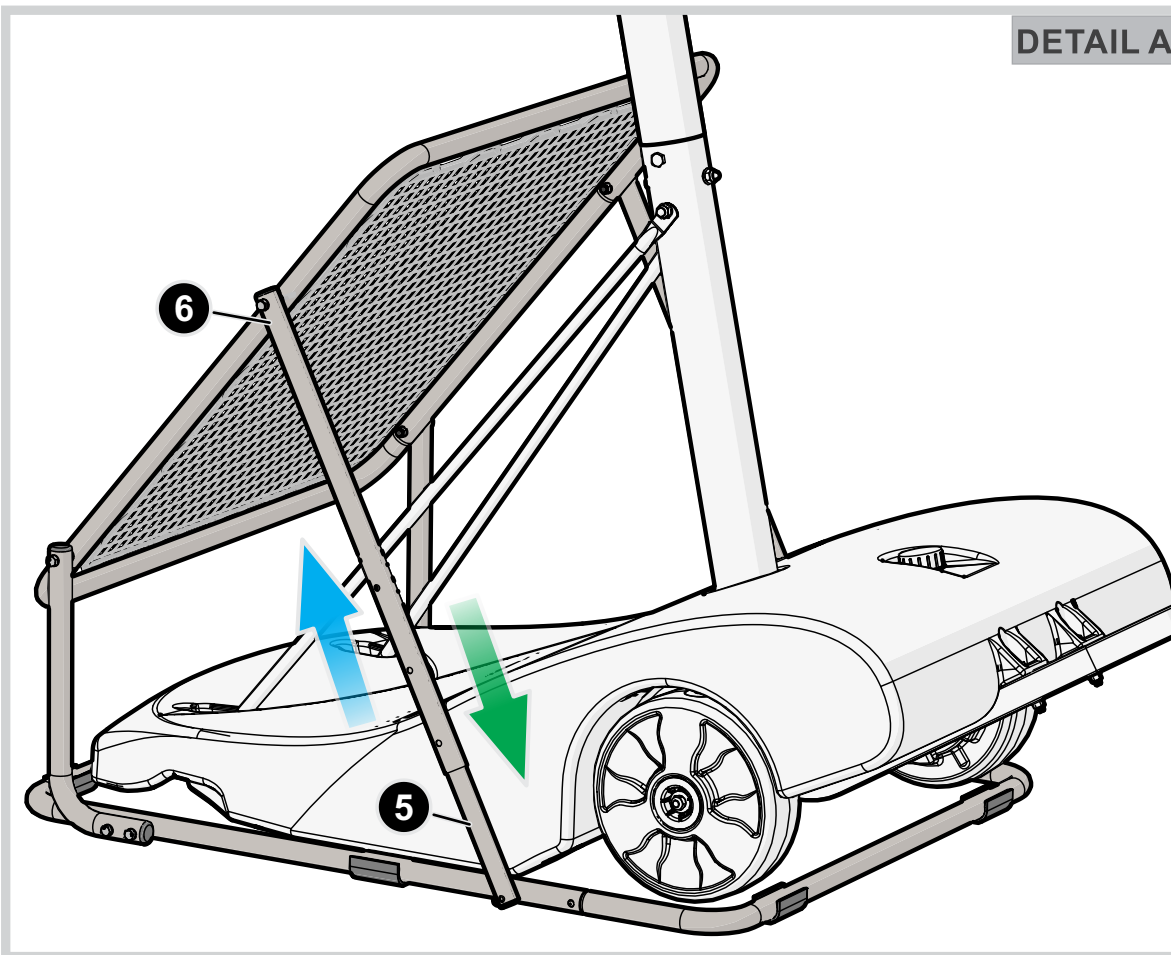

The angle of the frame can be adjusted by pushing in the button pin to unlock the telescoping tubes (**#5 & #6**) on both sides and adjusting them to the desired angle. See **Detail A**.



CAUTION

WHEN ADJUSTING THE ANGLE VIA THE REAR TELESCOPING TUBES, DO NOT LET GO OF THE SUPPORTS UNTIL THE BUTTONS ARE RE-ENGAGED.
