

2021 SAN SIMEON PASO ROBLES PETITE SIRAH



Region/Vintage Notes

The 2021 San Simeon Petite Sirah is sourced from our Stefano and Maddalena estate vineyards in the El Pomar AVA in the Paso Robles appellation. This region is renowned for its ideal growing conditions where Petite Sirah thrives. The warm Paso Robles days are cooled by the Pacific Ocean, causing a diurnal temperature shift of 30-50°, which helps achieve ripeness and maintain acidity levels. The 2021 vintage started early with an earlier than normal bud break. Heavy spring winds contributed to loose clusters, indicating lower yields. The ongoing drought conditions then produced smaller, more concentrated grapes. These factors combined to create a vintage of remarkable intensity and exceptional quality, resulting in an explosively flavorful wine.

Winemaker/Tasting Notes

Our 2021 San Simeon Petite Sirah is a testament to the depth and richness this varietal can achieve. Petite Sirah grapes have very thick skins that give the wine its inky depth of color that captivates right away. Aged for 26 months in a combination of French, American and neutral oak barrels, the wine has a smooth mouthfeel and powerful aromas of ripe blackberries, plums and savory herbs that delight the senses. On the palate, the wine reveals rich layers of concentrated dark fruits with hints of warm vanilla. The well-integrated tannins provide structure while the balanced acidity ensures a lively and enduring finish.

Sustainability

Sustainability is a top priority at San Simeon. Our Paso Robles vineyards are certified sustainable by the rigorous California Sustainable Wine Alliance (CSWA). At our Paso Robles winery, solar panels provide 100% of the needed electricity, and wastewater is effectively reclaimed and recycled for additional use.

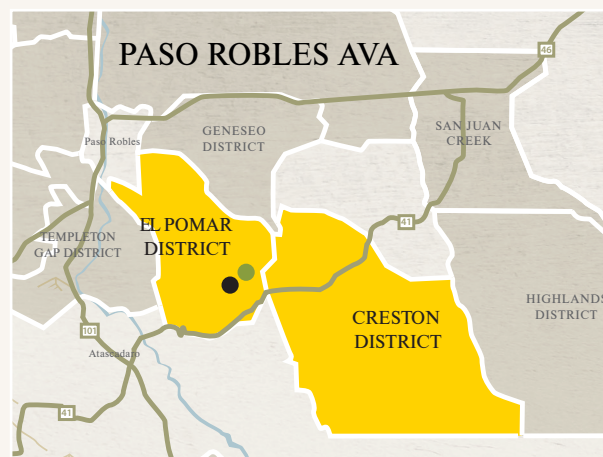
