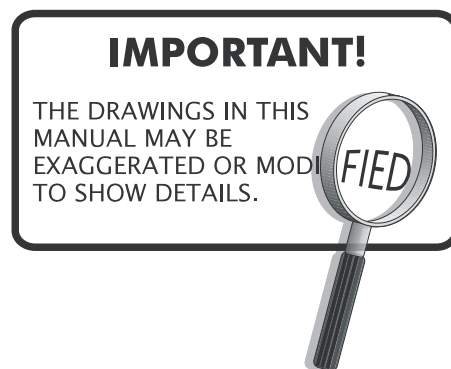

Tools Required (not provided):

Phillips Screwdriver
Furniture Polish and Cloth

An electric screwdriver is helpful in assembly. However, please set at low torque and use extreme caution with an electric screwdriver because you could overtighten the hardware and strip the screws.

Assembly Tips

Make sure you understand the following tips before you begin to assemble your hockey table.

1. Start all bolts by hand before tightening.
2. Some drawings or images in this manual may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before starting each assembly step.

- 2) Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon zinc), or rechargeable (ni-cad, ni-mh, etc.) batteries.
- 3) Do not dispose of batteries in fire, batteries may explode or leak.

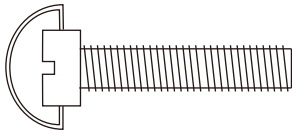

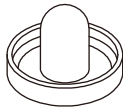

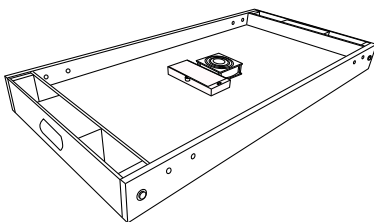

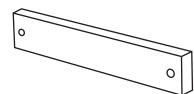

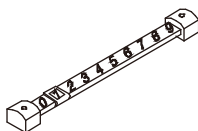

PARTS REQUIRED:

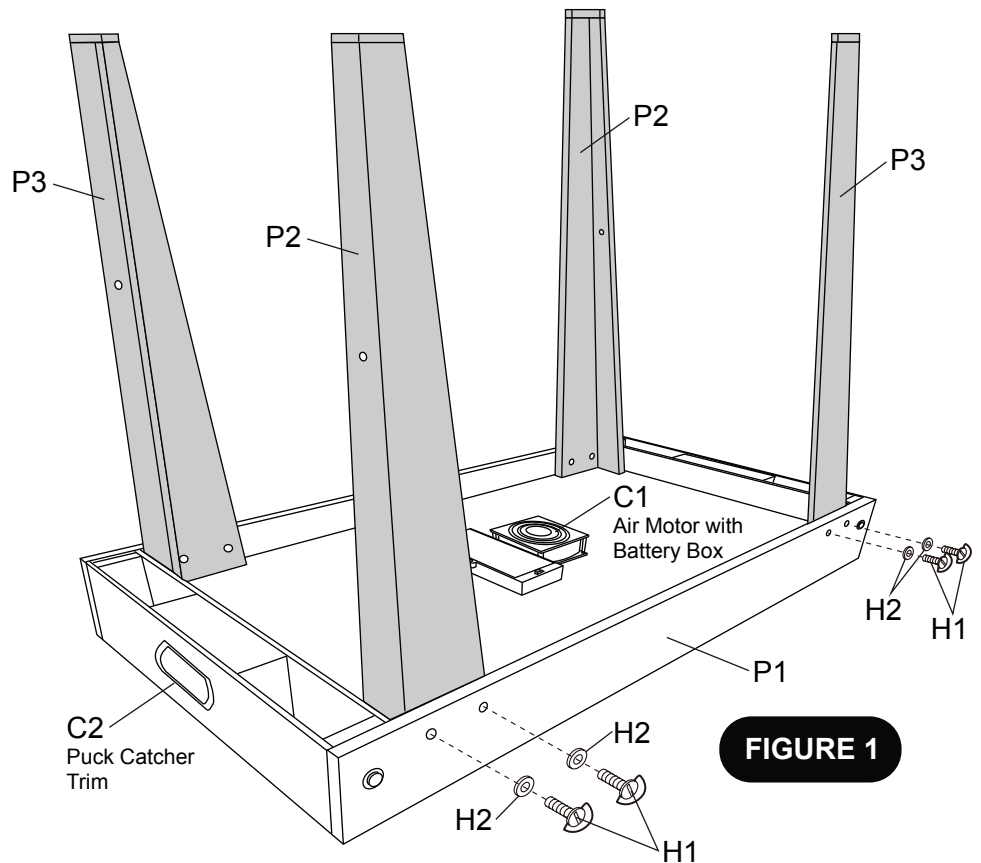
- 8 pcs - **H1** Wing Bolt
- 8 pcs - **H2** Flat Washer
- 1 pc - **P1** Air Hockey Cabinet
- 2 pcs - **P2** Left Leg
- 2 pcs - **P3** Right Leg

STEP 1:

Leave **P1** Air Hockey Table Cabinet face down in carton to assemble.

Install **P2** Left Legs and **P3** Right Legs onto **P1** Air Hockey Cabinet using **H1** Wing Bolts and **H2** Flat Washers as shown in **FIGURE 1**.

Do not tighten H1 Bolts during this step.



PARTS REQUIRED:

- 4 pcs - **H1** Wing Bolt
- 4 pcs - **H2** Flat Washer
- 2 pcs - **P4** End Leg Panel
- 8 pcs - **1.5V AA** Batteries (not provided)

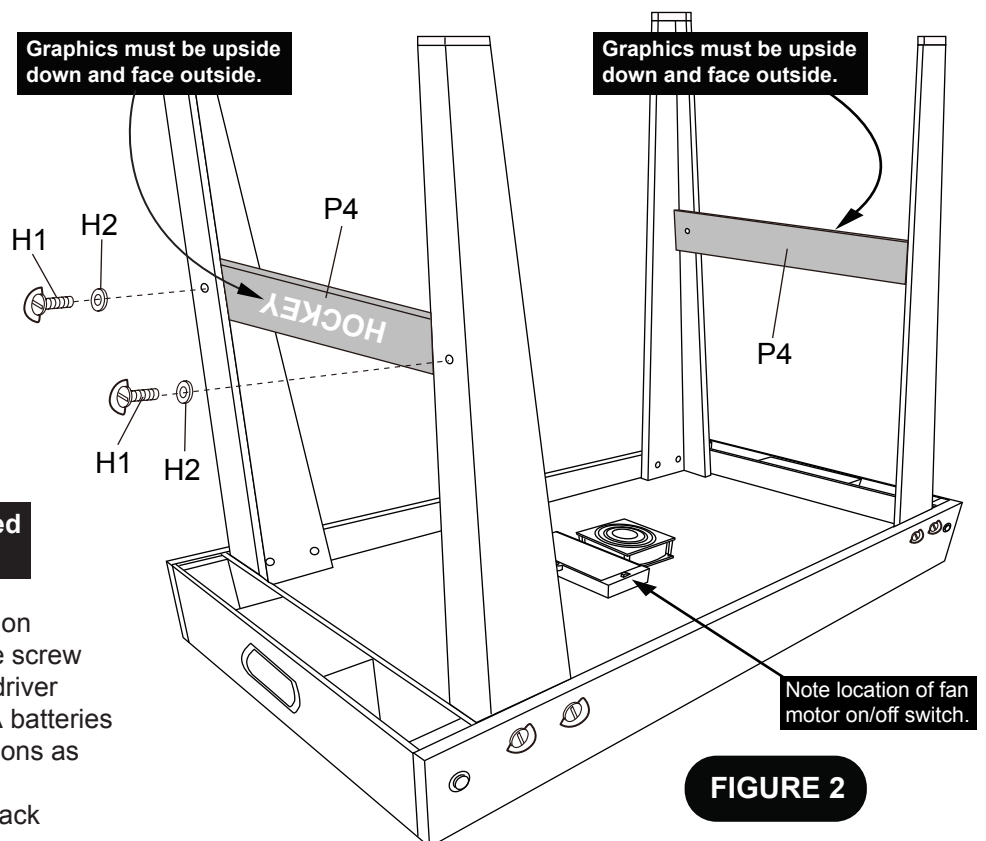
STEP 2:

Install **P4** End Leg Panels using **H1** Wing Bolts and **H2** Flat Washers as shown in **FIGURE 2**.

Tighten all H1 Bolts at this time from STEP 1.

All H1 Wing Bolts should be tightened with a screwdriver (not provided).

Next, Open battery compartment cover on the underside of the table by turning the screw counter-clockwise using Phillips Screwdriver (not provided). Install 8 pieces 1.5V AA batteries (not provided) in the proper (-) (+) positions as indicated inside battery compartment. Replace the cover and turn the screw back clockwise to secure it into place.



WARNING:

THIS STEP REQUIRES TWO ADULTS.

VERY CAREFULLY TURN THE TABLE OVER AND SET IT ON ITS LEGS. BE CAREFUL, THE TABLE IS HEAVY.

PARTS REQUIRED:

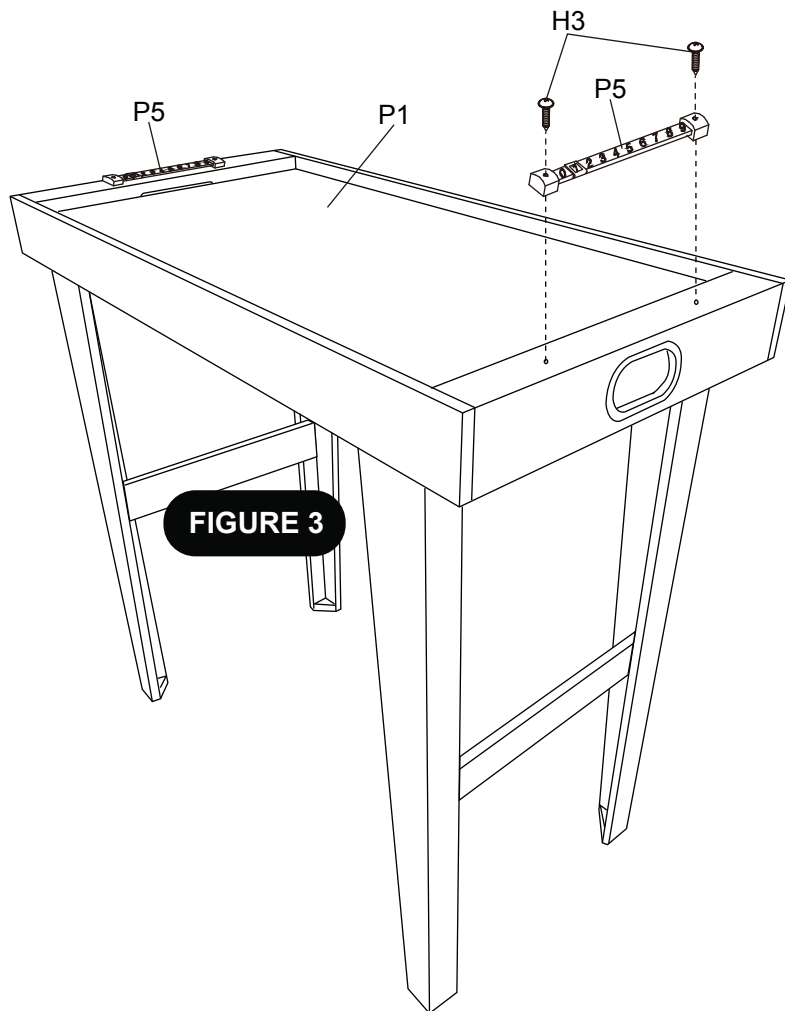
4 pcs - **H3** Phillips Round Head Screw
2 pcs - **P5** Manual Scorer

STEP 3:

Install **P5** Manual Scorer onto **P1** Air Hockey Cabinet using pre-drilled pilot holes with **H3** Screws as shown in **FIGURE 3**.

Tighten, do not strip out H3 Screws.

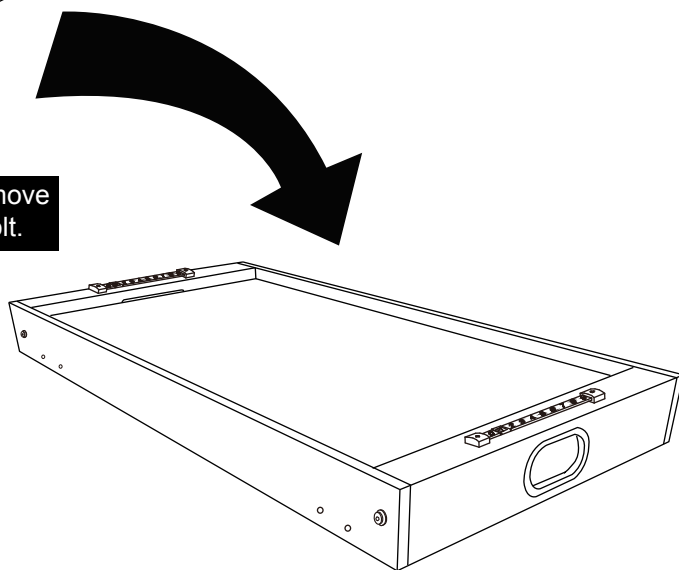
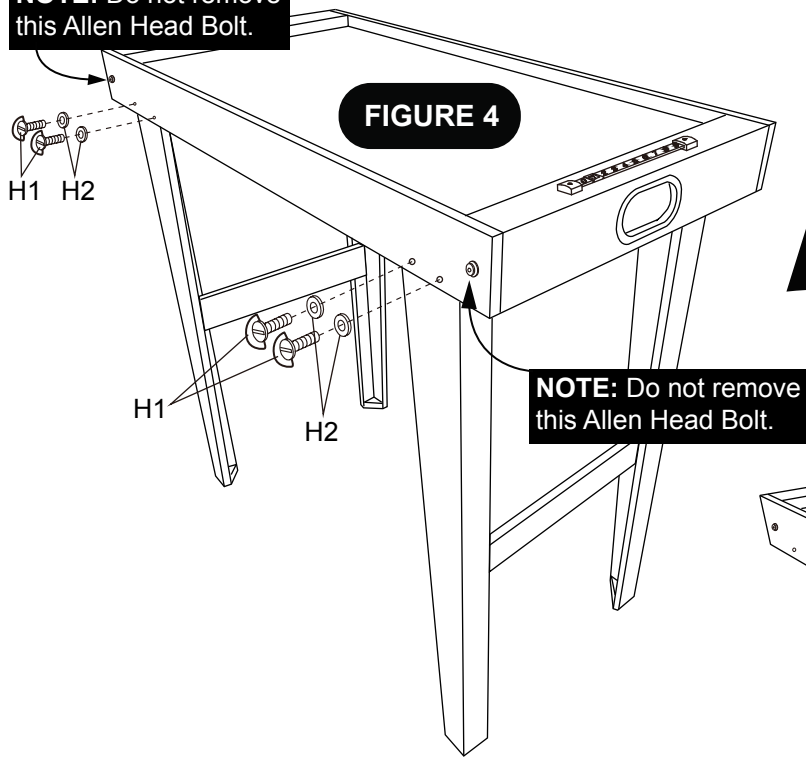
Lastly, Turn the power switch ON from battery compartment (underneath table) to play your hockey table.



FOR TABLE TOP PLAY:

Carefully remove **H1** Wing Bolts and **H2** Flat Washers as shown in **FIGURE 4**.

NOTE: Do not remove this Allen Head Bolt.



Congratulations! You have now assembled your hockey table. Please note the Care and Use instructions below to insure many years of trouble free use of your hockey table.

CARE AND USE OF YOUR HOCKEY TABLE

1. For long life and best play from your air hockey table, apply spray furniture polish to clean cloth and wipe down the playfield with air motor running to make the pucks slide faster before first play and frequently thereafter.
2. This product is intended for **INDOOR** use only.
3. **DO NOT** operate the motor if the battery compartment is damaged in any way.
4. **DO NOT** sit, climb or lean on the table.
5. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the legs.
6. **DO NOT** set drinks on the table.

Battery Caution:
