ABOUT BASKOLI

Hiruzta Winery, derived from hiruren uzta meaning ‘three-person harvest,’ has been the dream of a father and his two sons—Asensio, Txarli and Angel Reklade—to create their own Txakoli wines in one of the most beautiful locations in Basque Country. Txakoli is a wine produced from native grapes in Hondarribia; a tradition dating back to at last the 15th century. Hondarribia is a picturesque fishing village surrounded by mountains and sea, 18 kilometers from San Sebastián, and very close to French Basque towns such as Saint-Jean-de-Luz and Biarritz.

BASQUE COUNTRY

Hondarribia is a fishing village in the Basque Country that has managed to ensure the preservation of its architecture, history and an important gastronomic culture among its inhabitants. The weather, soil and crop type are the keys to our exceptional “terroir.” The winery’s own 42 acres of vineyard and are located in the surroundings of the winery itself, at the foothills of Jaizkibel Mountain. It is oriented toward the mid-day sun, which protects it from the wind and damp of the nearby Cantabrian Sea, thereby enjoying excellent sunshine.
