Region/Vintage Notes

Our 2022 San Simeon Cabernet Sauvignon is a harmonious representation of the distinctive terroir of Paso Robles' El Pomar AVA. Sourced from four acclaimed estate vineyards nestled within this coastal appellation, each vineyard contributes its own unique terroir, varying soil compositions and microclimates, resulting in grapes with nuanced flavors and complexities. Embraced by the cooling breezes of the Templeton Gap, these vineyards benefit from warm days and cool nights for optimal grape development. The generally rocky, marine-derived soils let the roots delve deep in their struggle for water and nutrients, yielding grapes brimming with concentrated flavors. By artfully blending these diverse elements from the mix of vineyards, our winemakers crafted a Cabernet Sauvignon that beautifully captures the essence of the broader region and the artistry and expertise behind each bottle.

Winemaker/Tasting Notes

After fermentation and pressing, our 2022 Cabernet Sauvignon ages gracefully in a thoughtfully selected blend of French and American oak. From its deep, dark hues to its robust flavors of black cherry, cassis and ripe plum, each sip unfolds layers of complexity revealing the diverse terroir of our four distinct vineyards. Enticing aromas of cedar, baking spice and tobacco beckon from the glass, leading to a rich, spicy mid-palate with soft, long-lasting leathery tannins. The wine has a long, round and smooth finish with a lasting impression.

Sustainability

Sustainability is a top priority at San Simeon. Our Paso Robles vineyards are certified sustainable by the rigorous California Sustainable Wine Alliance (CSWA). At our Paso Robles winery, solar panels provide 100% of the needed electricity, and wastewater is effectively reclaimed and recycled for additional use.

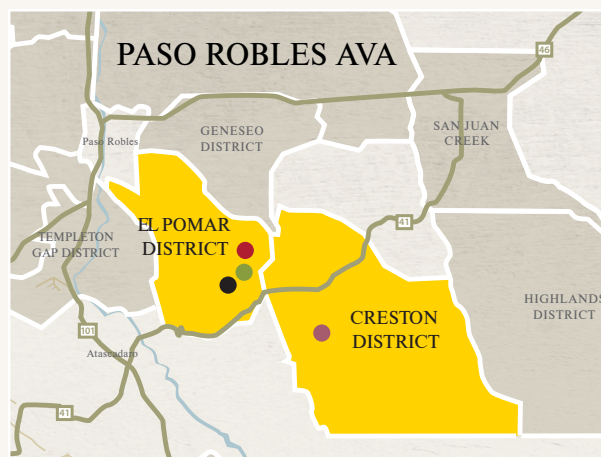
