
#### **IMPORTANT NOTE:**

Read the manual carefully. Make sure to save this manual for future reference. Illustrations in this manual are for explanatory purposes only, your actual product may look slightly different.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

The Air Mover is intended to move air and to dry floors, walls, carpet, furniture, etc. Durable and easy to operate with an effective balance of static pressure and airflow, the units are suitable for a variety of applications.

- 1. Your Air Mover is prepped for use upon delivery. Before connecting it to power, thoroughly check for any shipping damage.
- 2. Plug the electrical cord into an outlet.
- 3. Gently position the Air Mover on a solid, level, and dry surface. The unit features three Air Mover positions that can direct airflow across flat or upward-angled surfaces.



4. Set your preferred speed (1-LOW, 2- MED, 3- HIGH) using the control knob. If your fan will not turn on, make sure the Timer knob is set to "ON", then try setting preferred speed again.



5. Your air blower comes equipped with a convenient 180-minute (3 Hour) timer knob that allows you to set the operating time as needed.

**Turn Clockwise:** To set the timer, gently grasp the timer knob and turn it in a clockwise direction. As you turn it, you will notice the timer markings indicating the selected time interval.

**Choose Your Time:** Turn the knob to align the desired operating time with the reference mark or indicator on the control panel. This indicates how long the air blower will run before automatically turning off.

**Start the Blower:** Once you've set the desired time, simply start the air blower using the speed control knob as instructed in the user manual.

**Timer Activation:** The blower will run for the duration you've set on the timer. The fan will automatically switch off when the timer reaches zero.

**Important Note:** To reset the timer, turn the knob counter counter-clockwise to "ON", then reselect your new settings.

**NOTE:** Keep constant supervision on all active Air Movers.

### **SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. To prevent electric shock, do not operate the unit in standing water. Never plug in or unplug the unit with wet hands or while standing in water.
- 2. To avoid risk of injury, do not direct air flow at face or body.
- 3. To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not use the Air Mover with any solid-state speed control device.
- 4. Do not operate any Air Mover with a damaged cord or plug. Discard the unit or return it to an authorized service facility for examination and/or repair.
- 5. Unplug the Air Mover from the power supply before servicing or cleaning.
- 6. Do not run the power cord under carpeting. Do not cover the power cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Place the power cord away from traffic area to prevent tripping.
- 7. Do not allow children to play with or around an Air Mover at any time.
- 8. Do not move or carry an Air Mover while unit is operating.
- 9. All Air Movers in operation must be supervised at all time.

#### **MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. To keep the Air Mover clean, use a damp cloth to wipe the surface of the housing.
- 2. Never submerge or soak the Air Mover with water.
- 3. When not in use, unplug and store the Air Mover in a dry indoor place out of reach of children.
- 4. Always disconnect the Air Mover from its power source before performing any maintenance or cleaning.

## **TROUBLE SHOOTING**

For any problems not listed below, call your local distributor or contact our Service Department.

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	SOLUTION
	No power input	Plug in the Air Mover; check power source
Air Mover not running	Switch not turning on	Turn on switch
	Air Mover fan wheel jammed	Remove material jamming fan
	Intake or exhaust blocked	Turn unit off and allow to cool, then remove blockage
Air Mover vibrates excessively	Accumulation of dirt on fan blade	Clean Air Mover fan blades
