This balance of warmth and natural moderation allows for steady, even ripening, resulting in concentrated flavor, supple structure, and a thoughtfully timed harvest.


TASTING NOTES

This expressive Cabernet Sauvignon reveals aromas of ripe boysenberry, raspberry, and a touch of licorice. Layers of dark fruit unfold on the palate, complemented by subtle notes of lightly toasted oak. Rich yet composed, it carries through to a soft, elegant finish that pairs beautifully with grilled meats, roasted vegetables, and rustic, seasonal fare.
