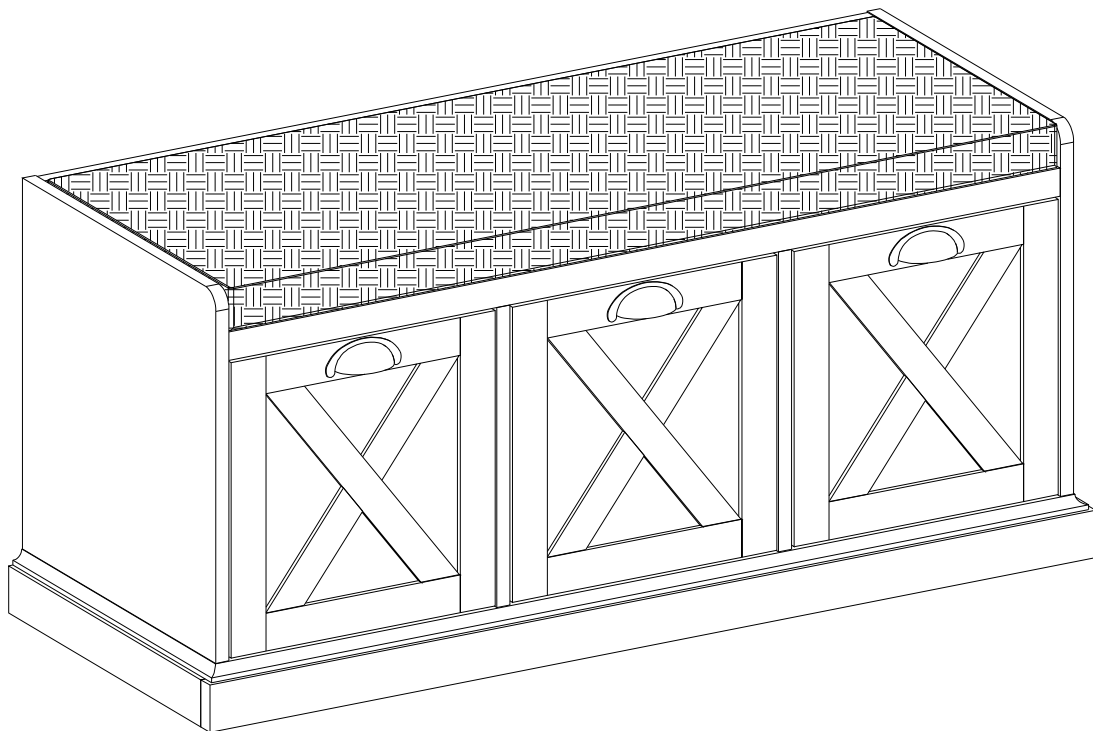

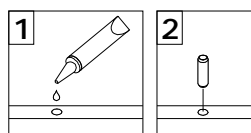

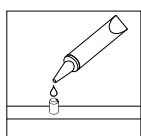

General Assembly Guidelines

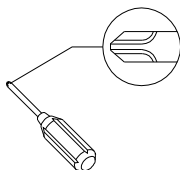
- I. Ensure that all parts and hardware are available before beginning assembly.
- II. Follow each step carefully to ensure the proper assembly of this product.
- III. Two people are recommended for ease in the assembly of this product.
- IV. The three main types of hardware used to assemble this product are: wood dowels, screws and bolts.
- V. The provided glue is to secure wood dowels in place. When first inserting dowels, locate the appropriate hole for the dowel, place a small amount of glue in the hole and insert the dowel. Wipe away excess glue immediately.



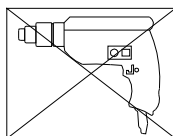
In future assembly steps when dowels are necessary to attach assembly parts together, place a small amount of glue on the end of the dowel before attaching parts together. Wipe away excess glue immediately.



- VI. A Phillips head screwdriver is required for the assembly of this product .

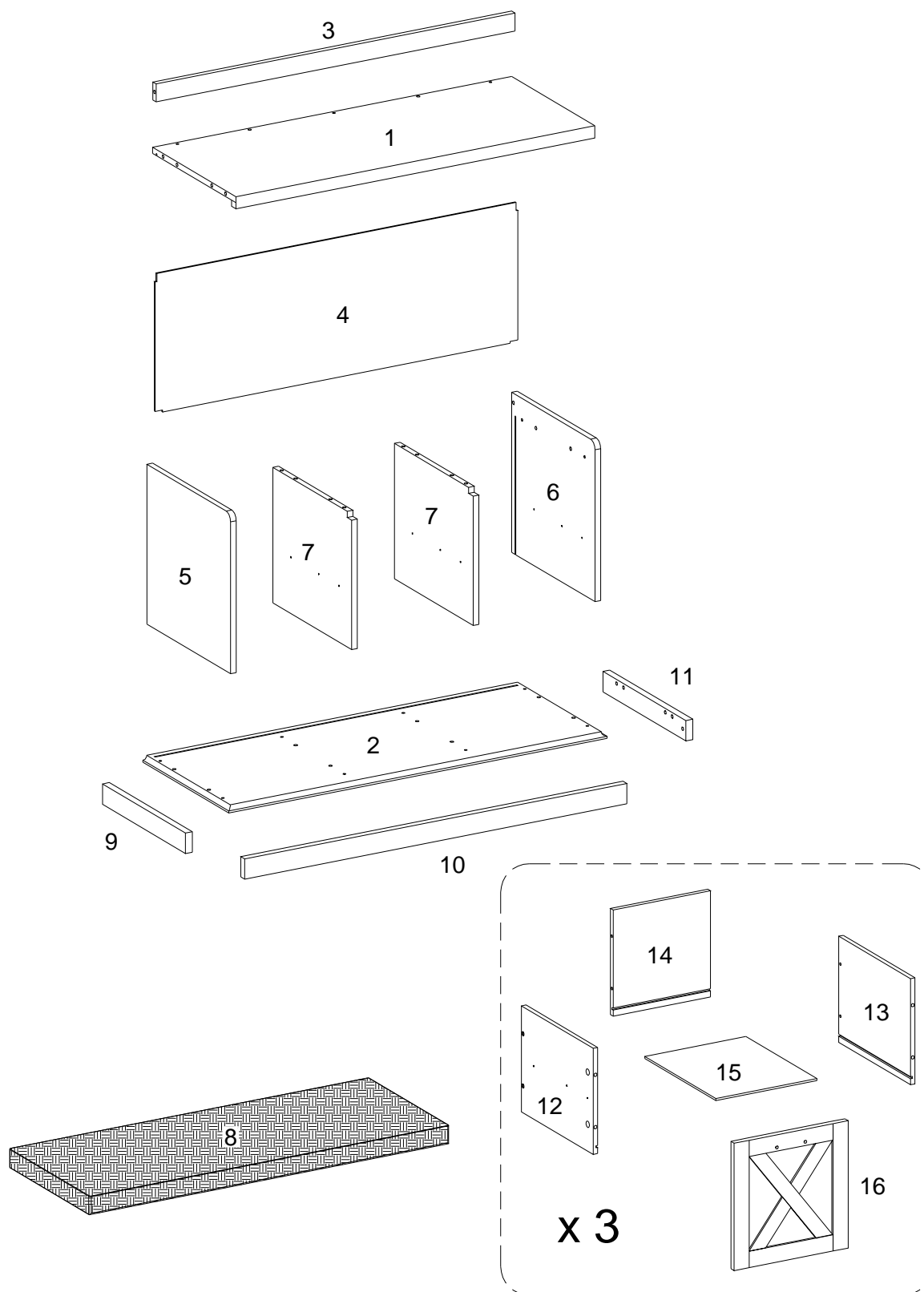


- VII. Power tools should not be used to assemble this product.

















Step 1



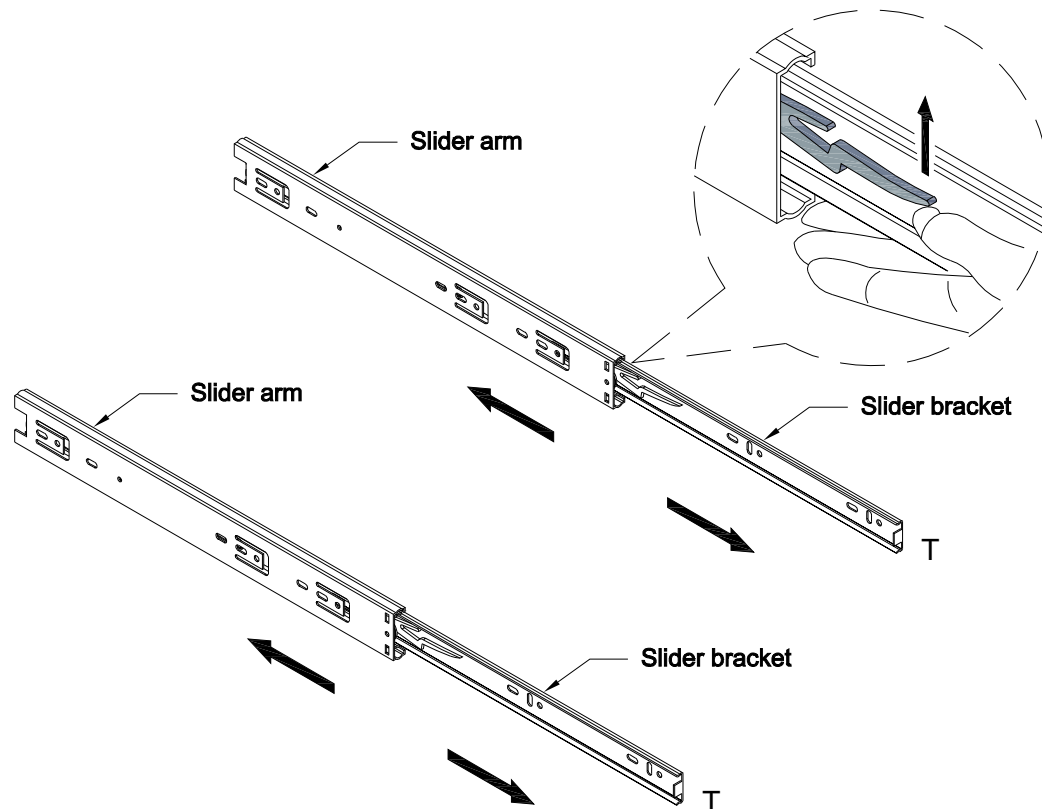
Insert wooden dowel (A) into parts (3,7) as per diagram.

Step 2



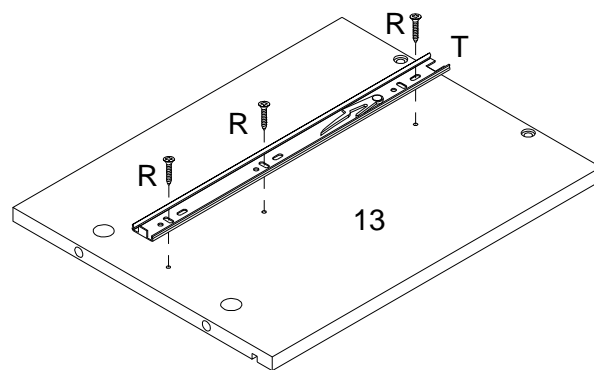
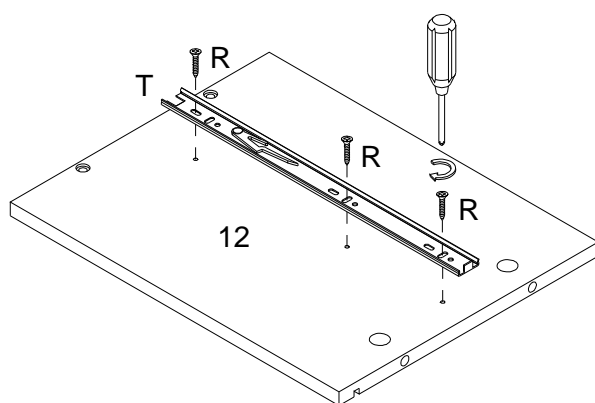
Insert wooden dowel (A) into parts (1,5,6), then secure cam bolt (B) into parts (1,5,6) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

Step 3



Pick up the slider arm (T) and separate the slide runner for the following Steps. Extend the slide runner all the way forward, press the plastic release lever of the slider arm up and pull the slide runner complete out .

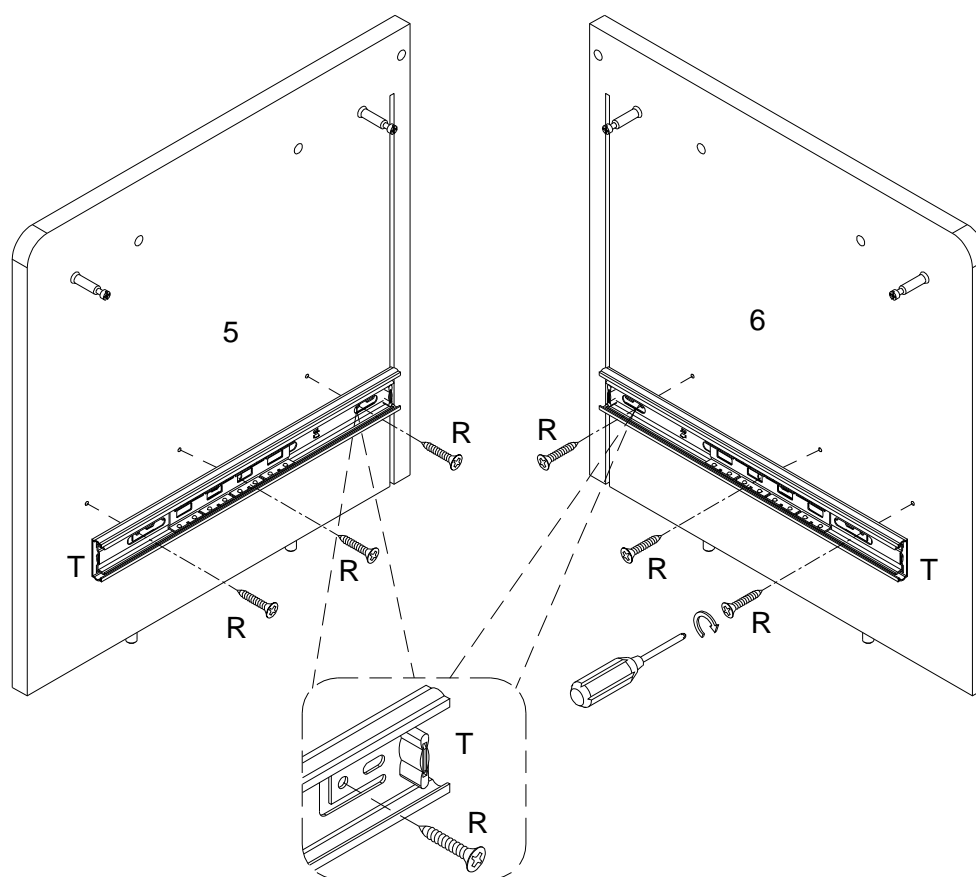

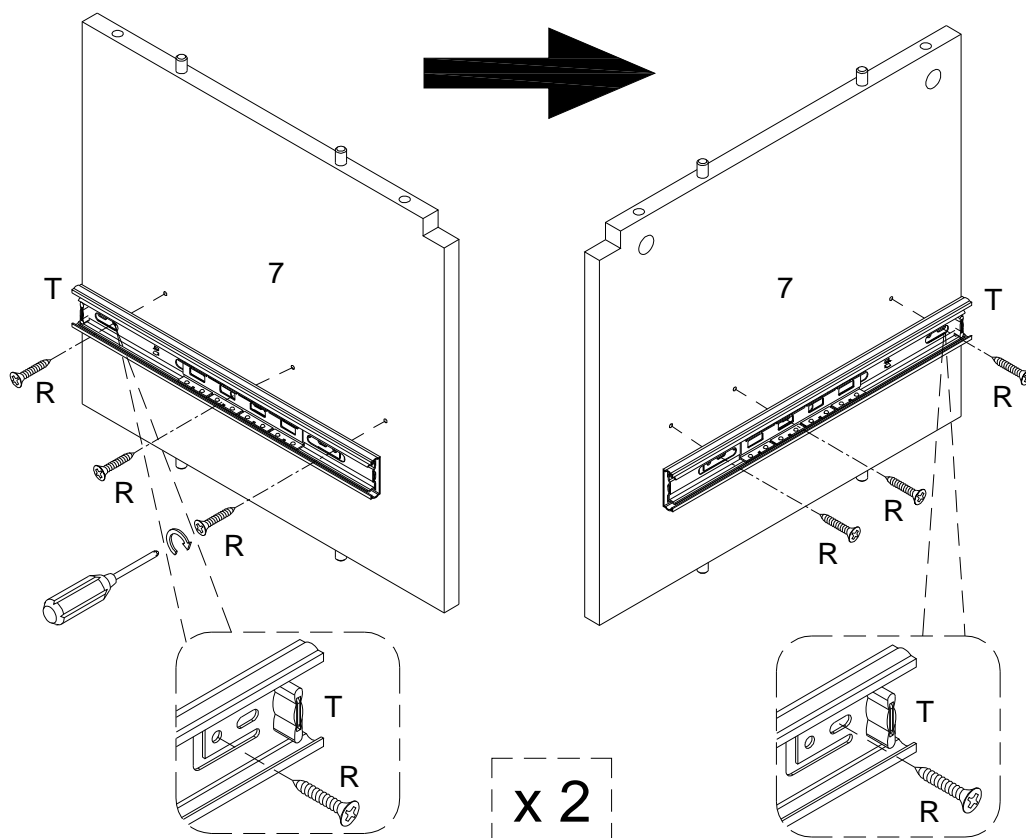
Using screw (R) attach Drawer slider (T) to parts (12,13) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

Step 5



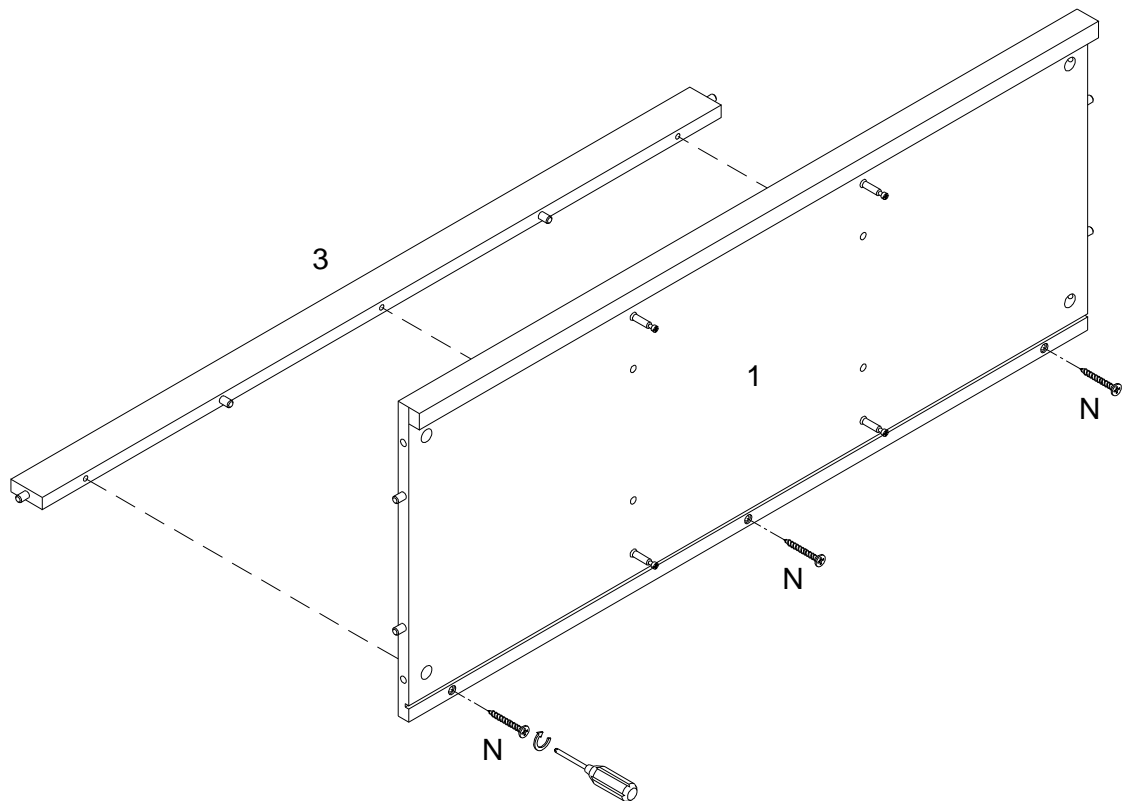
Using screw (R) attach Drawer slider (T) to parts (5,6) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

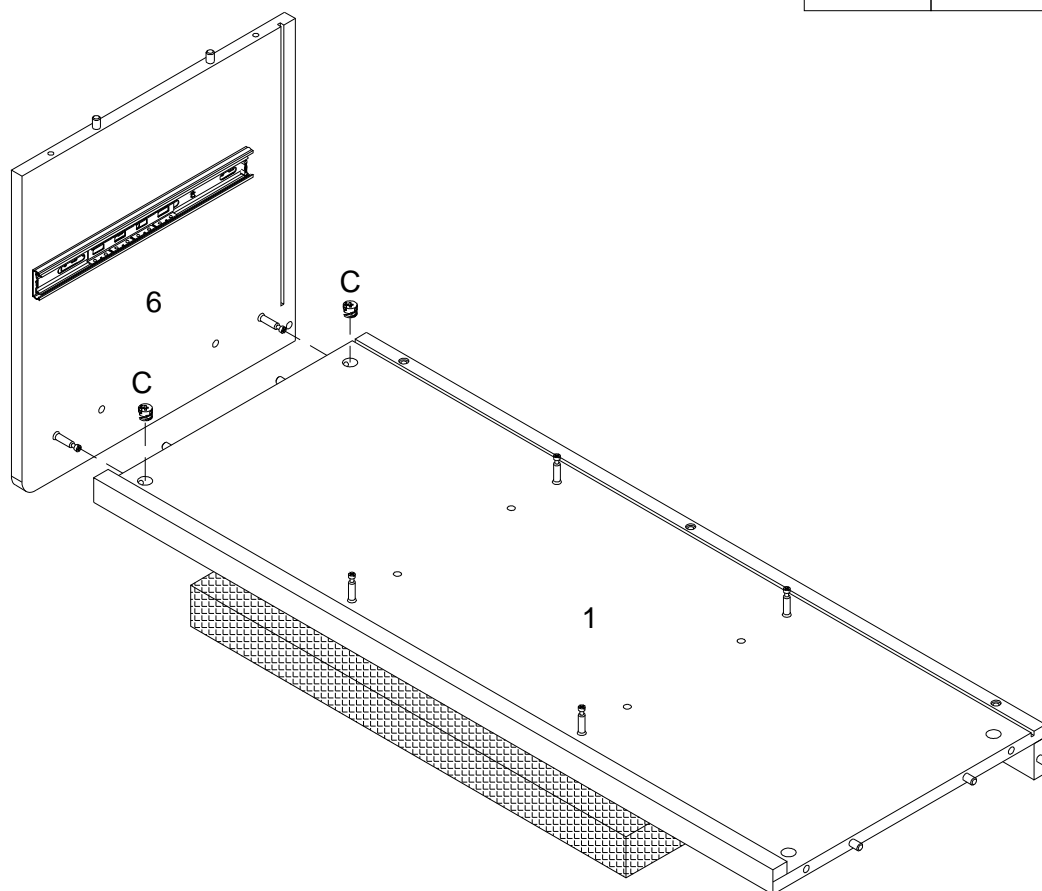
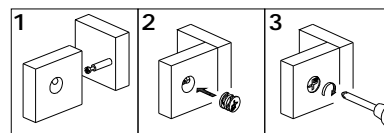
Using screw (R) attach Drawer slider (T) to part (7) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

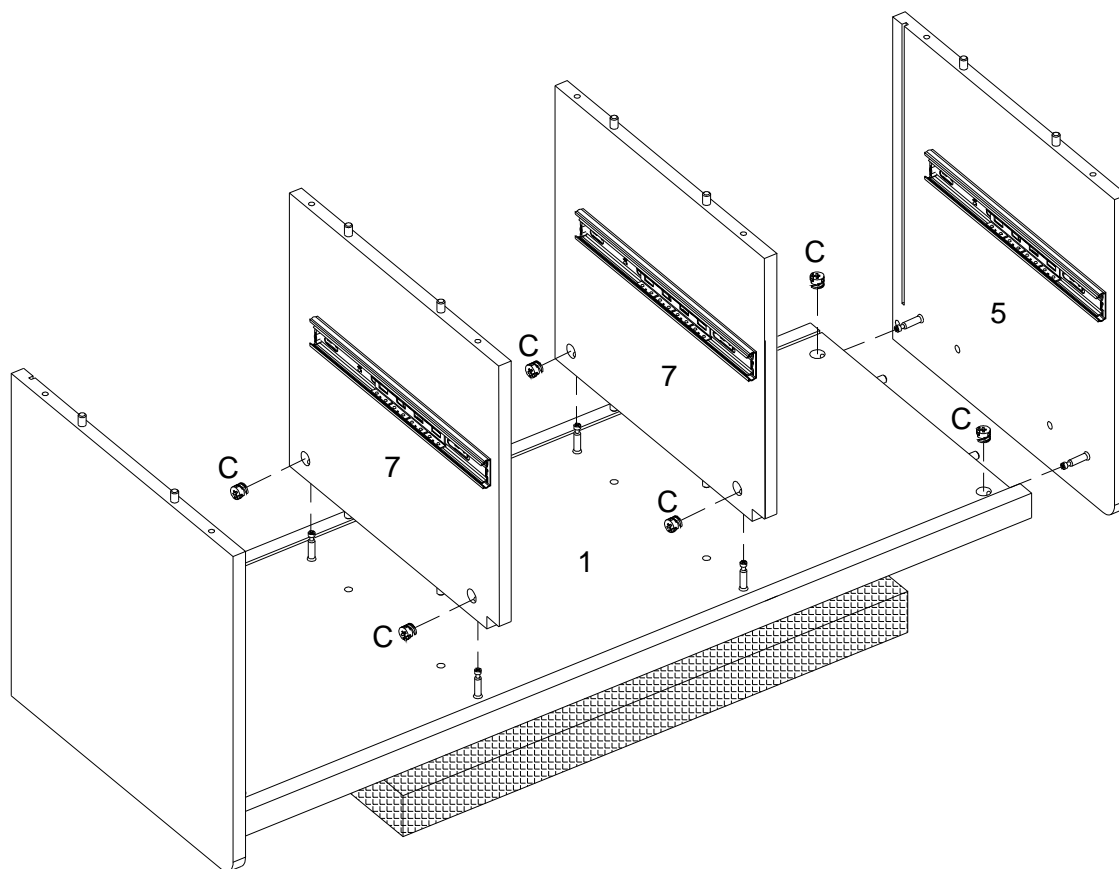
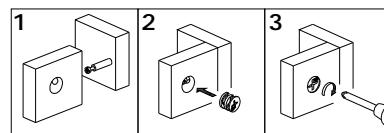
Using screw (N) secure part (3) to part (1) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

Step 8



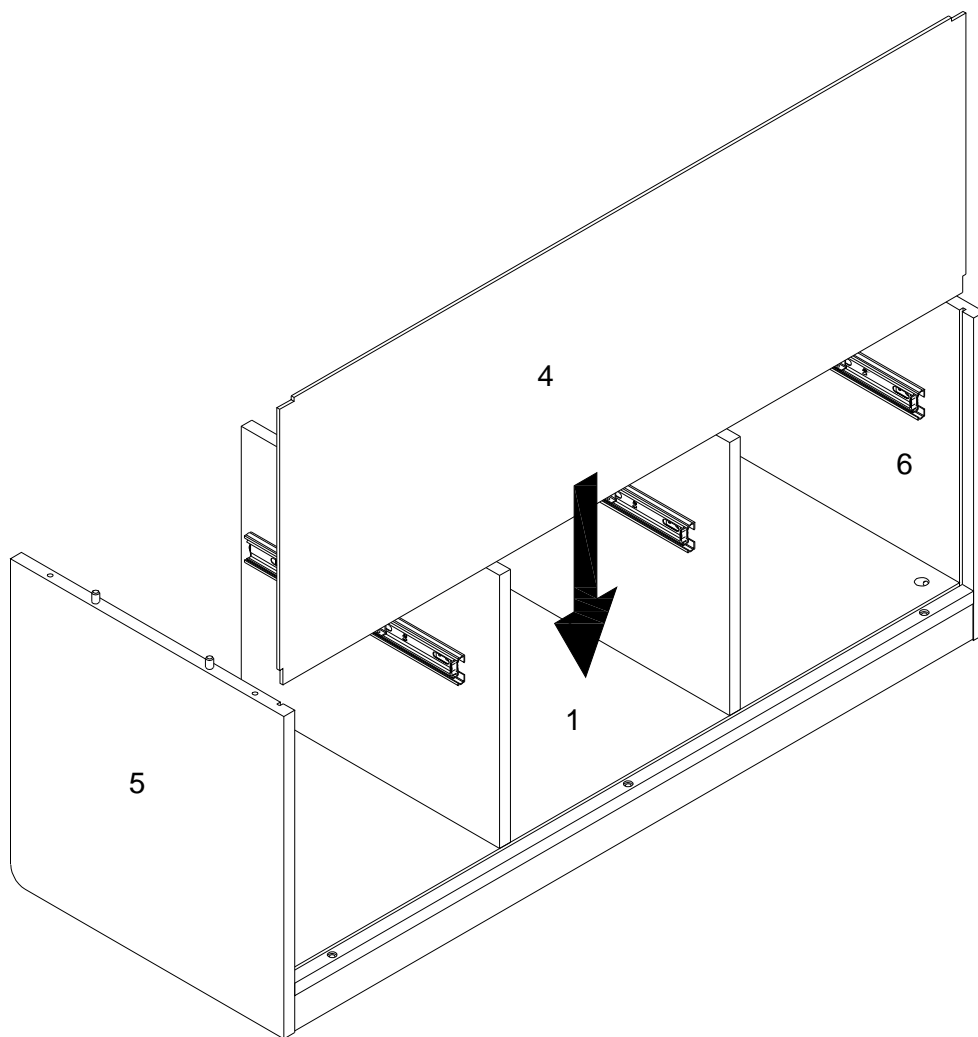
Using Cam lock(C) secure part (6) to part (1) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

Step 9



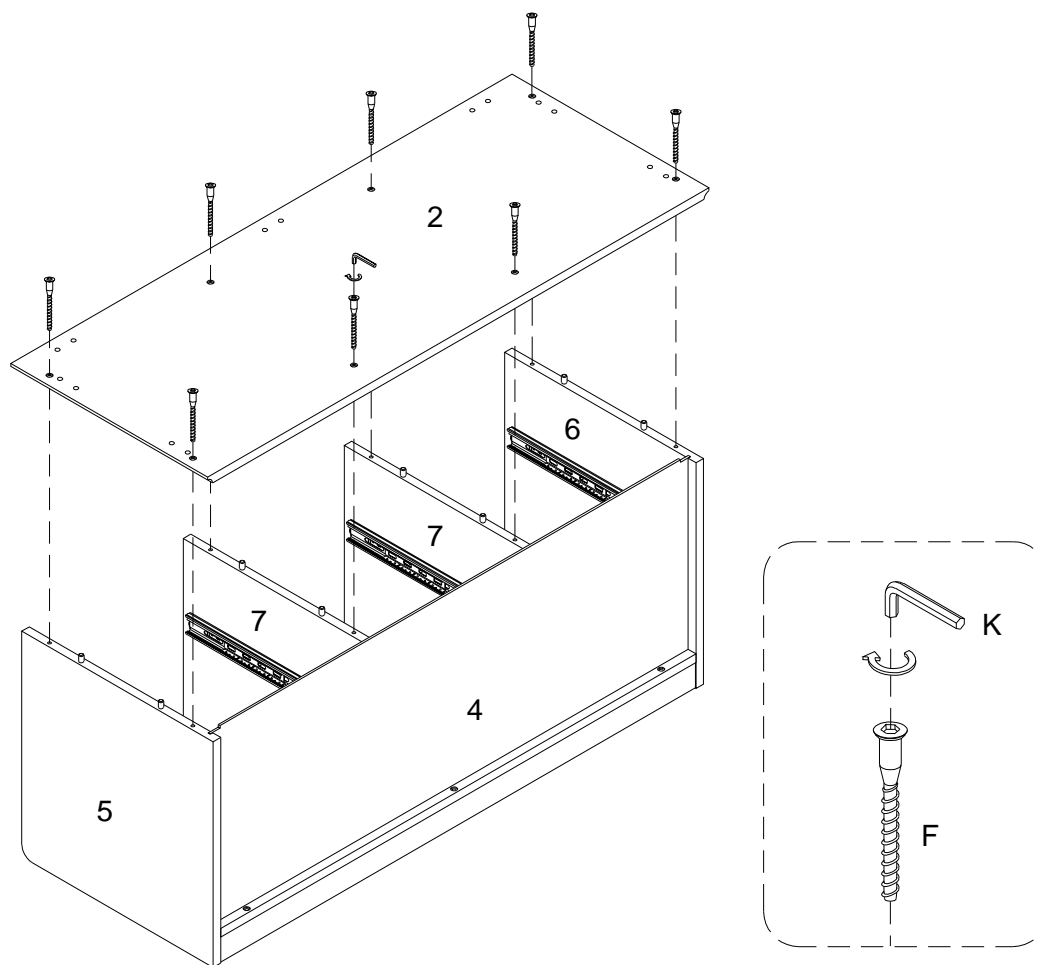
Using Cam lock(C) secure parts (5,7) to part (1) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

Step 10



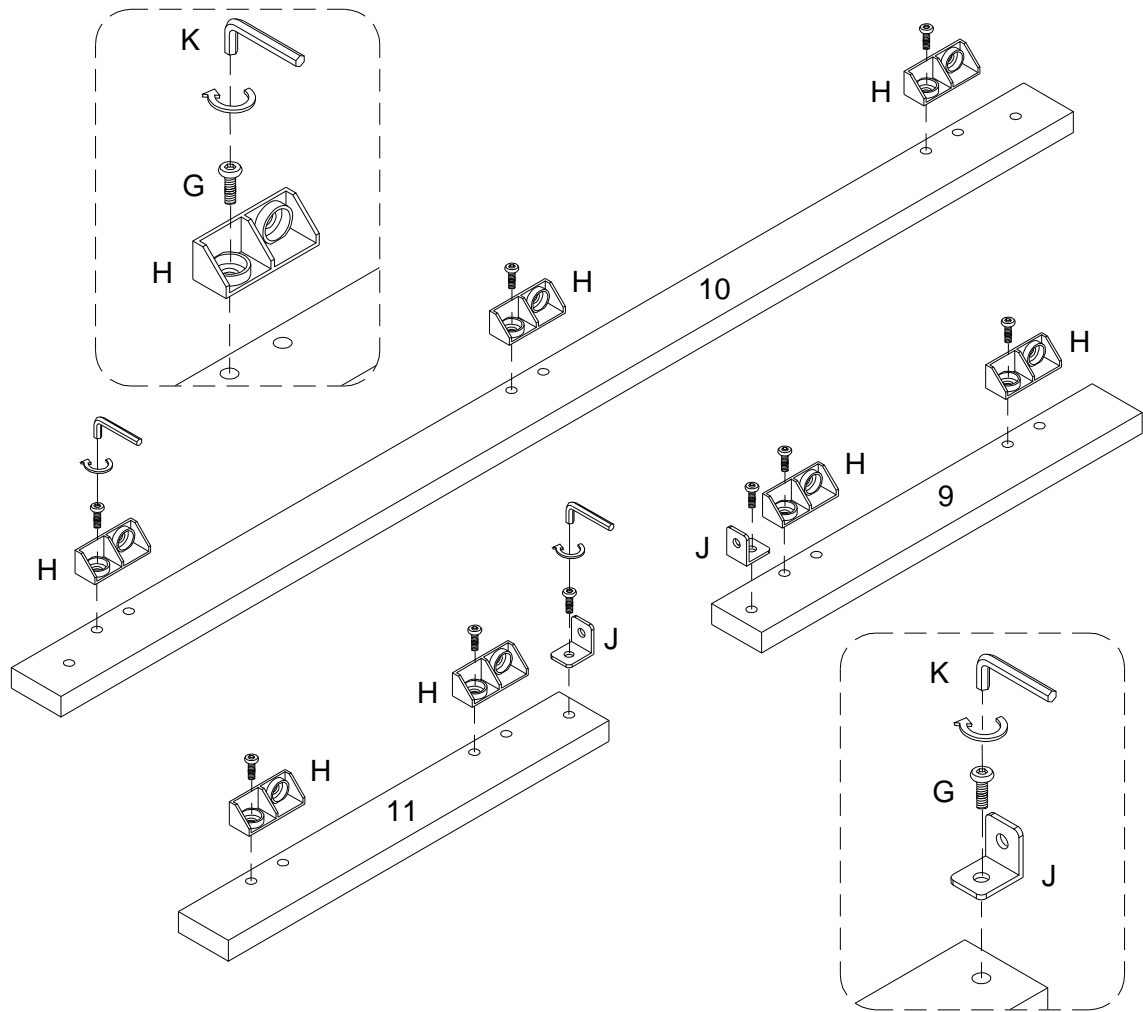
Put part (4) as per diagram.

Step 11



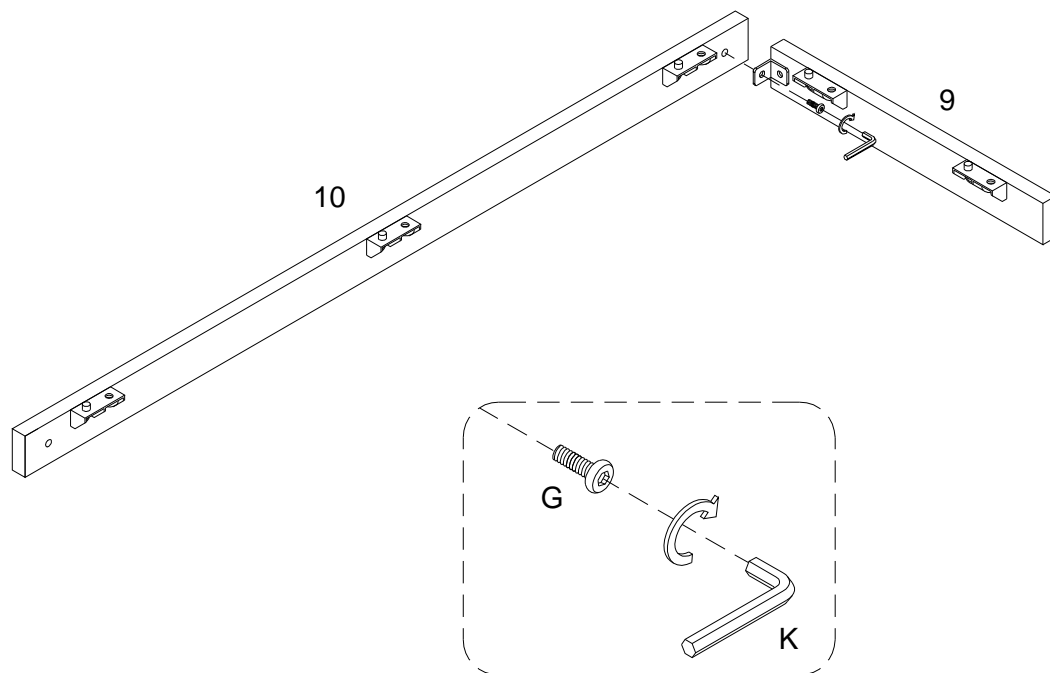
Using screw (F) attach part (2) into parts (5,6,7) with Hex key (K) as per diagram.

Step 12



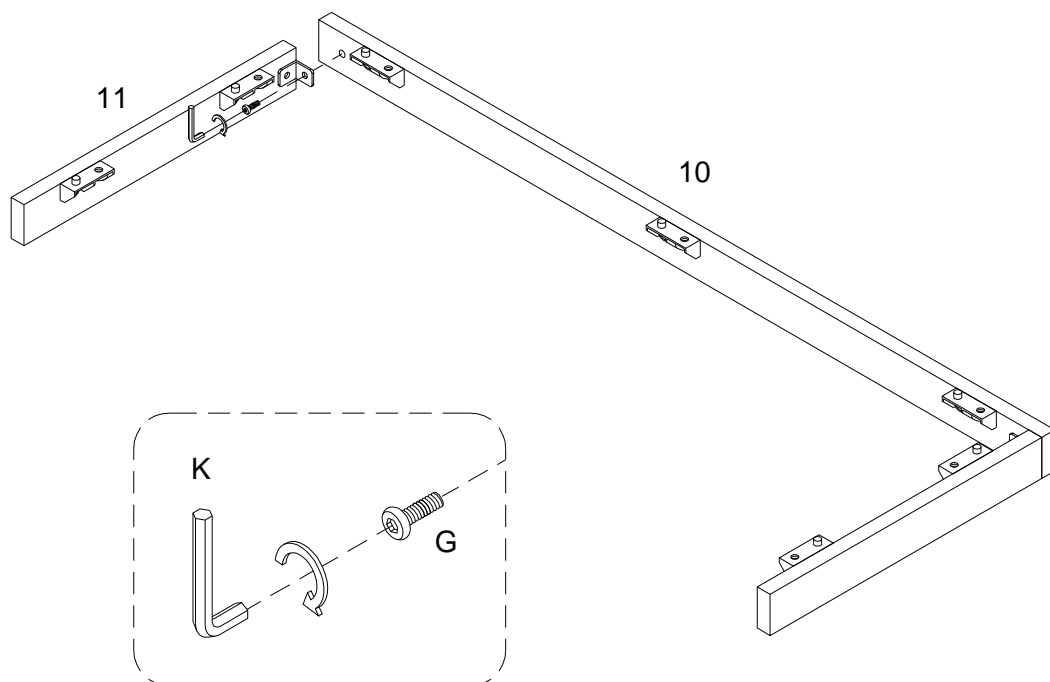
Using Bolt (G) attach plastic wedge (H) to parts (9,10,11) ,and using bolt (G) attach Connecting iron sheet (J) to parts (9,11) with Hex key (K) as per diagram.

Step 13



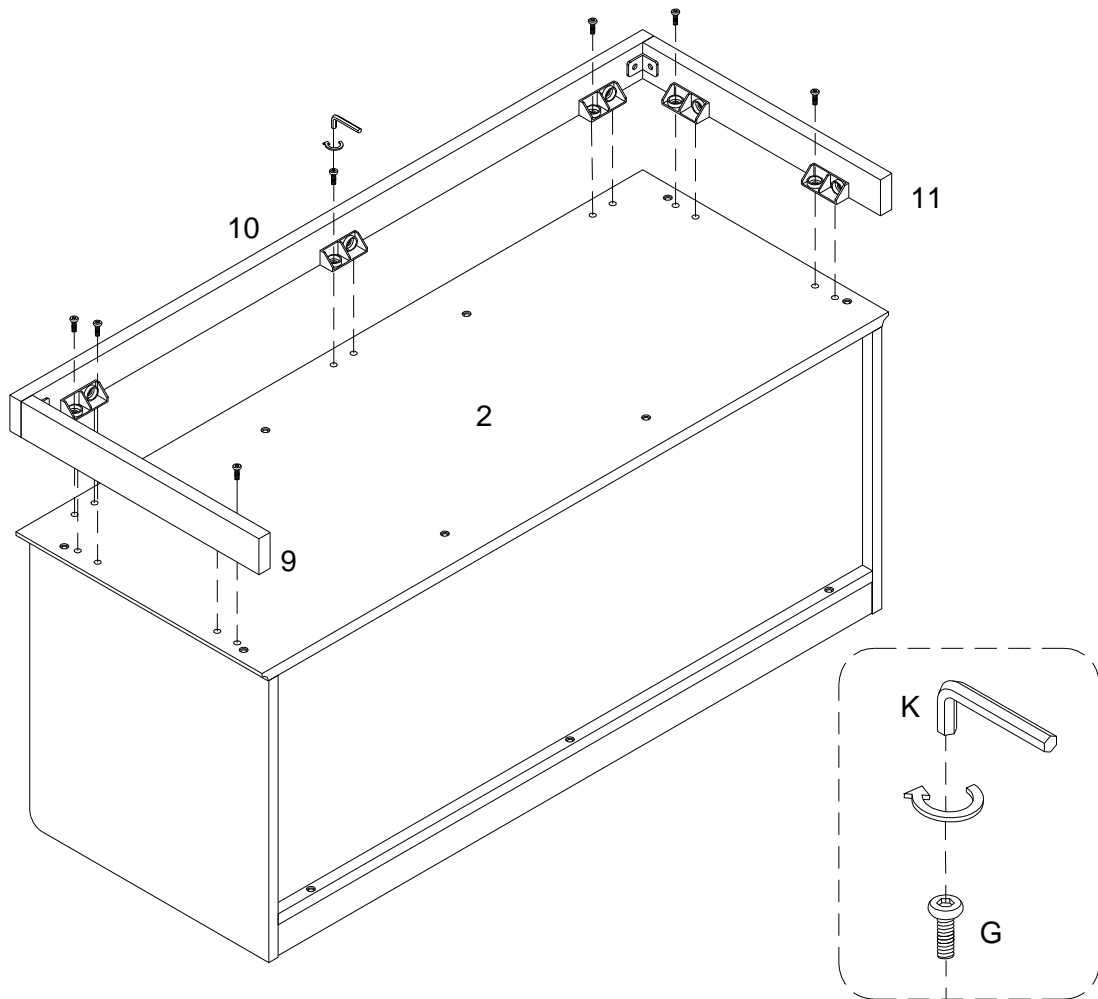
Using bolt (G) attach connecting iron sheet on part (9) to part (10) with Hex key (K) as per diagram.

Step 14



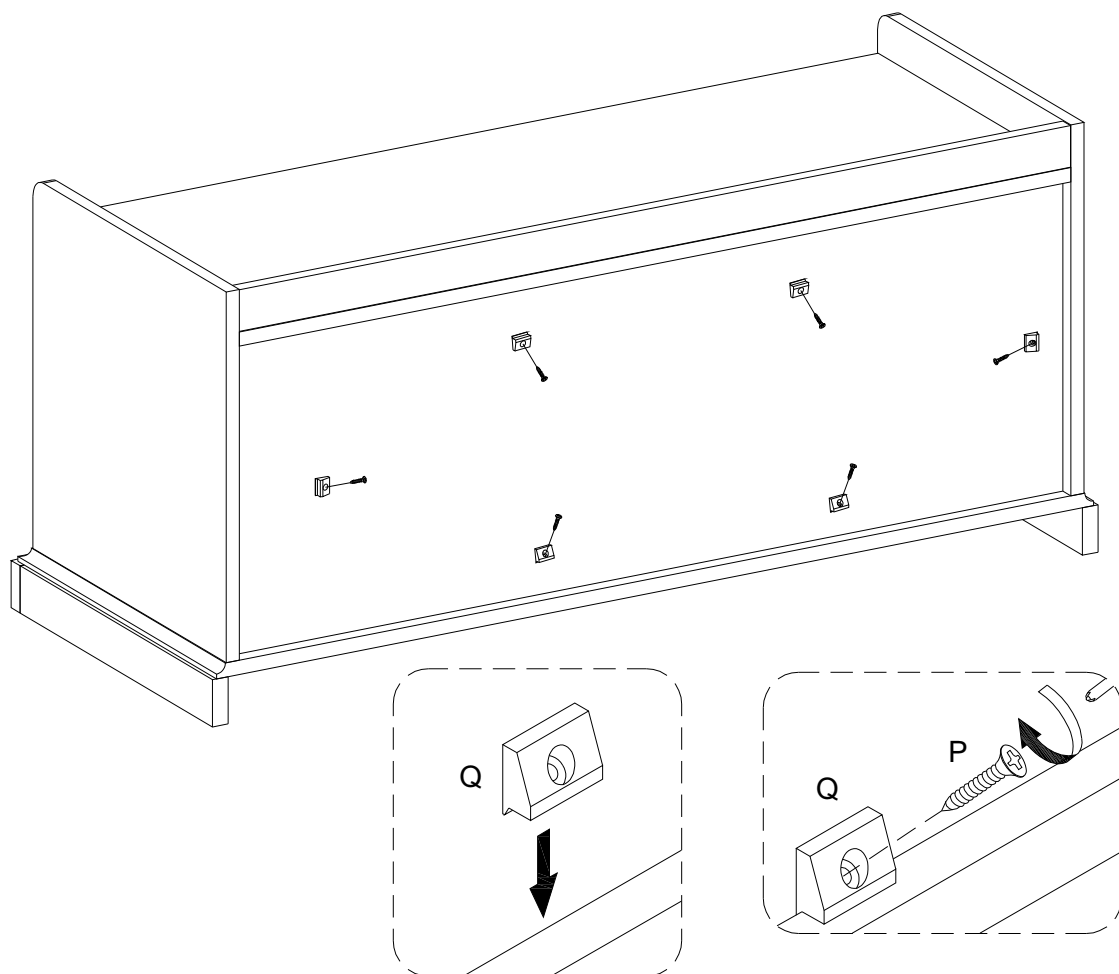
Using bolt (G) attach connecting iron sheet on part (11) to part (10) with Hex key (K) as per diagram.

Step 15



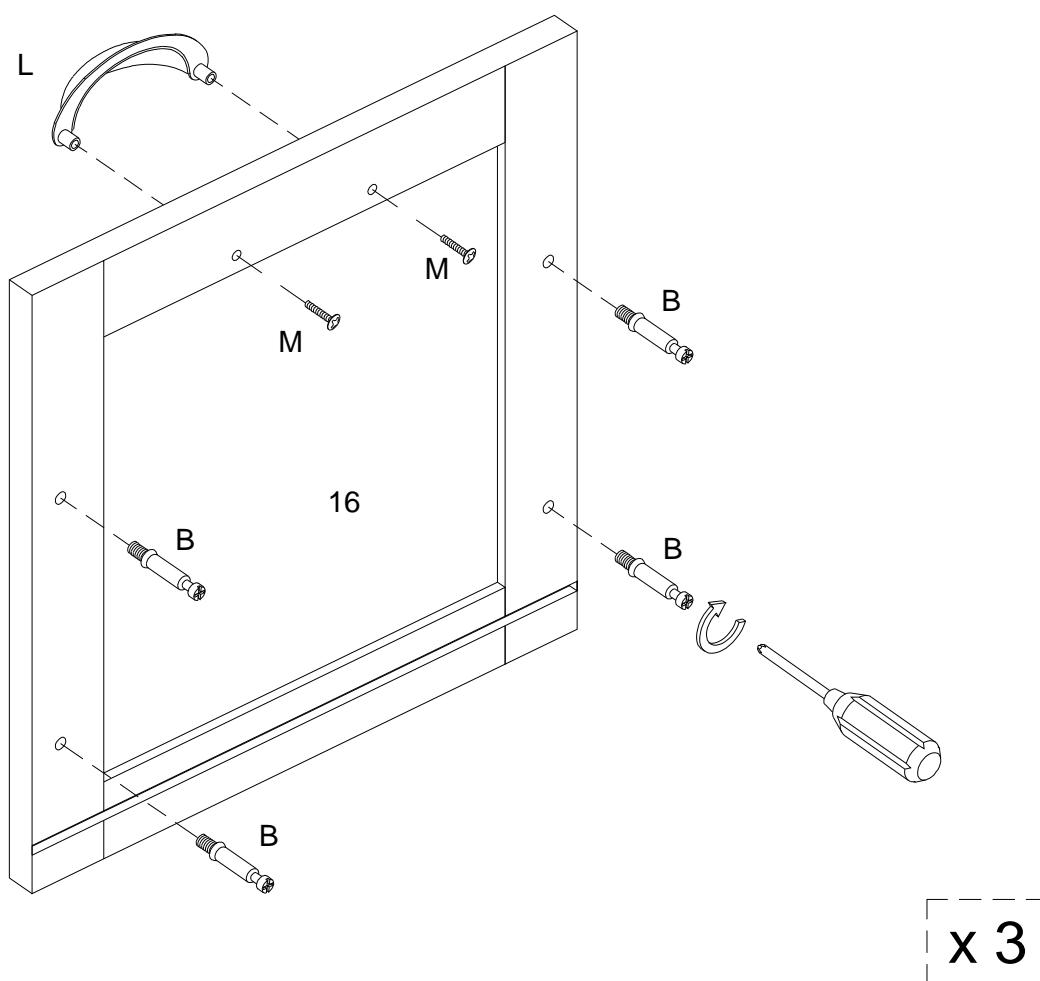
Using bolt (G) attach plastic wedge on parts (9,10,11) to part (2) with Hex key (K) as per diagram.

Step 16



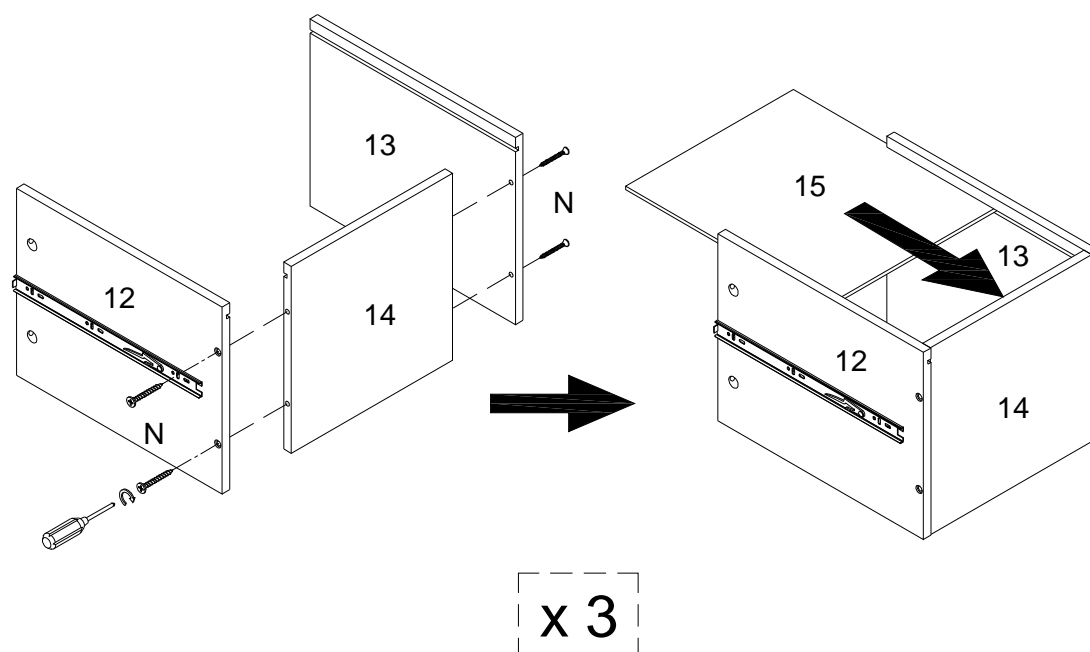
Using screw (P) secure plastic wedge (Q) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

Step 17



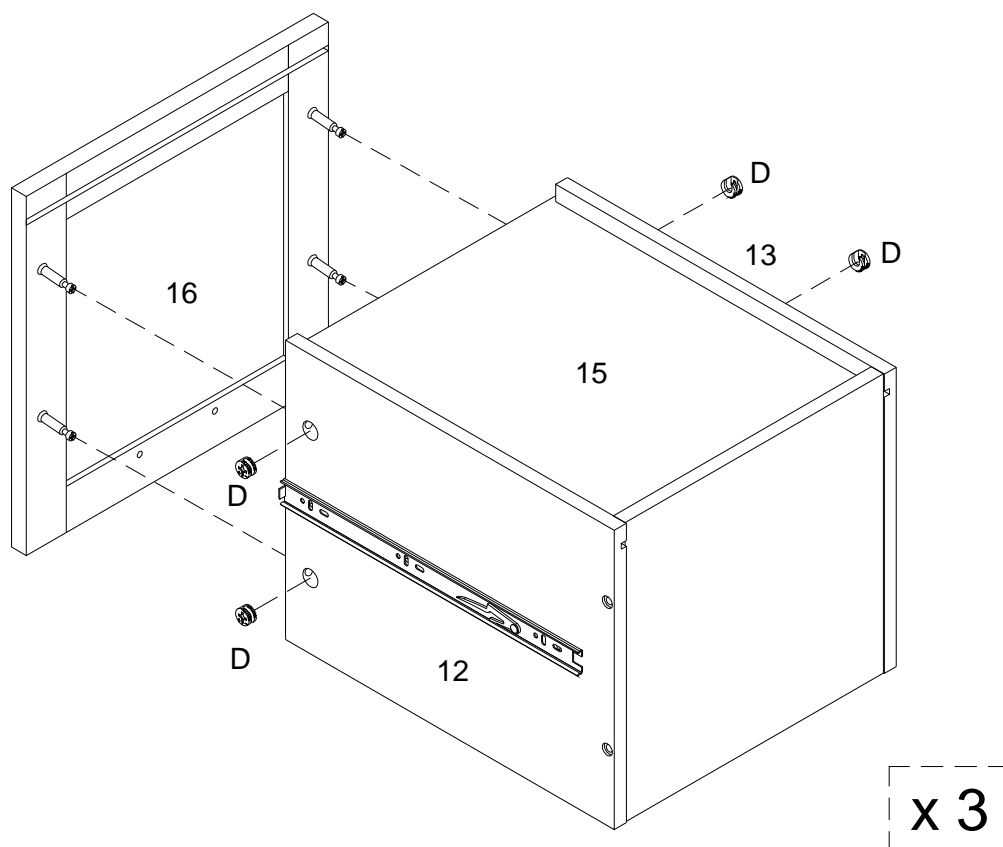
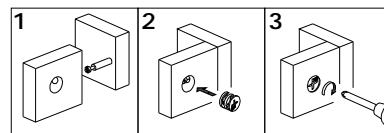
Secure cam bolt (B) into part (16), and using handle bolt (M) secure handle (L) to part (16) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

Step 18



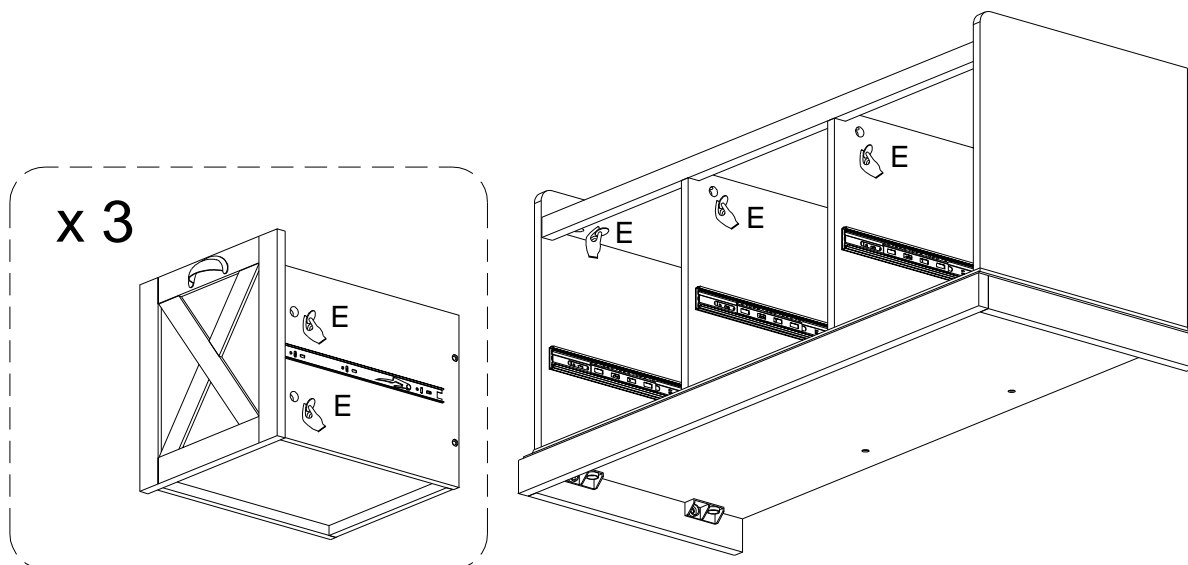
Using screw (N) attach parts (12,13) to part (14) with Philips head screwdriver, then put part (15) as per diagram.

Step 19



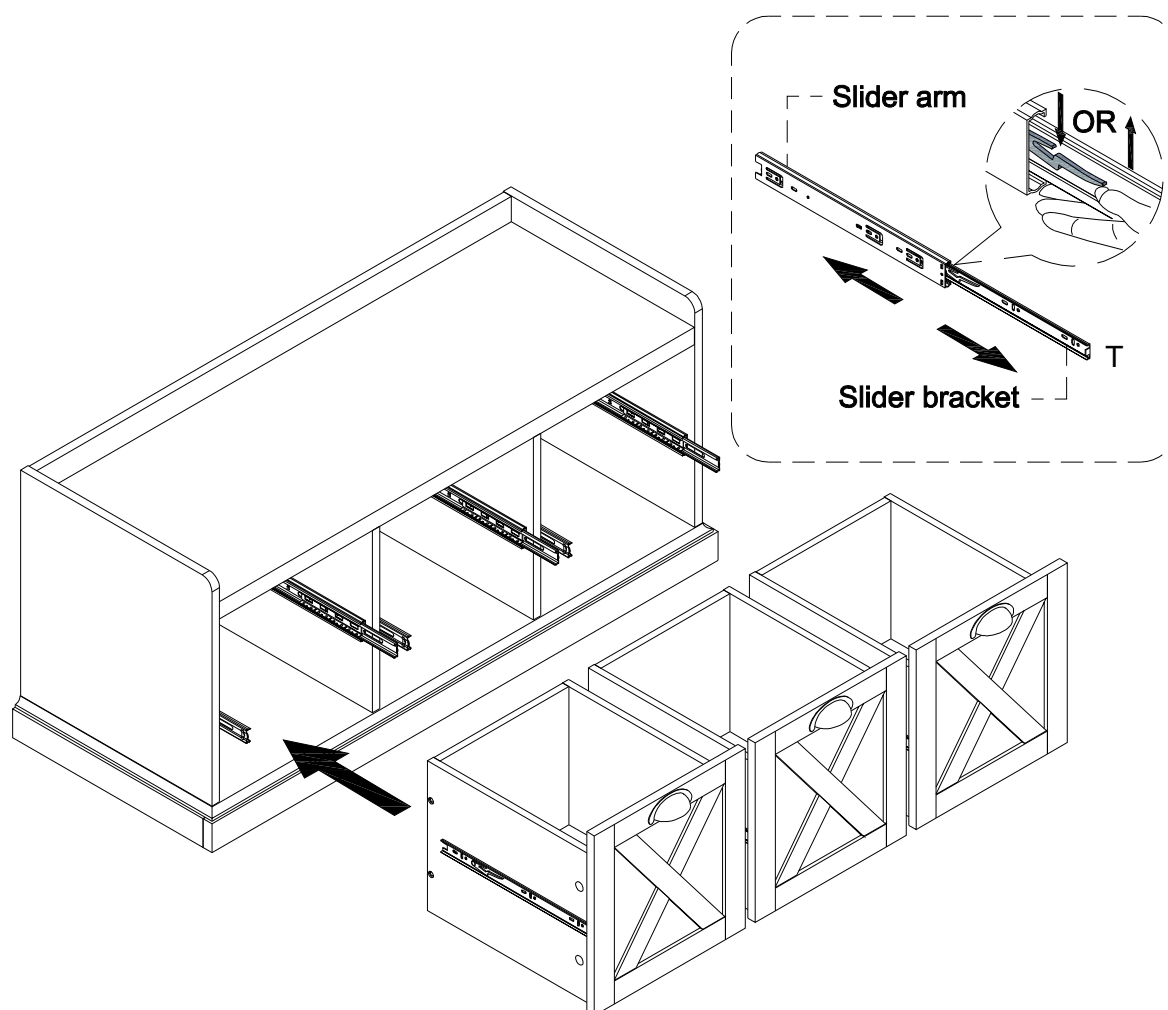
Using Cam lock(D) secure part (16) to parts (12,13) with Philips head screwdriver as per diagram.

Step 20



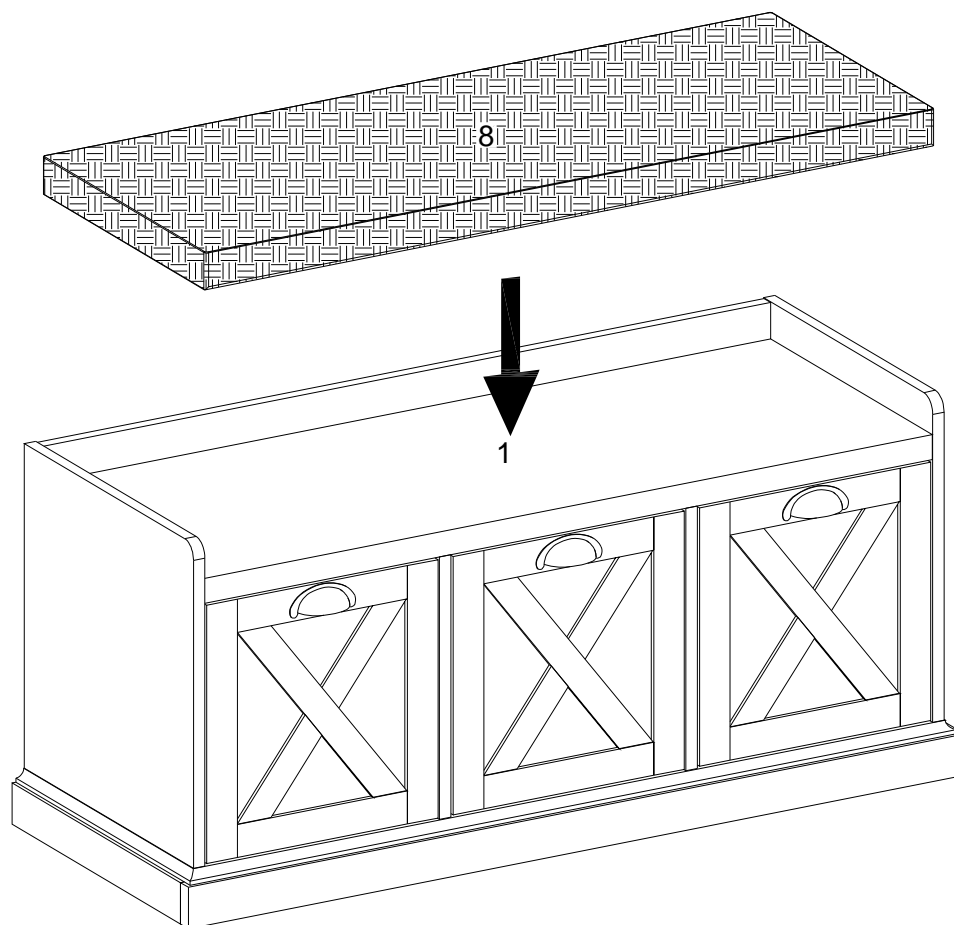
Place sticker (E) cover the holes as per diagram .

Step 21



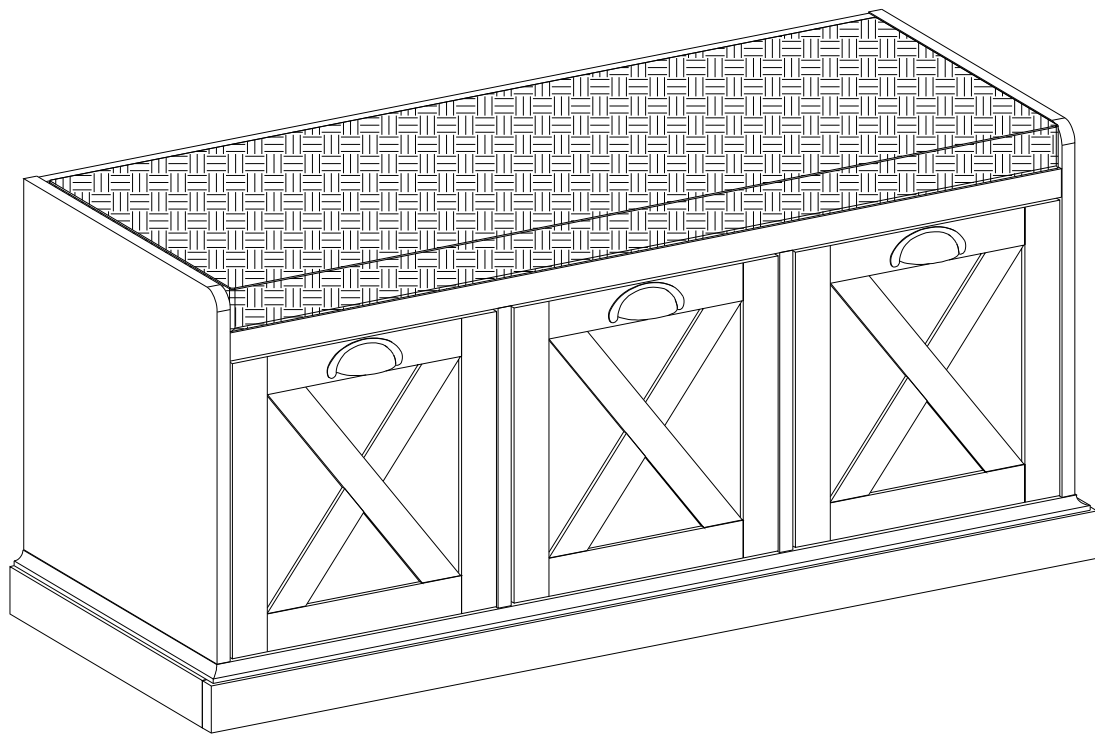
Insert the assembled drawers into the unit frame, extend the Ball Bearing Slide Tracks (T) on the pedestal Side Panel all the way forward .Then align the Slide Runners on the assembled drawers with the Slide Tracks and push the drawer carefully inside until it stops.
Note : if the drawer does not go in smoothly, please take it out and repeat the step.
If you need to remove the drawer, please pull the drawer all the way out,press or lift the plastic release lever and pull out the drawer and then re-assembled the drawer until it was going in smoothly .

Place the cushion (8) on the top of part (1) as per diagram.
