


## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION







This page lists all the contents included in the box. Please take the time to identify the hardware as well as the individual components to this product. As you unpack and prepare for assembly, place the contents on a carpeted or padded area to protect them from damage. Pull out the drawer from Top Panel (A). Lift the top, and attach 2pcs Metal Leg (C) to Top Panel (A) using Bolt (D), Spring Washer (E), Flat Washer (F) by Wrench (G), then lid Plastic Cap (H) on it.




2 Turn the assembled unit down and attach the 3rd Metal Leg (C) to the Top Panel (A) using Bolt (D), Spring Washer (E) and Flat Washer (F) by Wrench (G).



3 Attach the Bottom Shelf (B) to the 3pcs Metal Leg (C) using Bolt (D), Spring Washer (E) and Flat Washer (F) by Wrench (G). Then attach the 4th Metal Leg (C) to both Bottom Shelf (B) and Top Panel (A) by the same method. Finally lock them up to 100%.




Turn over the table and put the drawer in.




Cleaning & Care





2 Attach Bottom Shelf (B) to 3pcs Metal Leg (C) using Bolt (D), Spring Washer (E) and Flat Washer (F) by Wrench (G). Then attach the 4th Metal Leg (C) to both Bottom Shelf (B) and Top Panel (A) by the same method. Finally attach Caster (H) to the Bottom Shelf (B) by using Screw (I) with Screwdriver (not provided).
