

Beldray 2 Step Ladder

Care and use

The maximum permissible weight on the ladder is 150 kg. Users should exercise caution as there is a risk of falling, and it is crucial to identify any electrical hazards in the work area, such as overhead lines or exposed electrical equipment; the ladder must not be used in such conditions. To ensure optimum health and safety, all warnings and safety measures should be adhered to. The distributor is responsible for providing usage information alongside the ladder, and the ladder owner must ensure this information is accessible to users. Prior to use, users should refer to the instruction manual and conduct a visual inspection of the ladder to confirm it is free from damage and safe to use. It is important to avoid using the ladder on uneven surfaces, not to overreach, and to refrain from using it in contaminated areas. Only one person should ascend the ladder at a time, ensuring they face the ladder while going up or down, maintaining a secure grip at all times. Users should avoid carrying heavy or cumbersome equipment while on the ladder and should wear appropriate footwear. The ladder should only be used by individuals who are fit to do so, as certain medical conditions or the influence of alcohol or drugs can compromise safety. The ladder is designed solely for domestic use, and users should not step off the side of the ladder onto another surface. Always fully open the ladder before use and ensure that it is used only with engaged restraint devices. Standing ladders must not be employed as leading ladders unless specifically designed for that purpose, and users should not stand on the top two steps without adequate support. Repairs must be performed by qualified personnel according to the manufacturer's guidelines, and the ladder should be stored in a manner that prevents deterioration, damage, or unauthorised access. Regular checks of the ladder's integrity and condition are mandatory, and any defects or issues must be addressed immediately as it is prohibited to use the ladder if any safety parameters are not met. When using the ladder, it is advised to take regular breaks to reduce fatigue, transport it carefully to prevent damage, and ensure that it is suitable for the intended task. Users must remove any dirt from the ladder and should not operate it in severe weather conditions. Extra care should be taken when positioning the ladder, keeping potential hazards in mind, and it is advisable to secure any nearby doors and windows during use. Only ladders made of non-conductive materials should be used for electrical work, and it is strictly forbidden to modify the ladder's structure or to shift the ladder while standing on it.
