
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION







*** Do not tighten screws & bolts until the entire unit is completely assembled.


Attach Horizontal Stretcher (E), Stretcher H (H) and Stretcher G (G) to Left Upper Panel (A) and Right Upper Panel (B) by Bolt (L) and Allen Wrench (R) as shown.

*Please note the direction of stretcher.




Attach Vertical Stretcher (F) to Horizontal Stretcher (E), Stretcher H (H) and Stretcher G (G) by Bolt (L) and Allen Wrench (R) as shown.



Attach Left Under Panel (C), Right Under Panel (D) and Middle Stretcher (I) to Left Upper Panel (A) and Right Upper Panel (B) by Bolt (L) and Allen Wrench (R). Then, attach Horizontal Stretcher (E) to Left Under Panel (C) and Right Under Panel (D) by Bolt (L) and Allen Wrench (R) as shown.




Attach Vertical Stretcher (F) to Horizontal Stretcher (E) and Middle Stretcher (I) by Bolt (L) and Allen Wrench (R) as shown.





Attach Stretcher H (H) and Stretcher G (G) to Left Under Panel (C), Right Under Panel (D) and Vertical Stretcher (F) by Bolt (L) and Allen Wrench (R) as shown.



Attach Small Wood Shelf (J) to assembled metal rack by Screw (M) as shown.





Attach Large Wood Shelf (K) to assembled metal rack by Screw (M) as shown.

Select a location where you want the shelf mounted. Mark on the wall the two locations where the Wall Anchors (P) will be placed. Drill a hole for each anchor slightly smaller than the size of Screws (N). Push the Wall Anchors (P) as far as it will go with your finger. Tap gently with a hammer until the anchors are in. Then align the L Brackets (O) to the Wall Anchors (P) and insert Screws (N) to secure.





Cleaning & Care

Treat surface with care. Surface is resistant to scratches but is not scratch resistant. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.
