

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING IMPORTANT: NEVER attempt any work without shutting off the electricity.

- Read all instructions before installing.
- System is intended for installation by a qualified electrician in accordance with the National Electrical Code and local regulations.
- Go to the main fuse box, or circuit breaker. Place the main power switch in the "OFF" position and unscrew the fuse(s) or switch "OFF" the circuit breaker switch(es) that control the power to the fixture or room that you are working on.
- Place the wall switch in the "OFF" position.
- Supply conductors (Power Wires) Connecting the fixture must be rated minimum 90°C. If uncertain, consult an electrician.

TOOLS REQUIRED

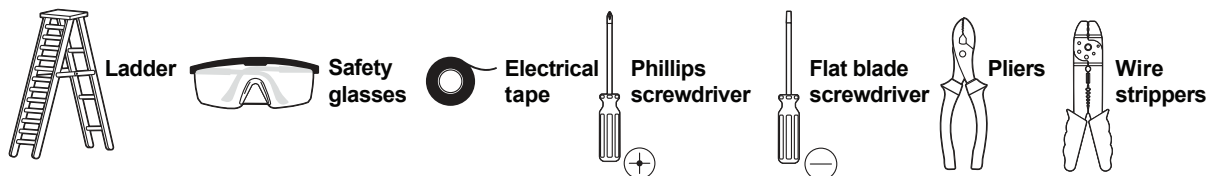


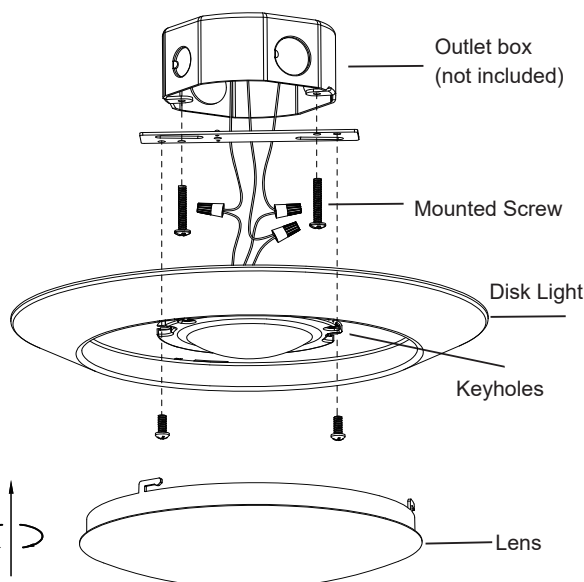

HOUSING INSTALLATION

1. Prior to installation, install the mounting bracket on the junction box with mounting screws. Drive screws completely to the end of the junction box. (Fig.1)

ELECTRICAL CONNECTION

1. Connect supply wires to wires on fixture with wirenuts. Connect white to white, black to black and green wire to green wire as grounding connection.
2. Rotate to open the shade and install the fixture to the mounting bracket with screws.



NOTE: Select desired LED color temperature by using the switch of luminaire situated on canopy for the color temperature selectable items.

LENS INSTALLATION

1. Twist the lens on disk light metal enclosure and lock the lens in place.
