

Easy Fold 2 Step Ladder

Please retain instructions for future reference.

CARE AND USE

Max. weight: 150 kg.

Warning: There is danger of falling from the ladder.

Electricity hazard: Identify any electrical risks in the work area, such as overhead lines or other exposed electrical equipment and do not use the ladder where electrical risks occur.

Please read all of the instructions carefully and retain for future reference.

Pay special attention to all warnings and measures for optimum health and safety.

General information: The distributor must make sure that the usage information is provided together with the ladder.

The owner of the ladder must make sure that the information is available to the ladder user.

Always inspect the ladder visually before every use to check it is not damaged and safe to use.

Max. total load is 150 kg.

Do not use the ladder on uneven bases.

Do not overreach.

Do not erect or use the ladder on contaminated ground.

Max. 1 person on the ladder at any time.

Do not ascend or descend unless you are facing the ladder.

Keep a secure grip on the ladder when ascending and descending.

Maintain a handhold (e.g. handrail) to work around.

Take additional safety precautions if you cannot avoid work at height in a bad weather (wind).

Do not use the ladder if you feel unfit, not confident or under the influence of alcohol or drug abuse could make ladder use unsafe.

Warning: Electricity hazard: Identify any electrical risks in the work area such as overhead lines or other exposed electrical equipment and do not use the ladder in those areas.

Do not use the ladder for unintended work, e.g. bridging between two platforms.

Do not stand on top steps/rungs if a standing ladder without a platform and hand/knee rail.

Repair, maintenance and storage: Repairs must be carried out by a competent person following the manufacturer's instructions.

Please contact the manufacturer for repair or spare parts (for example, stops, feet).

Store the ladder according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Do not store the ladder in rooms which could accelerate the deterioration of the ladder (e.g. humidity, excessive heat, etc).

Keep the ladder in a vertical position (e.g. by a total access distance) to prevent it from falling.

Keep the ladder in a way that prevents the possibility of use for criminal purposes.

Keep the ladder in restricted spaces that prevent unauthorized use (e.g. out of reach of children).

During regular checks, observe the following: Check the integrity of the legs and structure to make sure they are not twisted, scratched, dented or rusted.

Check the feet of the legs to make sure they are not damaged.

Check the fixings (rivets, screws) are not missing or loose.

Check all the fittings (e.g. locking devices, toggles and bars) are not damaged or missing.

Check the safety devices function correctly.

In the event of defects, do not use the ladder until it has been repaired.

Do not stand on the top step/rung of a stepladder without a platform and handrail.

Do not use a ladder to access another level unless it is properly secured (e.g. tied) and an appropriate additional safety device is used, such as a ladder stabiliser.

Do not use the ladder in adverse weather conditions, for example strong winds.

Use caution when placing the ladder near electrical equipment.

Do not use a dirty ladder, remove dirt, such as paint, oil or snow.

Do not use the ladder in a wet or slippery environment.

Do not modify the ladder design.

Do not move the ladder while standing on it.

Do not use the ladder when there is a risk of collision with a door, the panels or other objects, e.g. the glass.

Do not use the ladder while working.

Avoid climbing with open footwear (not suitable for secure foot placement).

Do not place the ladder on a platform to avoid landing on a breakable surface.

It is forbidden to use the ladder in a wind and rain.

It is forbidden to use ladder made of conductive material for work with electricity.
