
Assemble Connect Support (E) to Counter Frame - LSF (A) & Counter Frame - RSF (B), using Bolt (P) to fasten by Allen Key (X) as below shown.




2 Assemble Stretcher (D) to the top of Counter Frame - LSF (A) and Counter Frame - RSF (B), using Bolt (N) & Flat Washer (U) to tighten by Allen Key (X).




Assemble Counter Top (G) to Counter Frame - LSF (A), Right Frame - RSF (B) and Stretcher (D), using Bolt (N), Bolt (O) and Flat Washer (U) to tighten by Allen Key (X).




Assemble Connect Bar (C) to Counter Frame - LSF (A) & Counter Frame - RSF (B), using Bolt (R) to fasten by Allen Key (X) as below shown.




Assemble Cross Bar (F) to the back of Counter Frame - LSF (A) and Right Frame - RSF (B), using Bolt (S), Hex Nut (W) and Flat Washer (V) to tighten by Spanner (Y) and Screwdriver (Z).




6 Assemble Shelf Board (H) to the Connect Bar (C) as below shown.




Assemble Stool Connect Bar (L) to the Stool Frame (I), using Bolt (P) to fasten by Allen Key (X).




Assemble Stool Connect - Upper (J) & Stool Connect - Lower (K) to Stool Frame (I), using Bolt (P) & Bolt (Q) to fasten by Allen Key (X).



Assemble Stool Cushion (M) to the pre-assembled Stool Frame (I) & Stool Stretcher - Upper (J), using Bolt (T) & Flat Washer (V) by Screwdriver (Z).



Adjust any parts out of alignment and tighten all bolts and screws from step 7 through 10.



Cleaning & Care

Treat surface with care. Surface is resistant to scratches but is not scratch resistant. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.
