Sensory Bin



Enjoy hours of imaginative play! Scoop, sort and explore the treasures inside your sensory bin.

CARE AND SAFETY

* Sensory Sand is Gluten Free

- · The contents of this sensory bin have been tested to meet/exceed toy safety standards.
- · Younger children should be supervised during play.
- Prepare the area under the bin with a towel or table cover to collect any spills.
- · Children should wash their hands before and after use.
- Sensory Sand should be kept away from the eyes, nose and mouth. If contact should occur, rinse the area with water.
- Water and humidity will change the consistency of your Sensory Sand. Sensory Sand can be spread out on a pan and air dried as needed to return it to its original texture.
- · Wash the accessories as needed with warm soapy water.
- · Keep the sensory bin closed when not in use.
- Retain this information and phone numbers for future reference.

WATER BEAD INFORMATION

Non-toxic. Do not eat Water Beads or place in mouth. Do not insert Water Beads into nose or ears. If a substantial number of Water Beads are swallowed, or any Water Beads are inserted into nose or ears, seek immediate medical attention. Bring this instruction guide and some Water Beads with you. Not suitable for children under the age of three. Please retain this information for future reference.

Safety and Disposal Instructions for the Water Beads

- Water Beads contain Potassium (or Natrium), Hydroxide, Acrylic acid, Polyacrylamide, water and color pigmentation.
- Dispose of Water Beads in trash or work into garden soil. Because Water Beads give off water, they can be used to hydrate soil and conserve water usage.
- · Do not put Water Beads into sink, garbage disposal, or drain.
- · Water Beads are slippery remove spilled Water Beads from floor.

CAUTION:

Prepping your Water Beads

Add 3 cups/720 ml of cool tap water to a large bowl. Add in the Water Beads. Allow them to sit for about 3 hours until they are *fully expanded. Add more water as needed. Set the bowl aside while you assemble the bin.

Note: When Water Beads come in contact with the Sensory Sand, the texture of the sand will change into a fun slimy texture! When you are finished playing, you can rinse the Water Beads in your strainer. Follow the directions above to air dry the sand.





Assemble & Play!

Have an adult gently empty the bag of Sensory Sand into one half of the bin. Arrange the rocks along the edge of the sand to separate it from the Water Beads. Slowly place the Water Beads on the empty side of the bin using the blue scoop. Water Beads bounce, so be careful! Open and arrange all other items in your bin. Now it's time to scoop, play and create while engaging your senses!

Note to Parents - Using the scoop and sand molds are a fun way for your child to practice their fine motor skills and eye hand coordination.





Fun things to try:

- · Count the items inside the bin.
- · Name each sea creature.
- · Make up a story about your ocean adventure.
- · Call out the colors of each item.
- · Memory game: Parents hide some objects under the sand or Water Beads. Have your child guess what is missing.
- · Close your eyes and grab an item from the bin. See if you can identify it using your sense of touch.
- Imagine you are at the beach; What sounds do you hear? Now use your nose; What can you smell?
