CARE AND MAINTENANCE

PORCELAIN CARE & MAINTENANCE

INITIAL CLEANING

Proper cleaning after installation is essential for future maintenance. Remove excess grout using clean water and a sponge. If grout leaves behind a white haze, it can be wiped off using a clean cloth after grout has cured. Stubborn residue may require the use of a grout haze remover solution or neutral detergent. Thoroughly rinse the area with clean water and dry with a clean towel or wet vacuum.

ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

Immediately wipe up any spills and clean the area using a damp cloth or sponge. Remove loose soil using a broom or vacuum. To remove stubborn surface debris, use a scraper or putty knife. Wipe the area with a PH-neutral and soapless cleaner. Rinse with clear water and wipe dry to prevent residue. Do not use cleaning wax, oil-based cleaners, ammonia, sealants, or products containing acid or bleach for routine maintenance. Avoid using abrasive cleaning products such as steel wool.

CERAMIC CARE & MAINTENANCE

Glazed tile products should be cleaned routinely with an all-purpose, low VOC, household or commercial cleaner. The product chosen should also be grout joint cleaning compatible. The type of product may vary depending on the tile application and use. A multipurpose spray cleaner, which removes soap scum, hard water deposits and mildew designed for everyday use can be used on wall tile areas in residential baths and showers. A cotton mop, cloth, sponge, or non-metallic brush should be used to apply and agitate cleaner. Rinse the area with clean water and dry thoroughly. Routine cleaners should never contain harsh chemicals as these can damage tile. Acids can damage grout and the glazed surface of the tile. Ammonia can discolor grout.

Regular dust mopping, sweeping, or vacuuming is recommended prior to cleaning with liquid products.

Unglazed tile should be cleaned routinely with concentrated tile cleaners with a neutral pH for safe regular use. These cleaners are better suited for removing grease, oils, and normal spills from unglazed products. Again, these products will vary depending on the application, amount of traffic and the use. The product chosen should also be compatible with the grout.

GLASS TILE CARE & MAINTENANCE

Although glass tile is impervious to liquids and sealers the sanded grout used in a glass tile project should have a penetrating sealer applied. Urethane or epoxy grouts do not require sealers.

• Only a water based sealer should be used, as this will allow a quick clean-up on the glass tile surface after application. Use of proper tools for application to the grout lines of the penetrating sealer is recommended.

Cleaning Glass Tile

- Avoid abrasive scrubbing utensils
- Use of a soft cloth or sponge with water will clean most glass tile areas because of the nonporous nature of the product.
- For more stubborn cleanups, commercially available ceramic tile cleaners may be applicable.
