WINEMAKING PHILOSOPHY

For over four decades, Kendall-Jackson has remained relentlessly committed to producing only the finest quality wines from grapes grown in California's cool, coastal vineyards. We carefully match climates and soil types for each grape varietal and then guide each vineyard lot throughout the entire winemaking process.

KEY POINTS

- Cabernet Sauvignon is blended with Merlot, which softens the tannins and adds mid-palate, and Malbec, which adds plushness (roundness).
- Paso Robles vineyards give bold, ripe berry flavor and bright acidity.
- Sonoma County fruit adds black cherry and silkiness.
- Artisanal winemaking techniques such as cold soak are used to enhance fruit character and soften tannins.
- Ageing in small oak casks imparts a bit of spice and rounds out the texture.

TASTING NOTES

"Bright and fresh, displaying vibrant aromas of blueberry and blackberry, lifted by hints of fresh mint and cracked black pepper. The palate delivers juicy blueberry and cassis layered with a touch of caramel and subtle spice. Smooth and approachable, with lively acidity and well-balanced tannins, and a long, lingering finish. An easy-drinking, lively, fruit-forward Cabernet Sauvignon."

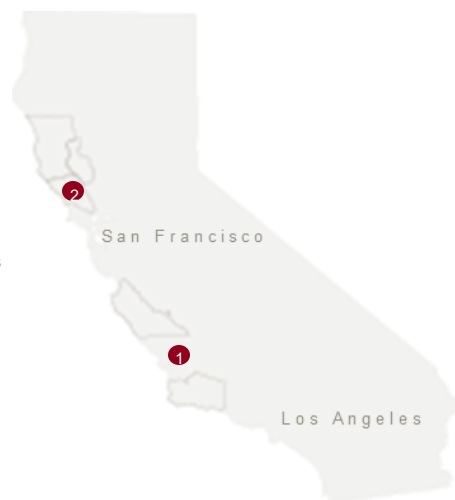
