**CAUTION:** Hooks are to engage the hanging chain only and not the electric cord.

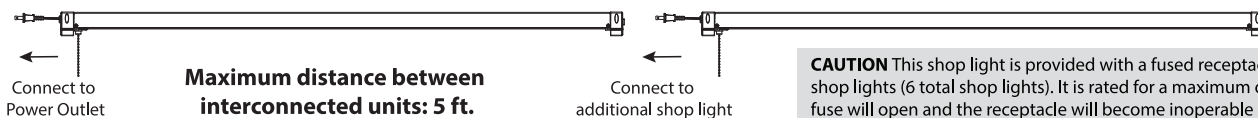
**NOTE:** When used with wall switch, make sure pull chain switch is On. When using pull chain On/Off switch, attach included extension to pull chain.

This portable light-emitting-diode (LED) luminaire has a polarized plug (One blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. Link up to 6 shop lights together

## INSTALLATION OPTIONS

### Install fixture using included hanging chain and V-hooks

1. Install provided screw-hooks directly onto ceiling. Spacing between screws should be 40 inches (See Figure A). For concrete ceilings/drywalls, wall anchors are required. Drill two holes (use a 1/4 inch drill bit) for provided wall anchors then use provided screw hooks (See Figure 1).
2. Attach chain to V-hooks then insert hooks into mounting holes located on top of fixture (See Figure 2). Do this for both ends of lamp.
3. Install lamp to ceiling by hanging the chain to pre-mounted screw-hooks on ceiling (See Figure 3).
4. Plug in power-cord to outlet or connect to additional shop lights.
5. Pull down on pull chain switch to turn fixture ON/OFF.
6. Zip tie cord to chain so that excess cord is kept out of the work space. (see Figure 4).

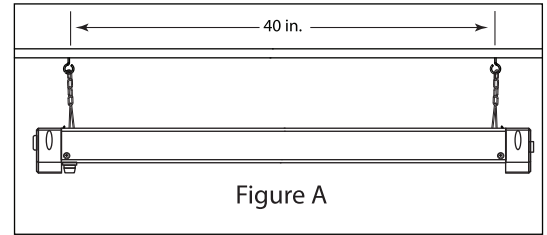

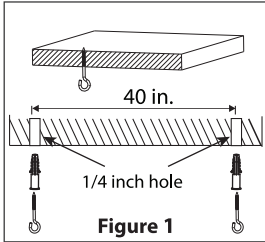

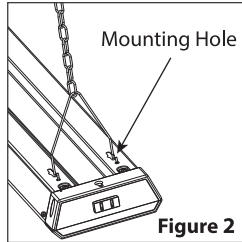

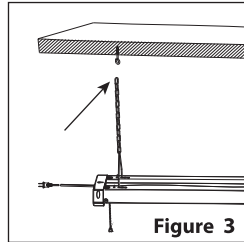

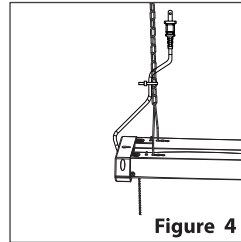

### Install fixture flushmount using screws

1. Install provided screws directly onto mounting surface. Spacing between screws should be 44 3/4 inches. Gap (D) should be .079-.099 inches. For concrete/drywall surfaces, wall anchors are required. Drill two holes (use a 1/4 inch drill bit) for provided wall anchors then use provided screws (See Figure 5).
2. Install fixture to mounting surface by inserting the Key Holes on top side of the fixture into the mounting screws (See Figure 6). It may be necessary to adjust the tightness of the screws (Gap D). Make sure both screws hold the lamp securely on the narrow side of the Key Holes.
3. Mount a third screw next to the side of the outlet (See Figure 7). If anchor is required, mark the hole as close as possible to the fixture, remove the lamp, drill the hole on the marked position, install anchor into the drilled hole, re-install the fixture then install the screw into the wall anchor. This will secure the lamp into place.
4. Plug in power-cord to outlet or connect to additional shop lights.
5. Pull down on pull chain switch to turn fixture ON/OFF.

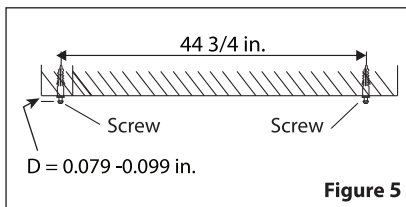

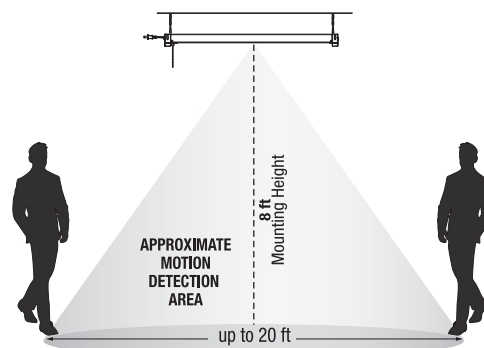
### Motion Detection

While the fixture is powered on, use the switch to turn the motion setting on or off. When ON is selected, the fixture stays on for 5 minutes after motion is detected. When OFF is selected, the fixture remains on continuously.



**NOTE:** When motion mode is ON, the fixture will blink once if turned on with wall switch or pull chain switch. This indicates that the motion mode is active.

The fixture is shipped with motion set to the OFF position.



### Fixture Maintenance

1. Please make sure the power is off before maintenance.
2. To avoid any damage to the product, please do not use any chemical solvents during the routine maintenance.
3. To ensure better lighting, please clean the lamp regularly.
