DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For control of Spotted Lanternfly, thoroughly spray all areas of the plant, especially new shoots and underside of leaves. Pests need to be contacted by the spray to be controlled. Hook the bottle to a hose and turn on. Extend the hose to the farthest area to be treated, point sprayer nozzle in direction to be sprayed. Walk at a steady pace while spraying, using an even sweeping motion and slightly overlap treated areas.

Follow all other label directions, restrictions and precautions on the product label.
