


CAM LOCK FASTENER ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



Note: Every cam lock bolt must have a cam lock connector in order to fasten the parts together.




Insert the cam lock bolt into the pre-drilled hole above the cam connector.





Turn right (clockwise) to tighten.








*** Do not tighten screws & bolts until the entire unit is completely assembled.


Insert Minifix(H) into the Top Panel(A), Right & Left Side Panel(C)(D) and Front Panel (F). Before insert Wood Dowel(J), using the Glue(M) into the Back Panel(G) of dowel holes.




Assemble Left Side panel(C), Right Side Panel(D), Back Panel(G) and Front Lower Panel(E), using screwdriver (not provide) with Cam(I).




Insert Cam(I) into the Left & Right Side Panel(C)(D), to connect Front Panel(F), using screwdriver (not provide) with Cam(I).



Assemble Top Panel(A) to connect Left & Right Side Panel(C)(D) and Back Panel(G), using screwdriver (not provide) with Cam(I).




Insert Screws(K) into the Left & Right Side Panel(C)(D) to connect Bottom Panel(B).

Drill a 7mm hole on the wall and fix Wall Anchor(N) into it, then fasten Screw(O) on Wall Anchor(N) through Wall Hanger(P). Using Screw(R) fasten Bracket(Q) onto the panel and hitching Bracket(Q) and Wall Hanger(P) by Cable Tie(S).



Cleaning & Care

Treat surface with care. Surface is resistant to scratches but is not scratch resistant. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are right.
