
## **SET-UP**

Please retain these instructions for future reference

- Place the two cornhole boards facing each other. The boards should be 25 feet apart.
- For a 4 player game, split up your team so each team has one player on each side (see diagram).



### **HOW TO PLAY**



Each team has 4 bean bags of the same color. Players on different teams alternate tossing a bean bag onto the opposite cornhole board. Begin the game by having a player on each team toss one bag and the team with the bag closest to the hole tosses first.

- Players may not move past the front of the board while tossing a bean bag. If this happens the toss will not count.
- If a toss is made out of turn it does not count.
- Players may not bounce bags off the ground and onto the cornhole board.

# **SCORING**

A bag that lands and stays on the board is worth 1 point. A bag that goes through the hole is worth 3 points. One team's points cancel the other team's points out. The difference in team points is the score for the round.

#### **EXAMPLE:**

Team one has 2 bags on the board and 1 in the hole for a total of 5 points. Team two has 3 bags on the board and none in the hole for a total of 3 points. For the round, team one would get 2 points (5 points - 3 points = 2 points).

The first team to 21 points wins. You do not have to score exactly 21 points, you may exceed it.
