
Attach Front Rail (D) and Back Rails (F) to Side Panels (B) and (C) with Cam Locks. (see Figure 1).







Place the unit on the wall at desired location. Mark with pencil to show the height and center of unit.




Move unit. Drill a 1/2" hole in the wall, 2 inches down and directly below the mark.




Attach Tipping Restraint to the wall using 1 1/2" Round Head Screw, Flat Washer & Anchor.



Insert Tipping Restraint to unit through the hole of Back Panel (G).




Screw Tipping Restraint to unit using 1/2" Round Head Screw & Flat Washer.







STEP 1

Insert Base Part (K5) into the groove.


Attach Side Part (K4) to Front Part (K1) and Back Part (K2) using a Phillips screwdriver and 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.











STEP 1

Insert Base Part (L5) into the groove.


Attach Side Part (L4) to Front Part (L1) and Back Part (L2) using a Phillips screwdriver and 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.





I. IF A DRAWER DOES NOT ALIGN




Insert the drawer into the main body, then adjust the drawer front panel left or right and up or down, until the drawer gaps look proportional.



drawer front panel into position

with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.



Pull the drawer open slowly and tighten the upper screws. Make sure the front panel does not move and lock the drawer front panel into position with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.
