




SAFETY FIRST

DESCRIPTION OF OPERATION

The **XT Cable Stripper** is made for end and mid-span termination of 600 volt 1/0 to 1000kcmil or outside diameter sizes from (.33"-1.284"). Works on THHN, XHHW, RHH, RHW, and USE jackets.

IDENTIFICATION

- 1. Precision Blade Adjustable Thumb Screw
- 2. Solid Unibody Aluminum Frame
- **3. Precision Cutting Blade**
- 4. Bottom Adjustable V Shape Cable Clamp
- 5. Cable Sizing Thumb Screw
- 6. Depth Adjuster Stop
- 7. Depth Adjuster Lock

SETUP AND OPERATION


- 1. Turn blade adjustment thumb screw counter-clockwise, to fully retract Precision Cutting Blade.
- 2. Turn cable sizing thumb screw counter-clockwise to open V shape cable clamp.
- 3. Insert cable.


4. Terminations

4A. For End-Termination: Place wire into V shape clamp with end of wire below precision cutting blade. Disengage the depth adjuster lock by turning it counter-clockwise.

Then rotate the depth adjuster in place and set depth adjuster relative to precision cutting blade.

Once desired depth is attained, secure the depth adjuster lock by turning it clockwise.






SETUP AND OPERATION cont.

4B. For Mid-Span: Align precision cutting blade to start of desired cut.

Note: cutting blade will travel towards the solid unibody aluminum frame.




5. Engage V shape cable clamp by turning cable sizing thumb screw clockwise until cable is secured.

NOTE: Do not overtighten sizing thumb screw as this may cause binding during operation.

- 6. Set the precision blade adjustable thumb screw until blade touches the outer jacket of the cable.
- 7. Rotate complete tool clockwise to start stripping cable.


NOTE: small adjustments may be required to achieve required depth of cut.

Adjustments can be made by turning the precision blade adjustable thumb screw clockwise.




SETUP AND OPERATION cont.

8A. For End-Termination this can be accomplished with the depth adjuster stop.



8B. For Mid-Span place a gloved hand against unibody frame while continuing to turn stripper clockwise.



9. Release V shape cable clamp by turning counter clockwise to remove stripper.

ADDITIONAL HELP

MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep tool clean and dry.
- 2. Oil moving parts occasionally.
- 3. To help reduce potential friction and make stripping easier, apply a small amount of grease to the V shaped clamp.
- 4. Do not alter the blade angles.
