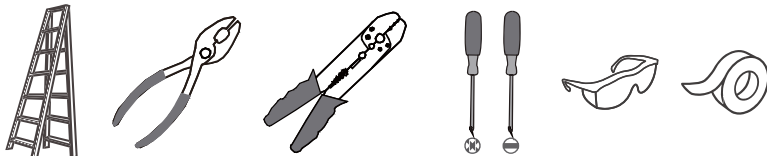
CAUTION

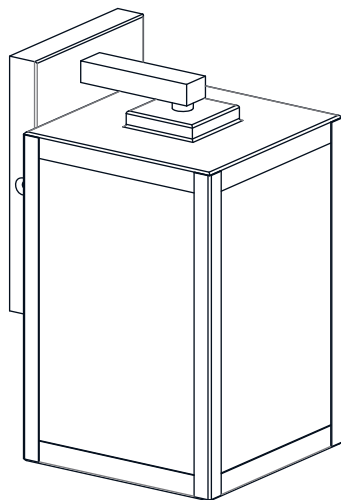


CARE AND MAINTENANCE

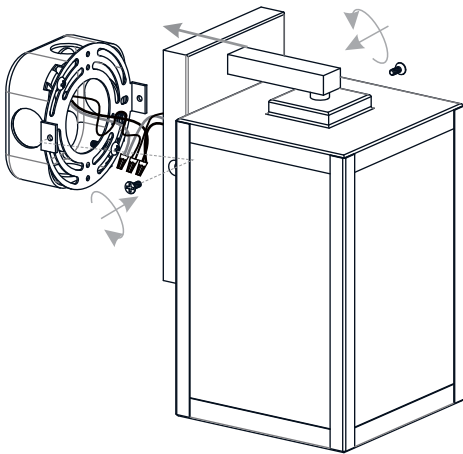
1 Install Crossbar



2 Wiring

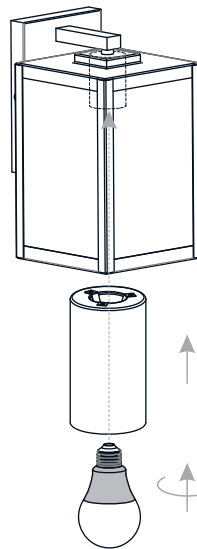


3 Install Fixture Body

Install the correct bulb referring to fixture markings and/or labels for maximum wattage.

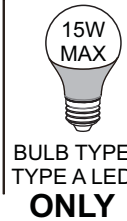


Note: *For Dark Sky use the sleeve and the recommended bulb.*



Bulb Type (not included):

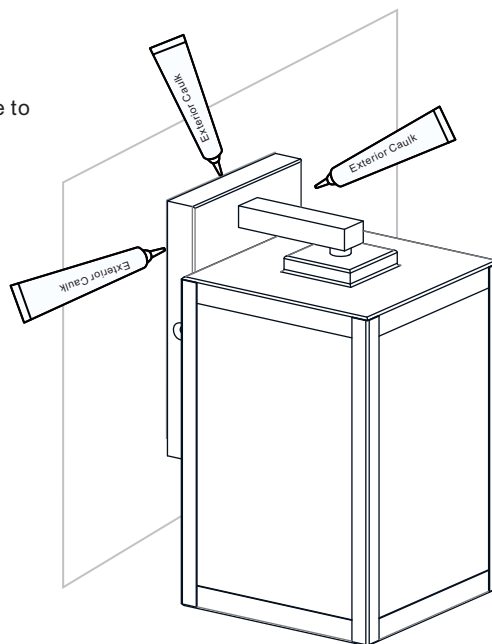
BULB BASE TYPE

* Note: Do NOT caulk the bottom of the backplate to allow moisture to escape.
