

2 Product Introduction

The appearance, dimensions, and structure may vary with device model.

2.1 Dimensions and Structure



1. Microphone	2. Main camera	
3. LED indicator	4. Doorbell button	
	When the doorbell is powered on, press and hold the button for 2 seconds to configure the network. Press to make a call.	
5. Sub camera (with illuminators on both sides)	Disassembly clip: After the doorbell is installed, you can press the clip using the detaching pin to remove the doorbell from the bracket.	
7. Speaker	8. Power connection terminal	

9. Reset button

Press and hold the button until you hear a beep, then release the button, and the device will begin to restore the factory defaults. Wait until the indicator flashes red, which means that the reset is successful.



Optional digital door chime is available, ILV DOORCHIME-1


3 Doorbell Installation

3.1 Doorbell Installation


Choose the mount bracket according to the desired viewing angle.
 The viewing angle of main camera and sub camera may vary with the used bracket.




(Optional) If the wall is uneven, remove the release paper from the installation foam, and then attach the foam to the back of the bracket.



Attach the drill template to the wall in the correct direction (see the arrow) at the recommended height of 48 inches from the center of the template to the ground. Drill two holes (depth:at least 1 inch; diameter: 1/4 of an inch) on the wall, and then insert expansion tubes.



- Place the flat mount bracket in the correct direction (see the arrow), and lead the cables inside the wall through the bracket hole (f inclined mount is required, place the inclined mount bracket behind the flat mount bracket)
- Insert the short screws (for the flat mount bracket) or long screws (for the inclined mount bracket) into the expansion tubes using a #2 Phillips screwdriver to secure the bracket to the wall.



3.2 Installation Preparation



WARNING

Be sure to disconnect the doorbell from power before installation.

1 Installation Position


It is recommended to install the doorbell on the wall next to the main door.

It is recommended to install the router near the doorbell to avoid any wealand avoid too many Wi-Fi signals.

2 Wiring

If the doorbell uses a mechanical chime, choose **Mechanical Chime** when adding the doorbell on the app.



3 Tools

Please prepare antistatic wrist strap or gloves, electric drill, hammer, #1 Phillips screwdriver, and #2 Phillips screwdriver.

Secure the doorbell to the flat mount bracket once app onboarding has been completed. (pg.11)

- (1) Align the two notches at the bottom of the doorbell with the protruding parts of the bracket and press the doorbell until it clicks into place.
- (2) Press the top of the doorbell until you hear a click, which indicates that the doorbell has been secured to the bracket.

Reconnect the doorbell to the power to start it up.

6 On-boarding Walk-through Guide



- Make sure the chime and doorbell are connected to power.
- Make sure your phone is Bluetooth-enabled and connected to Wi-Fi.
- Please note that using this doorbell station requires the use of the Illumivue Protect App.
 If you have not downloaded this app yet, but already have the Illumivue app,
 you can install Illumivue Protect and login with the same account credentials and your
 system will populate in the Illumivue Protect app.




2 Add a Device

 Press the + sign to add a device, in the image below scan the QR code on the back of the doorbell station that you can see on the bottom left of the screw terminals.



Once the scan is complete you will see the time settings, please leave the DST on if you are in a region that supports this and then tap the "OK" button then press the "Start" button and follow the on screen directions. Be sure to keep the phone close to the door bell for this process, and allow any permission requests that may pop up (for Bluetooth access, camera access, microphone access, etc.)



2 Once the Device is online in your app press on the 3 dots on the upper right corner of its image. Turn on the "Receive Alarm Messages" if you want notification from the doorbell. Now press the "Set" button to access settings for the doorbell. If you see a red dot next to the doorbell name, press the name, and then press "Current Version" to update the firmware. Once complete go back to the main settings page. Press "allow alarm notification" Here you can allow overall notification, then choose if you want app push notifications (which has a schedule and frequency of notification options) and snapshot reporting.

Video Call Notifications: should remain on

Alarm Detection: Motion detection is for the top doorbell camera and allows you to enable Ultra Motion Detection which can have a detection area drawn, the default is that the area covers the entire camera view.

Package Detection is for the lower package camera and all options are on by default. It contains the option for Package Guard, Overstay and Checker. Each of these has a brief description below their name in the app menu.

<u>Video:</u> Allows you to set both cameras on Mainstream and Sub stream to .H265, this is recommended if using the doorbell stand alone or with an Illumiyue NVR

Sound and Microphone: Allows for volume settings for audio input, audio output and alarms

OSD: allows you to show the time and date in the image for each camera

Chime Settings: IMPORTANT, this must be configured if using any type of chime. If using the wireless chime (ILV DOORCHIME-1), please select that option and follow the on-screen prompts. You may add up to 3 wireless chime units. This unit does have two independent cameras, dual lighting as well as advanced analytics because of this when using a mechanical chime, the minimum power transformer recommended is a 16VAC 20VA unit.

If using a mechanical chime please select that option, **BEFORE** selecting next please ensure that the Power Kit is installed on the mechanical chime properly following the wiring diagram in the app.

<u>More:</u> This section allows for diagnostic reports (if this is needed tech support will guide you how to use this and where to send the report)

Speed Test: Once the unit is installed and configured, test for live view and button press calling. If the units seem to be slow in response it is recommended to run the speed test to ensure you have good communication speed on the WiFi network. The download speed should be at least 5000kbps.

App notifications: The "message" button at the bottom of the Illumivue Protect app is where you can view your alarm notifications. Please be aware that this doorbell has a post record of 30 seconds. You will have to wait until the recording clip has completed to view it, or if you press the notification and see no recording right away you can press the live view button in the lower right corner of the screen to see the live doorbell camera feet.



Adding the doorbell to an Illumivue NVR/DVR:

- The cameras should be added to the NVR/DVR via IP address and using the ONVIF protocol.
- Note that the unit will consume 2 channels on an NVR if you add both cameras.

 It is also recommended to go into the NVR/DVR menu, go to ALARM then select the channel for the doorbell camera, click on the "trigger" tab and uncheck the "push notification" option. Do this for both camera channels. This will keep the app from sending you double notifications. It is recommended to the leave the doorbell itself as the device in your app as the primary notification sender.
