









Locate the part 7 refrigerator top door and attach one part N door insert and one part P door hinge peg with four part F screws, two screws each. Flip the door, then attach the part 53 door handle with two part C screws.







Locate the part 14 microwave door and attach one part N door insert and one part P door hinge peg with four part F screws, two screws each.

Flip the door, then attach the part W microwave handle with two part C screws.







Locate the **part 37 dishwasher door** and attach one **part N door insert** and one **part P door hinge peg** with four **part F screws**, two screws each.

Flip the door, then attach the part 53 door handle with two part C screws.

BEFORE ASSEMBLY

Attach the part S phone mount to the part S refrigerator left side.

Attach two part M door catches to the part 6 refrigerator right side with four part F screws, two screws each.


Attach part M door catch to the part 22 stove range right side with two part F screws.


Attach one part M door catch to the part 25 oven right side with two part F screws.

Attach one part M door catch to the part 30 center stove knobs with two part F screws.


Insert the part 43 towel rod between two part K towel rod sides, then


attach the towel rod side to the part 45 right side with two part C screws. Attach one part Q lower hinge receiver to the part 2 refrigerator top molding, part 38 right top molding, and part 46 sink front with six part F screws. Two screws per support, six screws total.





Attach one part O upper hinge receiver to the part 4 refrigerator shelf, part 33 left base, part 41 right base, and part 36 microwave bottom shelf with eight part F screws. Two screws per support, eight screws total.







Attach the part 31 center bottom molding to the part 35 center oven base with two part D dowels, then secure with two part A screws.

Attach the part 35 center oven base to the part 24 and 25 oven sides with four part A screws, two screws per side.

Attach the part 30 center stove knobs to the oven sides with four part V screws.






Attach the part 42 right bottom molding to the part 41 right base with two part D dowels, then insert three part D dowels as shown, one in right bottom molding and two in the right base.

Attach the part 41 right base to the part 25 oven right side with two part V screws.


Attach the part 34 left bottom molding to the part 33 left base with one part A screw.

Attach the left base assembly to the part 24 left side with four part D dowels, two part V screws.




Insert two part D dowels into the part 12 left bottom shelf, then attach the shelf to the part 24 left side with two part A screws.


Attach the part 47 back sink support with one part D dowel and one part A screw.



Insert two part D dowels into the part 40 right sink counter's side, then attach it to the part 25 right side with two part A screws.




Slide the part 16 right sink cabinet backing between the part 40 right sink counter and part 41 right base. Place the part 50 oven center support onto part 26 oven base, then slide a part 27 oven backing on either side of the support, two total.




3 Attach the part 18 and 22 stove range sides to part 26 oven base with four part D dowels, two dowels per side, and two part A screws, one per side.

Attach the oven base assembly to the part 24 and 25 oven sides with four part D dowels and four part Z screws.

Note: Use a hand screwdriver when attaching the part V screws to prevent damage.





Insert two part D dowels into the part 15 microwave bottom shelf and attach it to the part 18 left stove range side, then secure with one part A screw.

Insert two part D dowels into the part 13 microwave top molding, then attach it with one part A screw.

Slide the part 16 left cabinet backing between the part 9 left countertop and the part 33 left base.

Insert two part D dowels into the part 8 microwave top, then attach it to the part 22 stove range right side and secure with one part A screw.


Insert one part D dowel into the part 36 right top shelf, then secure it to the part 22 stove range right side with one part A screw.


Insert the part 44 right backs lasp between the part 8 top and part 40 right sink.

Attach the part 46 sink front to two part 48 sink sides with four part D dowels.

Slide the part 49 sink bottom into the sink assembly, then insert two part D dowels each into the part 48 sink sides and the part 46 sink front.


Attach the sink assembly to the part 47 back sink support, then push the sink front until it is flush with the part 25 oven right side.






Insert two part D dowels into the part 8 microwave top, then attach it to the part 18 stove range left side and secure with one part A screw.

Insert the part 10 right/left backsplash between the part 8 top and part 9 countertop.



Attach the part 2 refrigerator top molding to the part 6 refrigerator right side with one part A screw.

Insert one part D dowel into the part 4 refrigerator shelf, then attach the shelf to the part 6 refrigerator with two part A screw.




Attach the part 2 refrigerator top molding to the part 6 refrigerator right side with one part A screw. Insert one part D dowel into the part 4 refrigerator shelf, then attach the shelf to the part 6 refrigerator with two part A screw.

Insert two part D dowels into the part 11 left counter molding, then insert it into the part 24 oven left side. Insert two part D dowels into the bottom of the part 6 refrigerator right side, then attach the refrigerator right side to the left side assembly with ten additional part D dowels and secure with five part A screws.


Install two part V screws under the part 4 shelf. Secure the bottom of the part 6 refrigerator side with two more part A screws.

Recommended: Have a second person lift the assembly while a second person secures the screws.


Attach the part 5 refrigerator left side to the refrigerator shelf assembly with four part D dowels, then secure with six part A screws.




Insert the part 32 refrigerator backing between the part 5 and 6 refrigerator sides, then attach the part 14 microwave door by inserting the hinge peg into the top receiver. Insert one part P hinge peg into the bottom receiver, then align the door with the peg and secure with two part F screws.




Attach the part 1 refrigerator top to the refrigerator assembly with six part D dowels and four part A screws.



Insert two part D dowels into the part 19 and 21 center backsplash side, then attach the backsplashes to the part 26 oven base, then secure with four part A screws.







Insert the top hinge peg on the part 37 dishwasher door into the top receiver, then insert one part P door hinge peg into the bottom receiver. Align the door with the hinge peg, then secure with two part F screws.



Insert the top hinge peg on the part 3 refrigerator top door into the top receiver, then insert one part P door hinge peg into the bottom receiver. Align the door with the hinge peg, then secure with two part F screws.


Insert the top hinge peg on the part 7 refrigerator bottom door into the top receiver, then insert one part P door hinge peg into the bottom receiver. Align the door with the hinge peg, then secure with two part F screws.





Install two AA batteries into both part 51 stove burners, four batteries total. Insert the burners into the openings on the part 26 oven base.

Attach the part 29 oven door by securing the part X oven door hinges with four part F screws, two screws per hinge.
