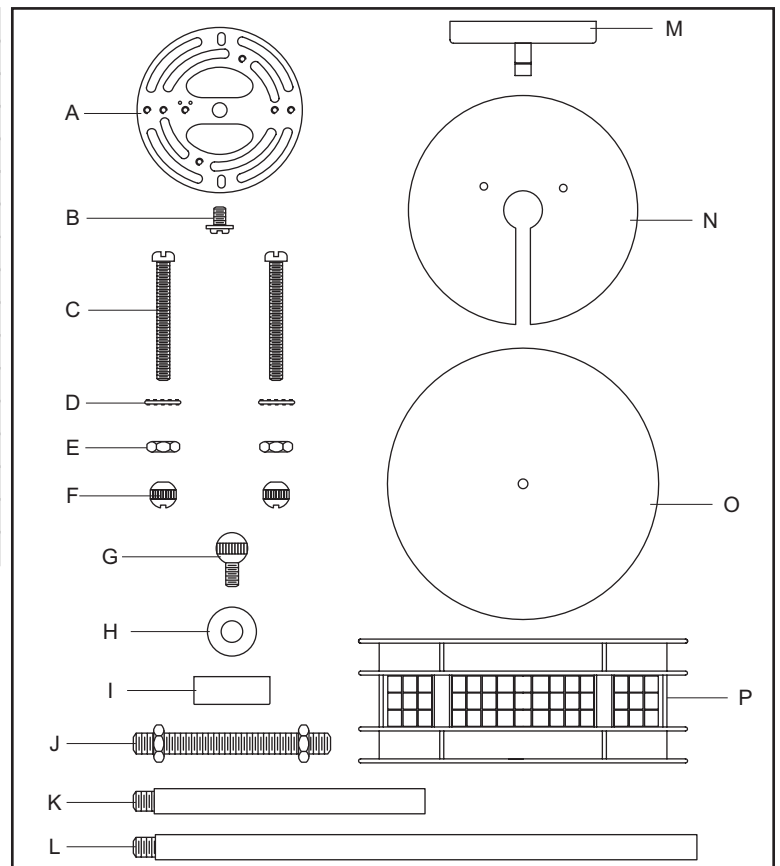

WARNINGS AND CAUTIONS

WARNING:

- Before beginning the installation, turn off electricity at the circuit breaker box or the main fuse box by switching off the circuit breaker or removing the fuse.

CAUTION:

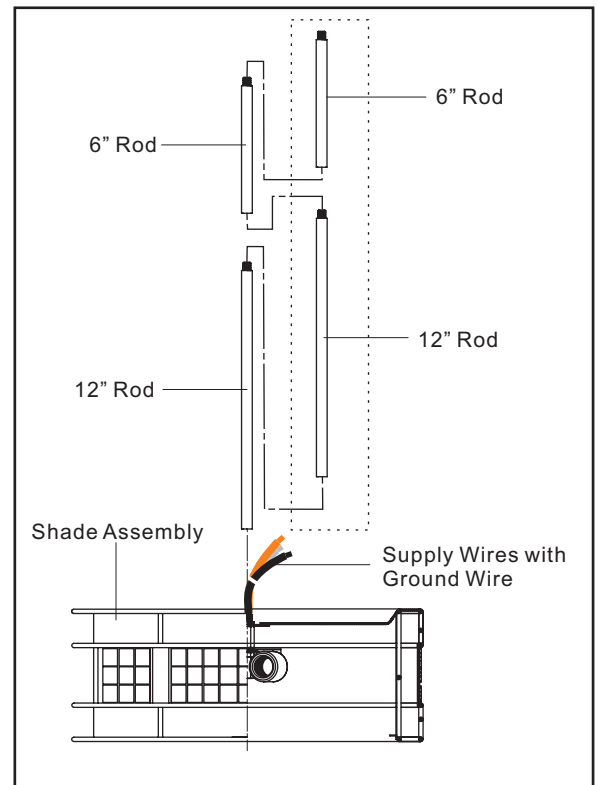
- These instructions are provided for your safety. It is very important that they are read completely before the installation of your fixture. We strongly recommend that a professional electrician install the fixture.
- Disconnect fixture from the power source before replacing the bulb(s), making sure the bulb(s) had sufficient time to cool down. DO NOT subject the lamp to any shock while lit as shattering of lamp may result.

PREPARATION

- Before beginning installation of product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with package contents list and diagram above. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install or operate the product. Contact customer service for replacement part.
- Estimated Assembly Time : 20 - 30 minutes
- Tools Required for Assembly (not included) : Flathead Screwdriver, Phillips Screwdriver, Pliers, Electrical Tape, Wire Cutters, Safety Glasses & 3, 60 Watt, Type - A Medium Base Bulbs.
- Helpful Tools (not included) : Wire Strippers.

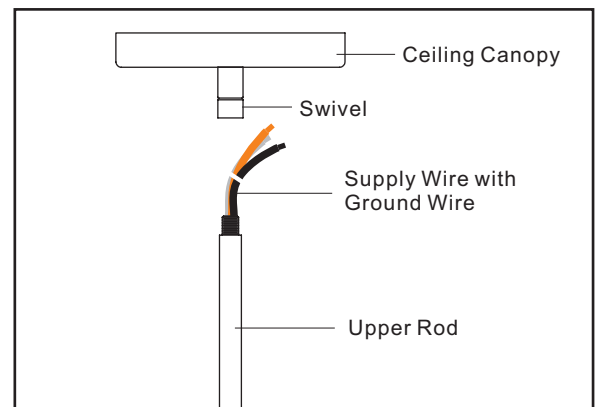
STEP 1:

- Determine the Rods to be assembled according to your desired hanging height.
- Pass the Supply Wires with Ground Wire through the chosen Rods and then thread Rods and Shade Assembly together as shown. Tighten until snug.



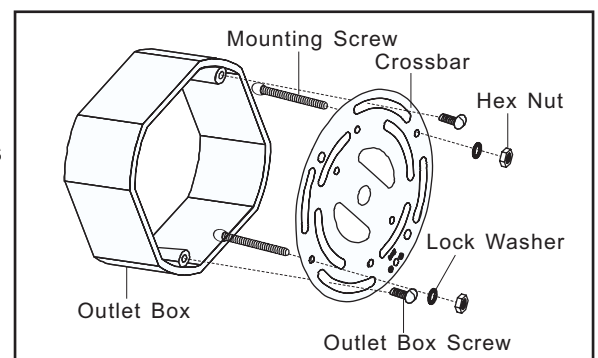
STEP 2:

- Pass the Supply Wires with Ground Wire through the Swivel and Ceiling Canopy.
- Thread the Swivel onto the top end of the Upper Rod and hand tighten until snug.



STEP 3:

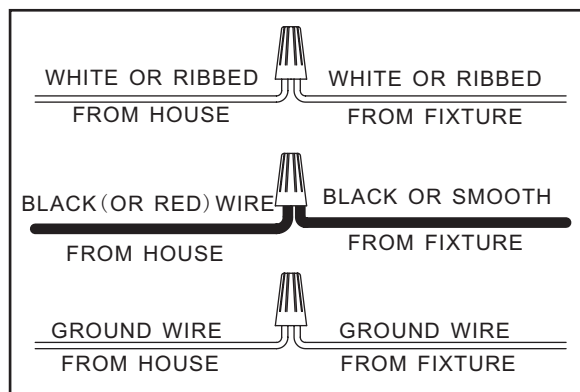
- Screw the Mounting Screws into the Crossbar, place the Lock Washers over the Mounting Screws and thread the Hex Nuts onto the Mounting Screws as shown. Secure the position of the Mounting Screws by tightening the Hex Nuts against the Crossbar.
- Secure the Crossbar to the Outlet Box with Outlet Box Screws.



STEP 4:

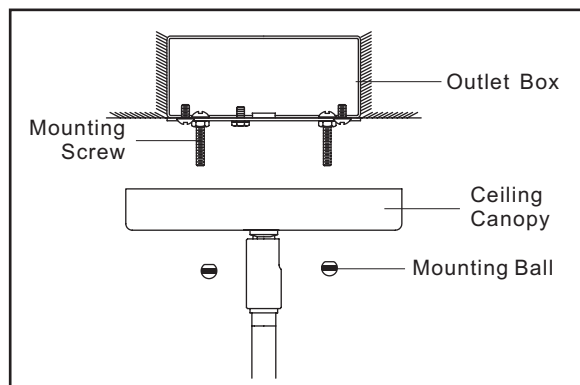
*Use Wire Connectors (not supplied) to connect the wires.

- Connect the House Ground Wire to the Fixture Ground Wire.
- Connect the House White (or Ribbed) Wire to the Fixture Supply Wire (White or Ribbed Side).
- Connect the House Black(or Red) Wire to the Fixture Supply Wire (Black or Smooth Side).
- Wrap each connection with approved electrical tape and carefully stuff all of the connected wires into the Outlet Box.



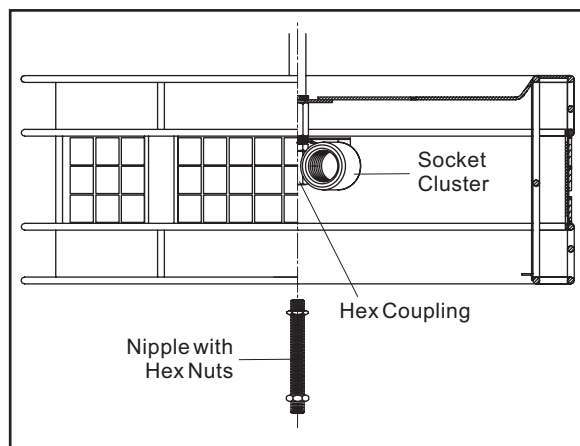
STEP 5 :

- Place the Ceiling Canopy onto Outlet Box aligning 2 holes in the Ceiling Canopy with 2 Mounting screws threaded on the Crossbar and secure it against wall with Mounting Balls.



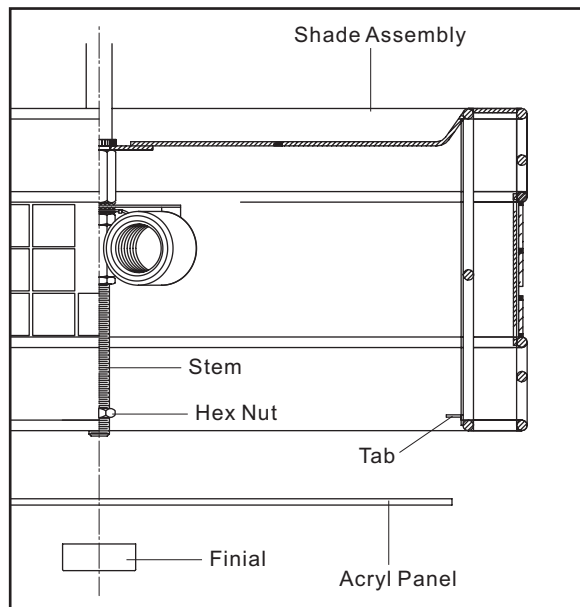
STEP 6 :

- Screw the Hex Nut end of the Nipple into the Hex Coupling underside of the Socket Cluster. Using pliers, thread the Hex Nut against the Hex Coupling and hand tighten until snug.



STEP 7 :

- Place the Acryl Panel over the end of the Stem, attach onto the Tabs in the bottom of the Shade Assembly. Adjust the Hex Nut on the end of the Stem until it attaches onto the Acryl Panel.
- Thread the Finial onto the end of the Stem and hand tighten until snug to secure the Acryl Panel.

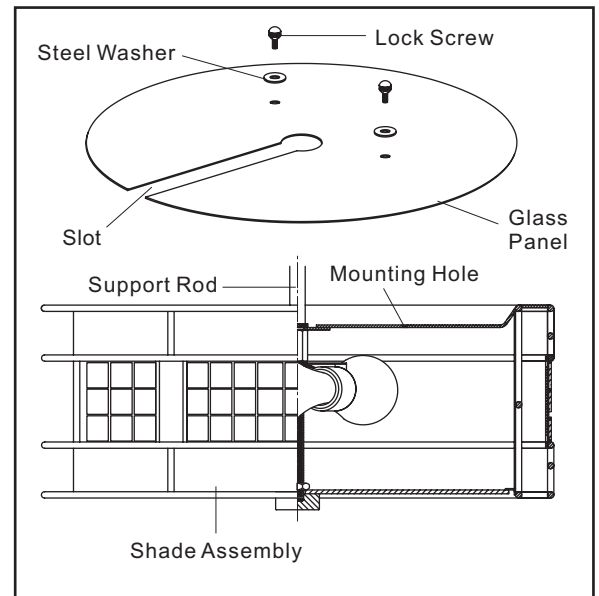


STEP 8 :

- a. Install correct bulbs referring to fixture markings and/or labels for maximum wattage.

STEP 9 :

- a. Pass the Slot on the Glass Panel over the Support Rod and align holes on the Glass Panel onto the Mounting Holes on the Bracket on the Shade Assembly.
- b. Pass Steel Washers over Lock Screws and then screw the Lock Screws into the Mounting Holes on Bracket to secure the Glass Panel. Hand tighten gently until snug.



Your installation is completed now. Restore electricity. Retain this sheet for future reference.
