Assembly Tips

Make sure you understand the following tips before you begin to assemble your Atomic Hockey Table.

1. Start **ALL** bolts by hand before tightening.
2. Some drawings or images in this manual may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before starting each assembly step.

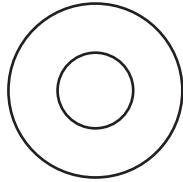

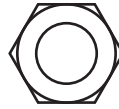

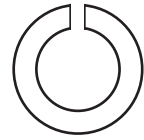

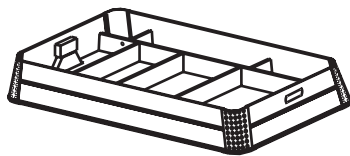

PARTS REQUIRED:

12 pcs - H1 Hex Bolt	1 pc - P1 Main Cabinet
24 pcs - H2 Flat Washer	4 pcs - P2 Leg
12 pcs - H3 Nut	4 pcs - P3 Leg Leveler
12 pcs - H4 Lock Washer	1 pc - T1 Wrench

STEP 1.

Move the table to room of choice before starting installation. Leave the Main Cabinet **P1** face down in the carton to protect the table.

Attach each Leg **P2** as shown in **FIGURE 1**. Place Washer **H2** on Bolt **H1**, insert bolts through support in Main Cabinet **P1** and Leg **P2**. Next, place Washer **H2** and Lock Washer **H4** on the Bolt and secure using Nut **H3**. Tighten all hardware securely using the Wrench **T1** provided and an adjustable wrench. Repeat as shown with each remaining leg.

Next, thread Leg Levelers **P3** into the bottom of each leg as shown.

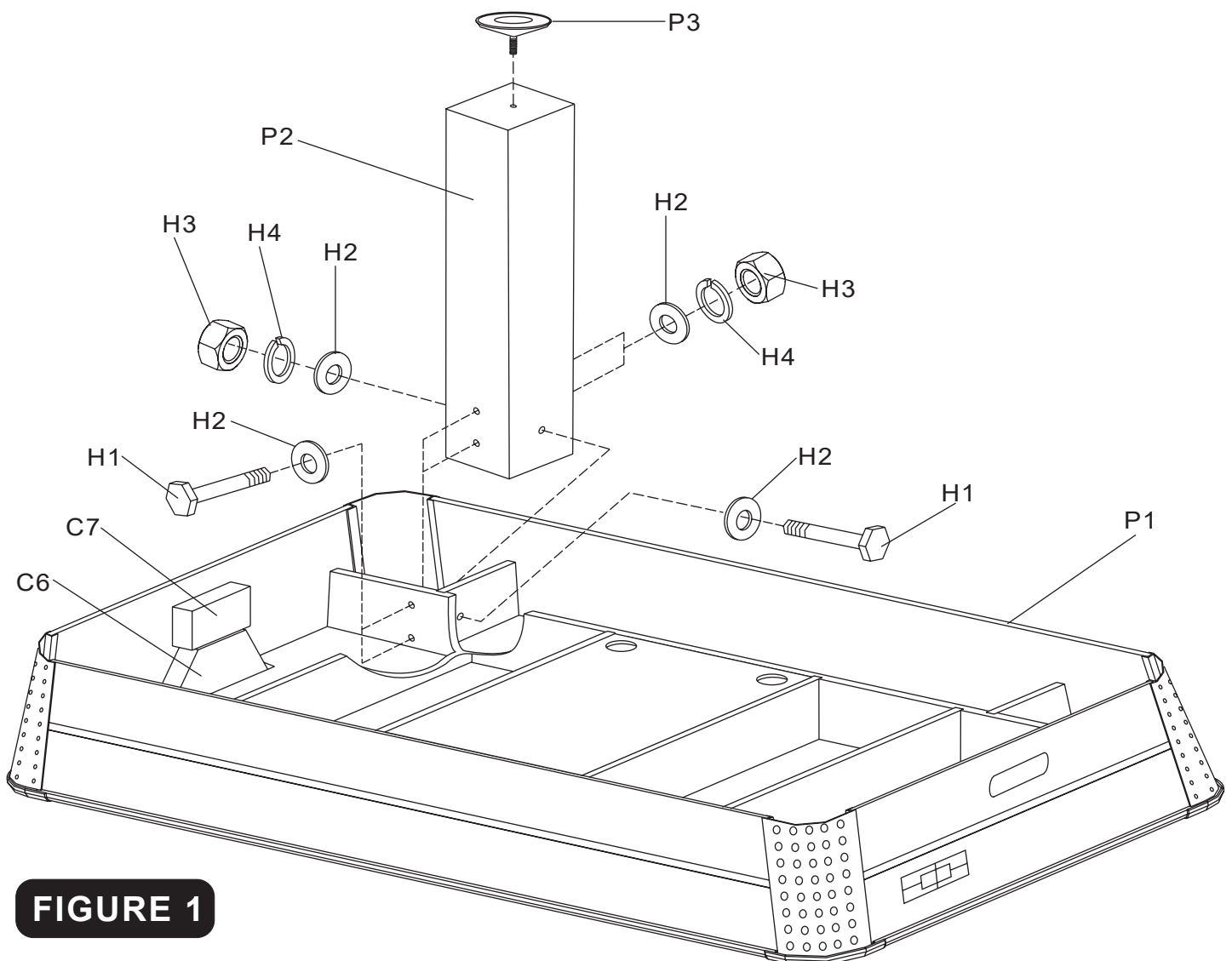

STEP 2.

With the help of 4 adults, **CAREFULLY** lift and rotate this table into an upright position. Lastly, place a carpenter's level on the playfield and adjust the Leg Levelers P3 to level the Hockey Table.

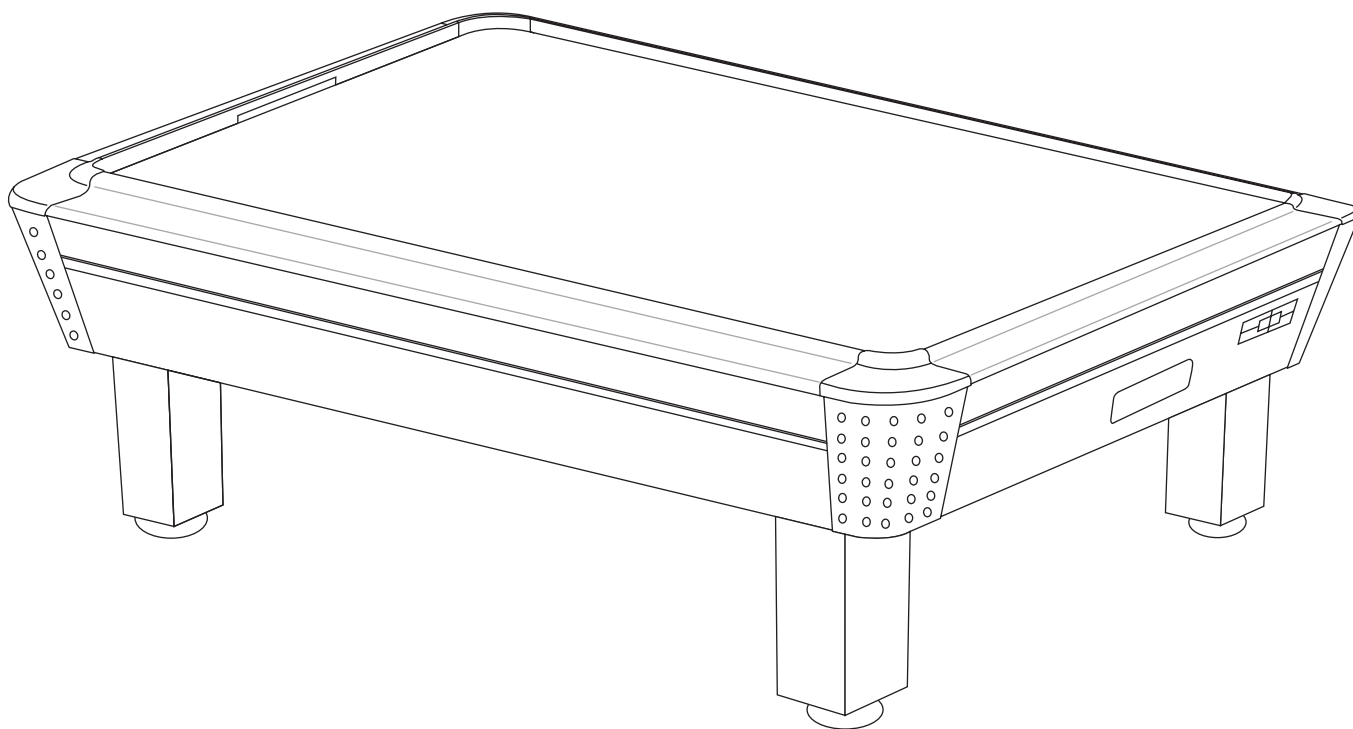

CARE AND USE OF YOUR ATOMIC HOCKEY TABLE

1. Use only a suitable 120v AC household outlet, and insure the cord is not a trip hazard.
2. Spray furniture polish is recommended to both protect the play field and increase the puck speed. Apply and wipe off with the air motor on.
3. This product is intended for **INDOOR** use only.
4. **DO NOT** operate the motor if the cord is damaged in any way.
5. **DO NOT** sit, climb or lean on the table.
6. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the legs.
7. **DO NOT** set drinks on the table.

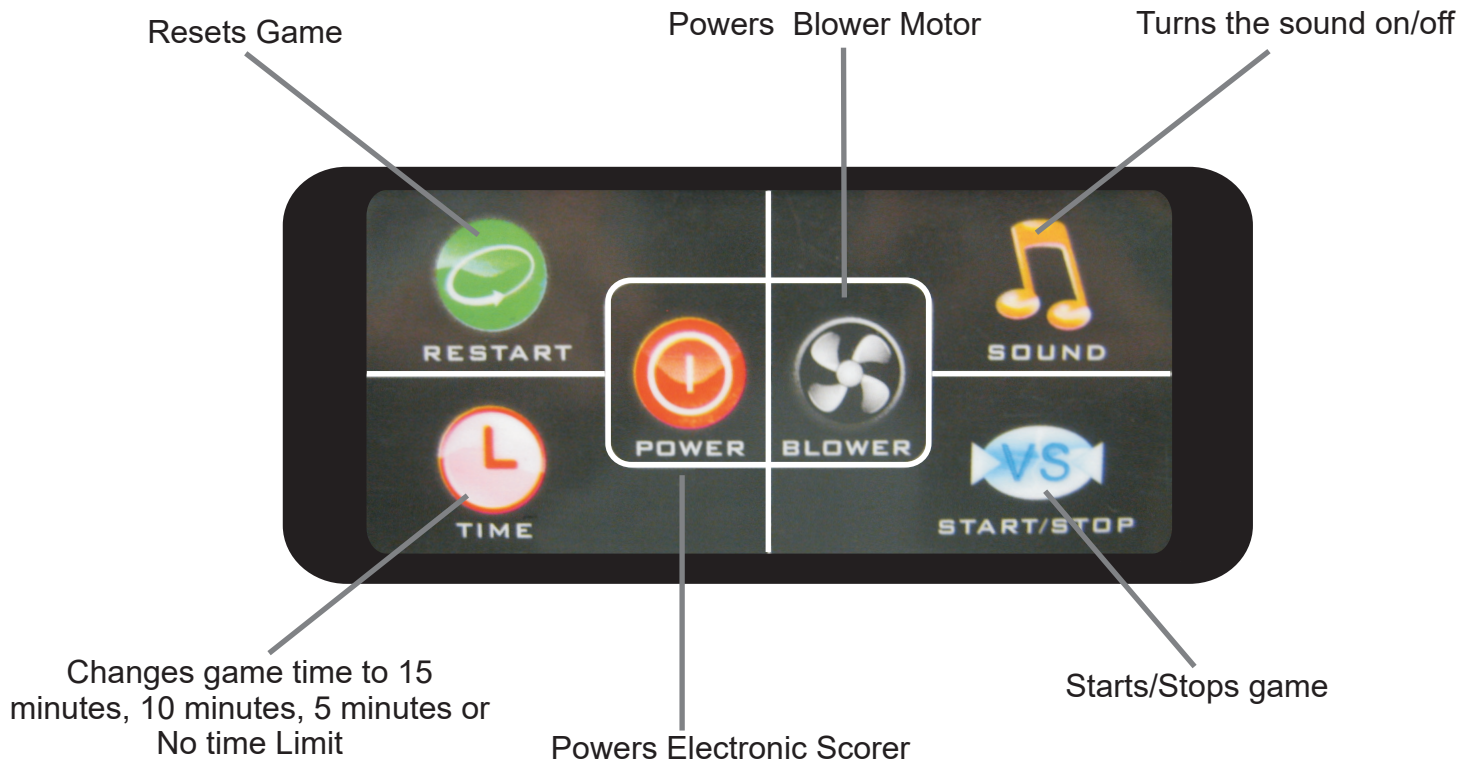


TABLE HOCKEY RULES

The Object of the Game

To score a predetermined number of points or to score the most points in a given amount of time.

To Play

Flip a coin to determine who will begin play. Play begins when the puck is placed on the playing surface. Players must hit the puck with the striker and attempt to shoot it into their opponent's goal. One point is awarded when a puck is shot into the opponent's goal.

Sometimes pucks can fly off the table. If this occurs, players may take turns placing the puck back on the table.

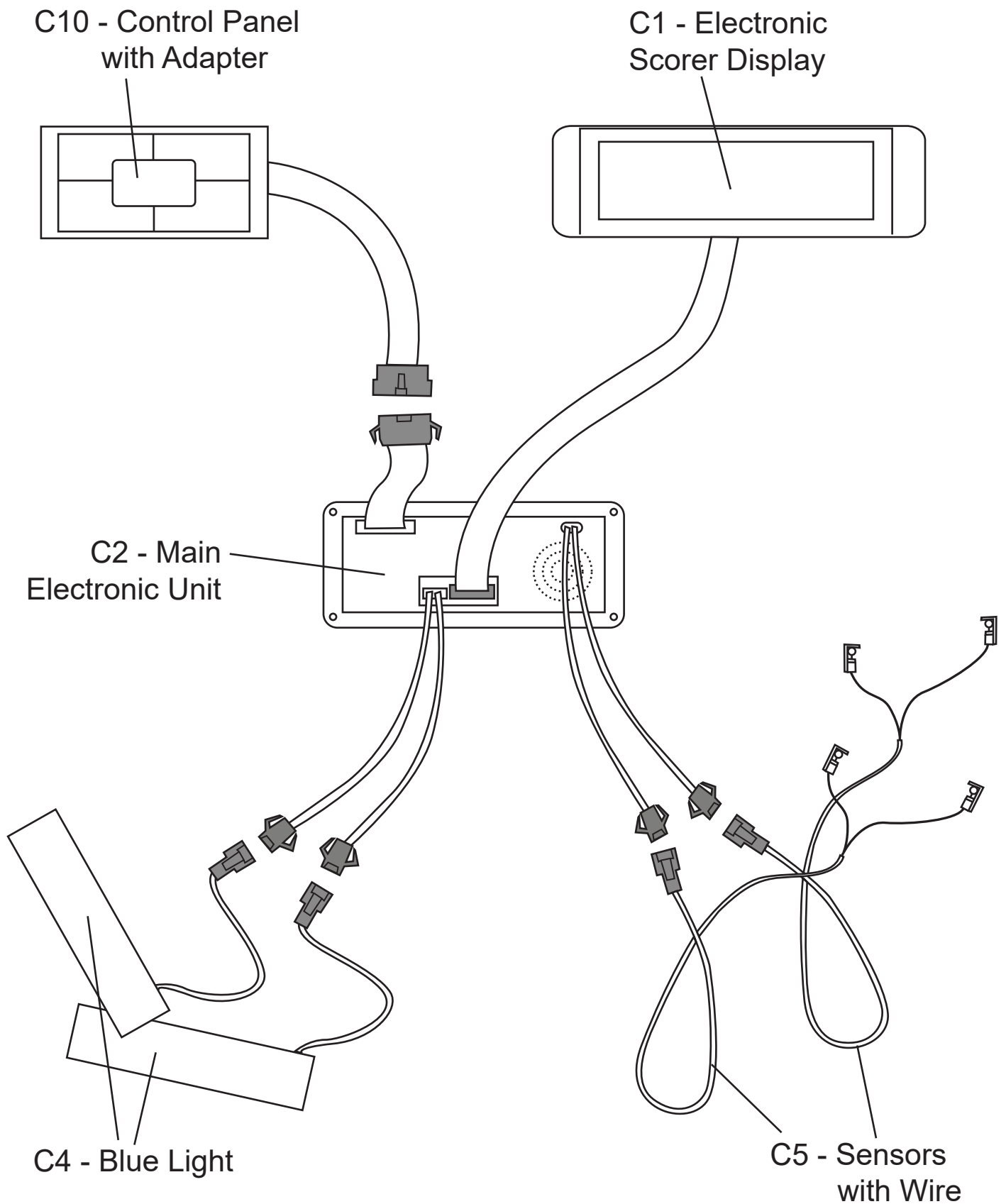
