

THIS SURVEY LOOKS AT ENERGY/ELECTRICITY USAGE WITHIN THE HOME


A vast majority of Americans [90%] say that someone in their household forgets to turn lights off when they leave a room.




People believe the **BIGGEST WASTE** of electricity in the home is lights left on in an empty room.




CHILDREN get the majority of the blame for leaving lights on in households with children under 18 present.
