Care and use

Before using the cookware for the first time, it is essential to hand-wash it thoroughly. This cookware is suitable for use on hobs, including induction, and for optimum energy efficiency, it is advisable to place the cookware on hob rings that match the size of its base. Care should be taken to prevent flames from overlapping the sides or handles. To enhance the longevity of the cookware, it is recommended to utilise silicone, wooden, or nylon utensils, as the use of metal utensils can lead to damage. Additionally, avoid overheating the cookware or allowing it to boil dry, and never leave it unattended while in use. It is important to note that the non-stick coating may discolour over time, although this will not affect the cookware's functionality. To prevent any damage to ceramic hobs, always lift the cookware instead of dragging it across the hob surface, and periodically check and retighten screws using a screwdriver, as they may loosen over time. For cleaning and storage, allow the cookware to cool before cleaning, as it is not dishwasher safe; instead, hand-wash it with a mild detergent and a non-abrasive sponge, then rinse and dry thoroughly. It is crucial not to store wet cookware. As a precaution, always use heat-resistant oven gloves to handle the cookware, and never expose hot cookware to cold liquids. Should there be any signs of damage, dispose of the cookware carefully.
