Attach two part 1 shelf side frames to one part 2 & 3 table side frames with two part D & part E screws. Set aside these assemblies.

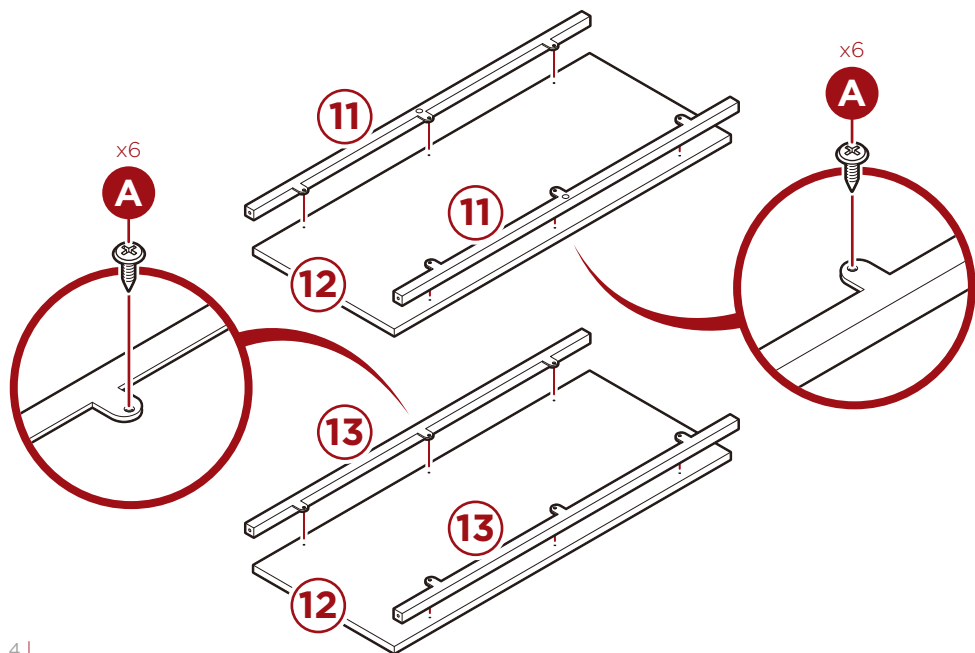
NOTE: Insert the part D screws from the bottom of the shelf frames, through the table frame.

Locate one part 12 lower shelves and attach two part 11 Lower shelf frames with six part A screws.

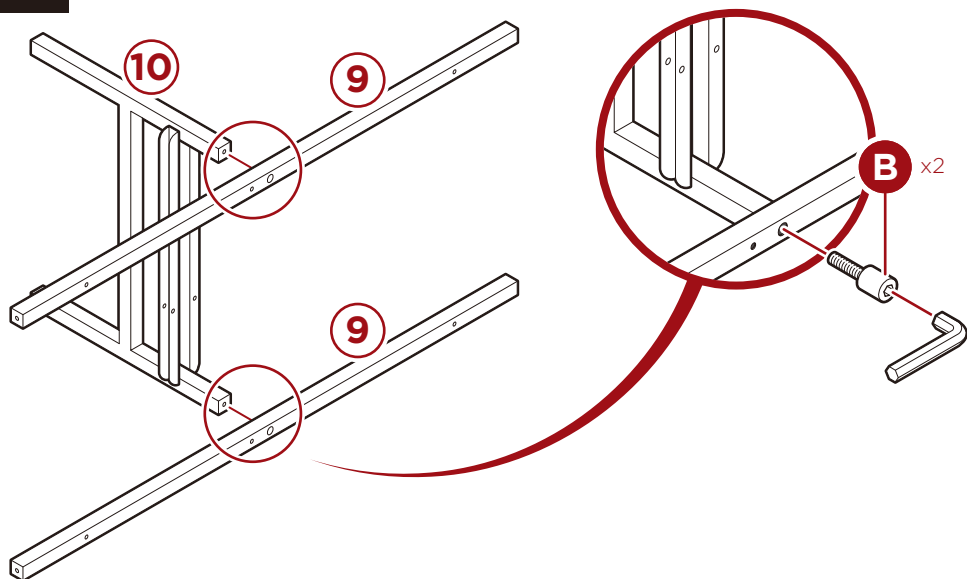
Repeat to attach two part 13 shelf frames to one part 12 lower shelf. Set aside these assemblies.

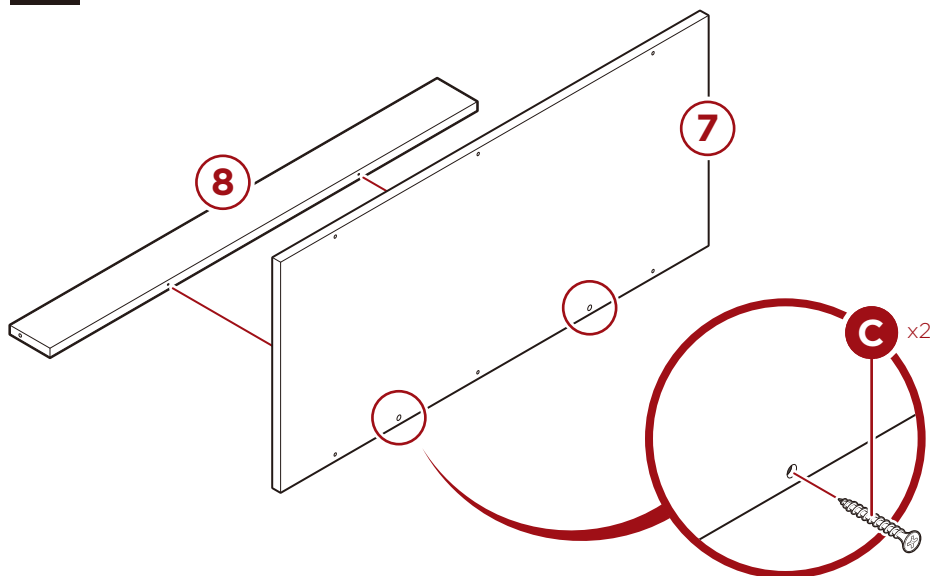

Locate the part 10 table top support and attach two part 9 table top frames with two part B shaft bolts. Set aside this assembly.

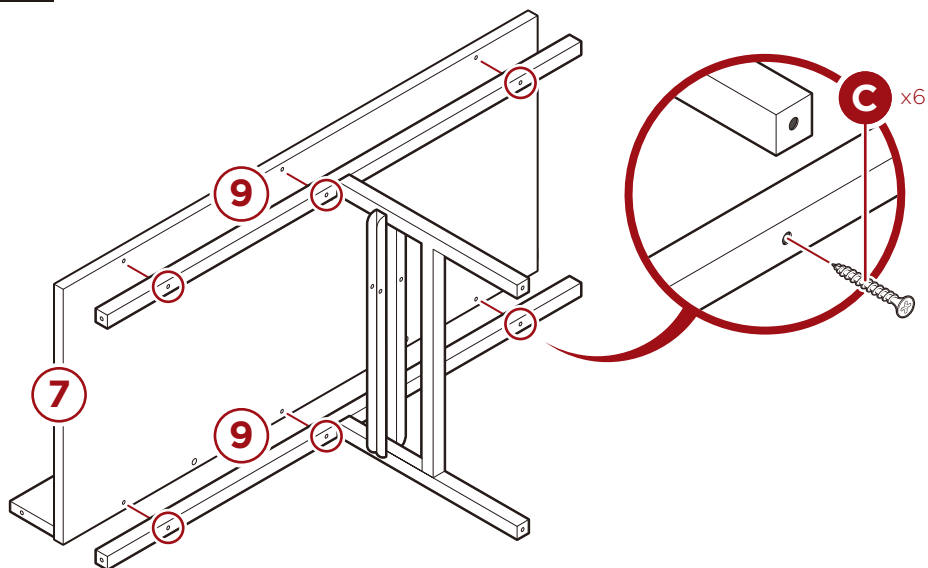
Attach one part 7 table top to one part 8 backplash with two part C screws.

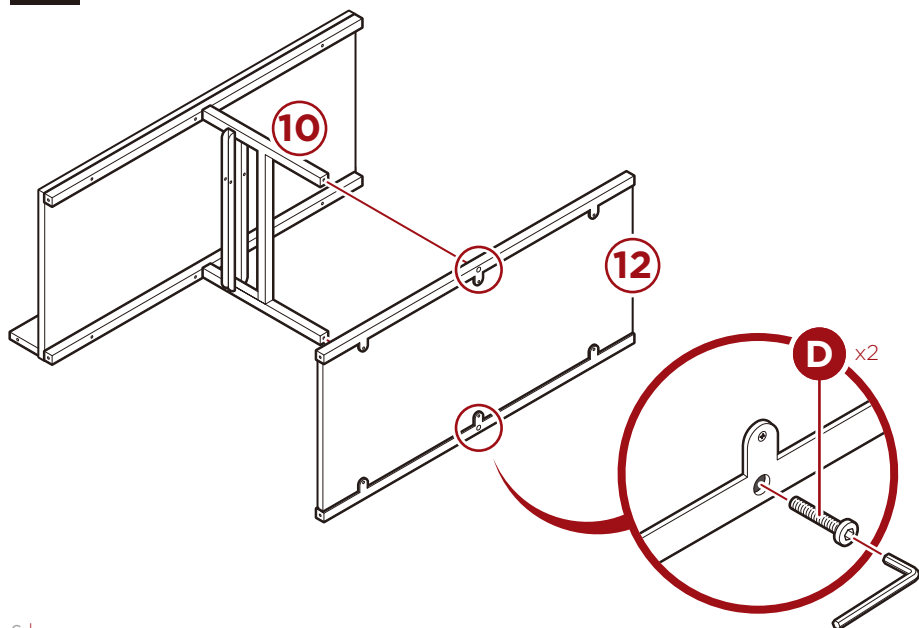

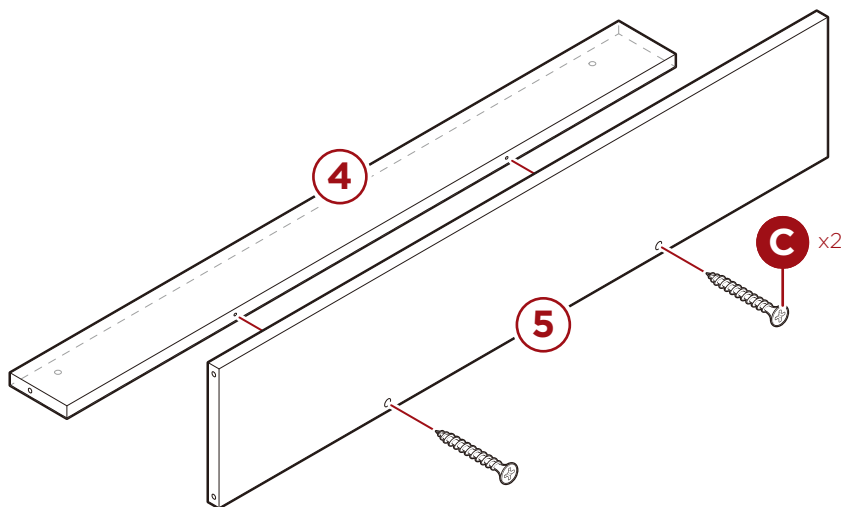
Attach the part 12 lower shelf assembly to the part 10 table top support with two part D screws.

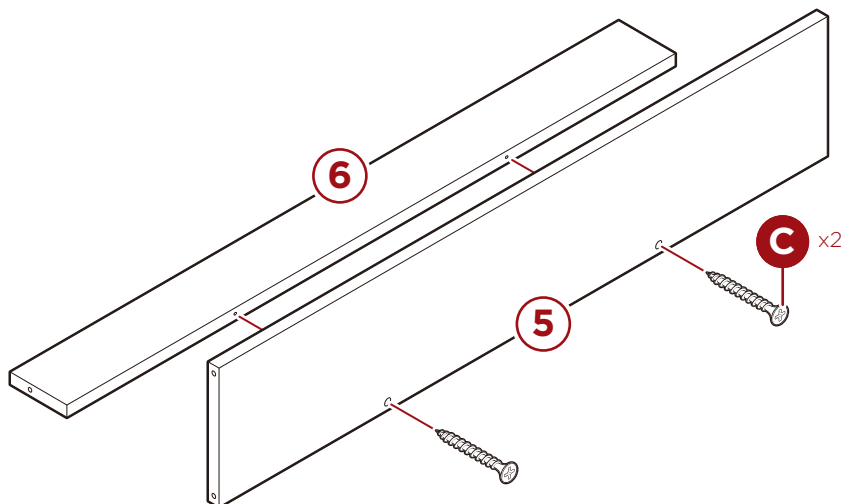

Attach one part 5 shelf to the part 6 upper shelf back with two part C screws.



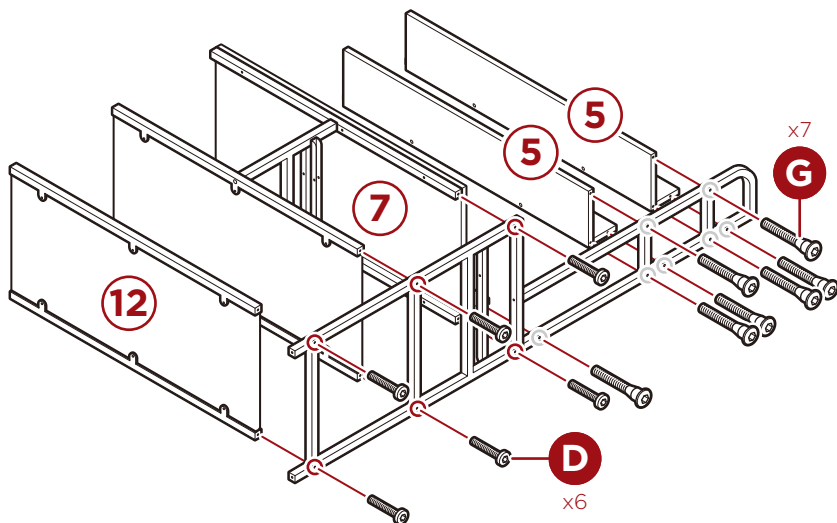

Attach the two part 12 lower shelf assemblies with four part D screws.

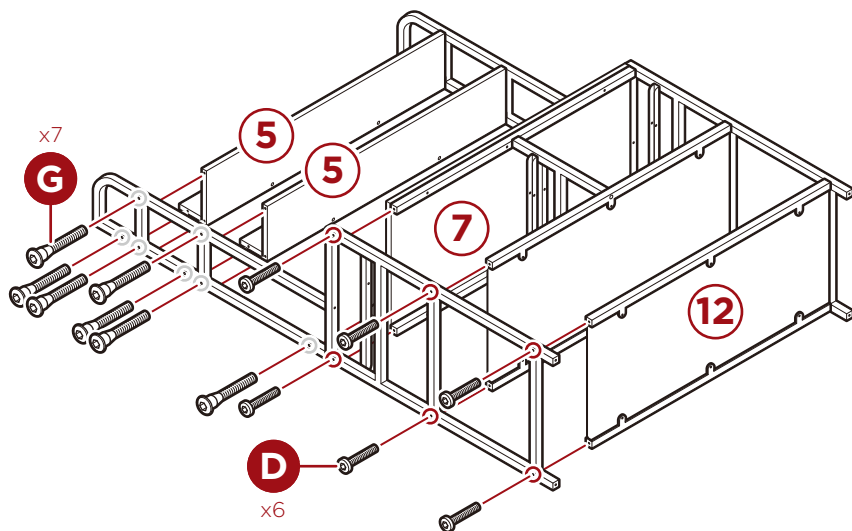

Attach the part 7 table top assembly with two part D screws & one part G screw.

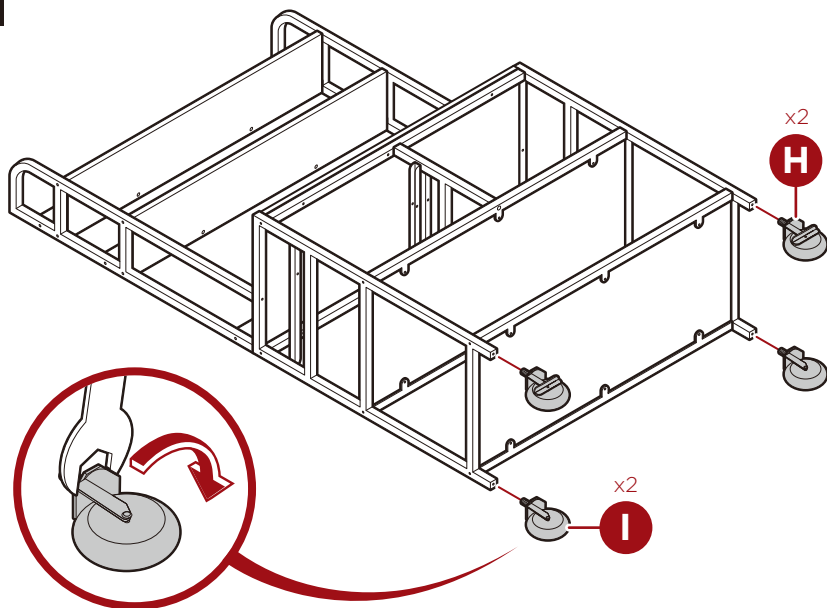
Attach the two part 12 lower shelf assemblies with four part D screws.

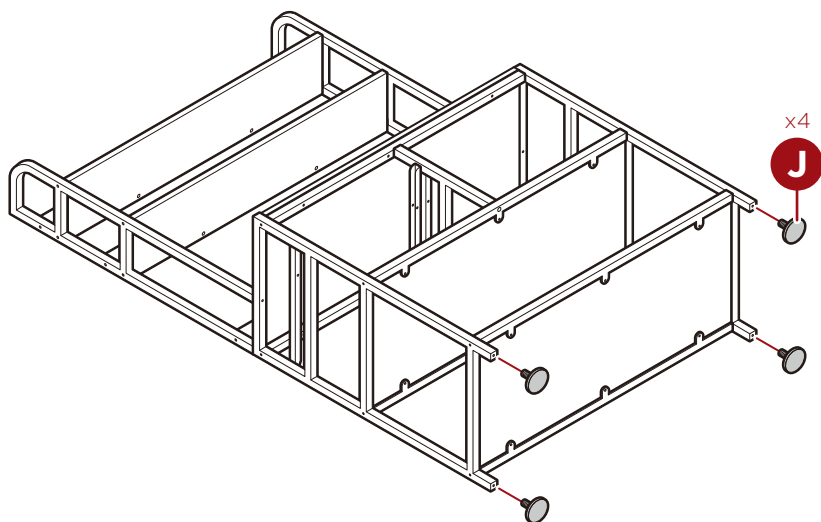

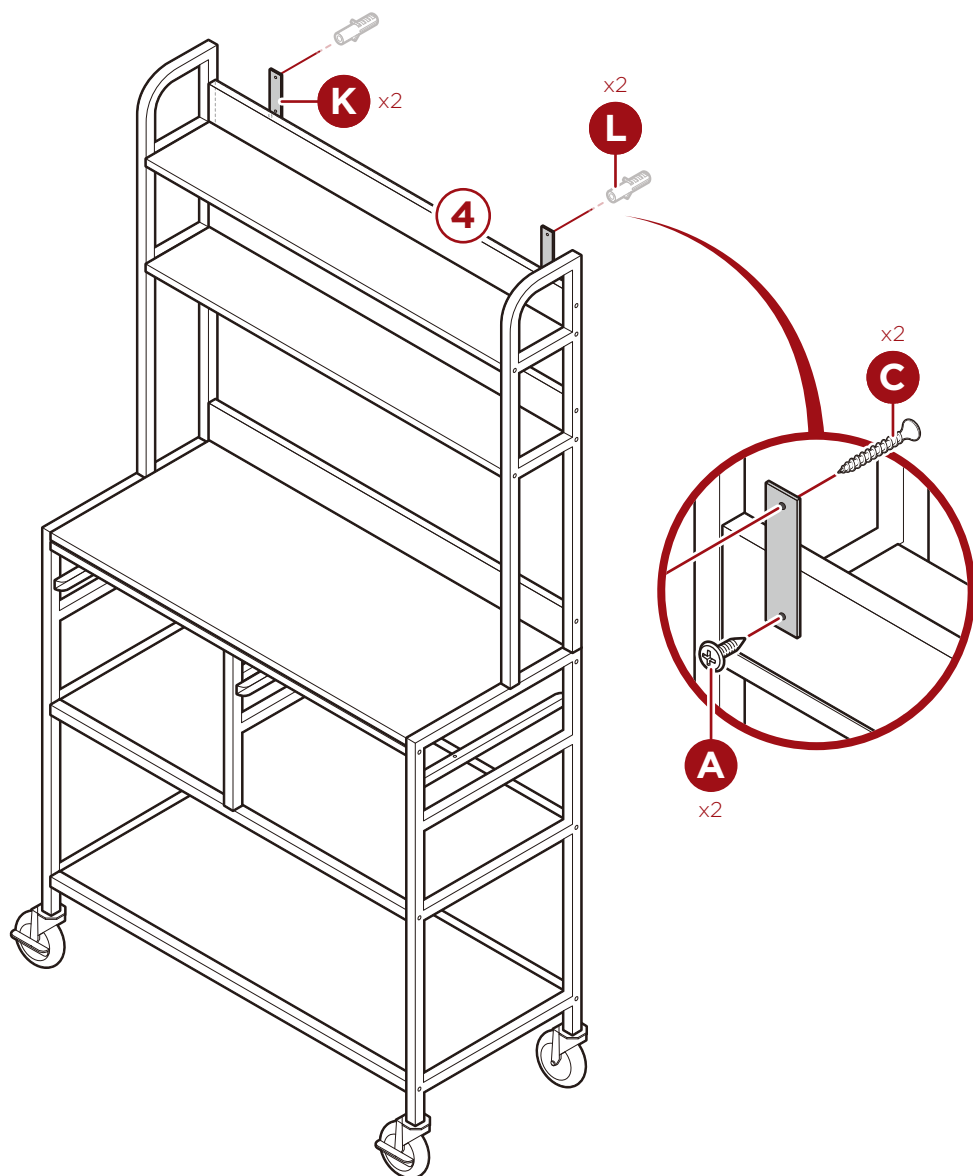
Insert four part J foot pads.

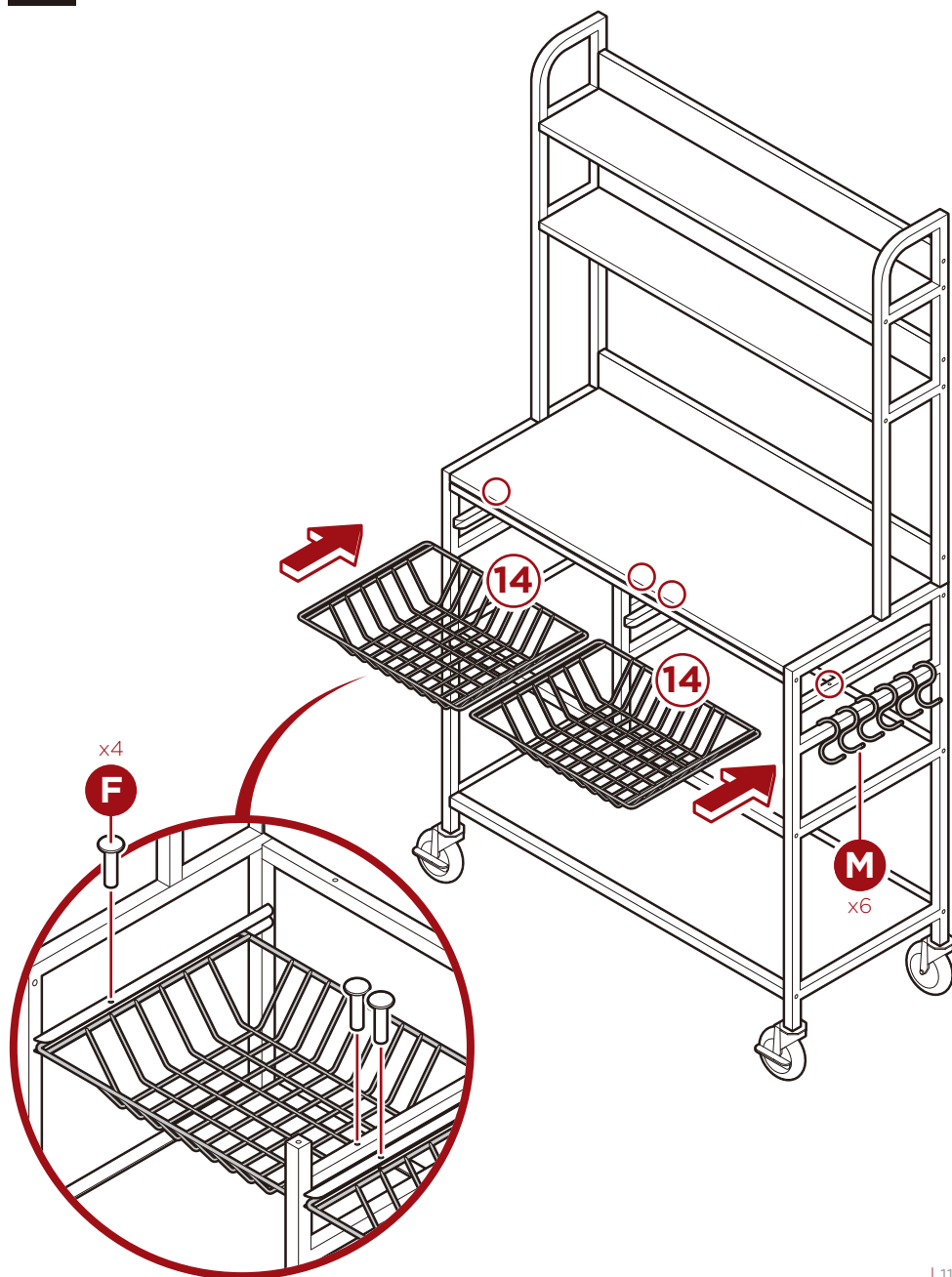
Attach the two part K wall brackets to the part 4 shelf back with two part A screws. Then attach the product to an existing structure with two part L wall anchors and two part C screws.

PRODUCT WARRANTY INFORMATION

All items can be returned for any reason within 60 days of the receipt and will receive a full refund as long as the item is returned in its original product packaging and all accessories from its original shipment are included.
