


STEP 6

Attach Back Panels (M) and (N) to unit using 1/2" Round Head Screws and Flat Washers.

IMPORTANT

• To help reduce the risk of the unit tipping over, the Tipover Restraint must be installed following these instructions exactly.

STEP 8

Place the unit at desired location.






Figure 3 Figure 4

Mark wall with pencil to show position of hole in Back Panel (M). (See Figure 3)

Move unit.

Drill a 3/8" hole in wall 2 1/2" below mark.

Insert Anchor into the wall hole and attach Tipover Restraint to Anchor with 1 1/2" Round Head Screw and Flat Washer. (See Figure 4)




Figure 5 Figure 6

Move unit back into place and insert Tipover Restraint into unit through hole in Back Panel (M). (See Figure 5)

Screw Tipover Restraint to unit with 1/2" Round Head Screw and Flat Washer. (See Figure 6)
