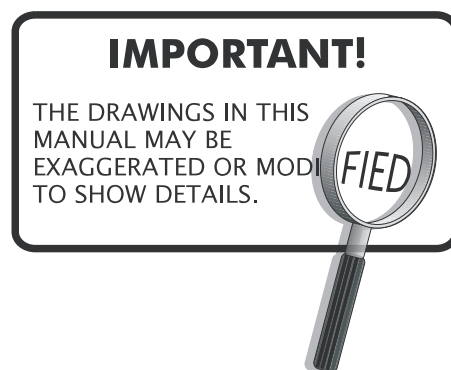

TWO ADULTS ARE REQUIRED TO ASSEMBLE THIS HT250 AIR HOCKEY TABLE

Tools Required:

- A3 - Allen Wrench (Included)
- Phillips Screwdriver
- Furniture Polish and Cloth

An electric screwdriver is helpful in assembly. However, please set at low torque and use extreme caution with an electric screwdriver because you could overtighten the hardware and strip the screws.













Make sure you understand the following tips before you begin to assemble your hockey table.

1. Start all bolts by hand before tightening.
2. Some drawings or images in this manual may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before starting each assembly step.

PARTS REQUIRED:

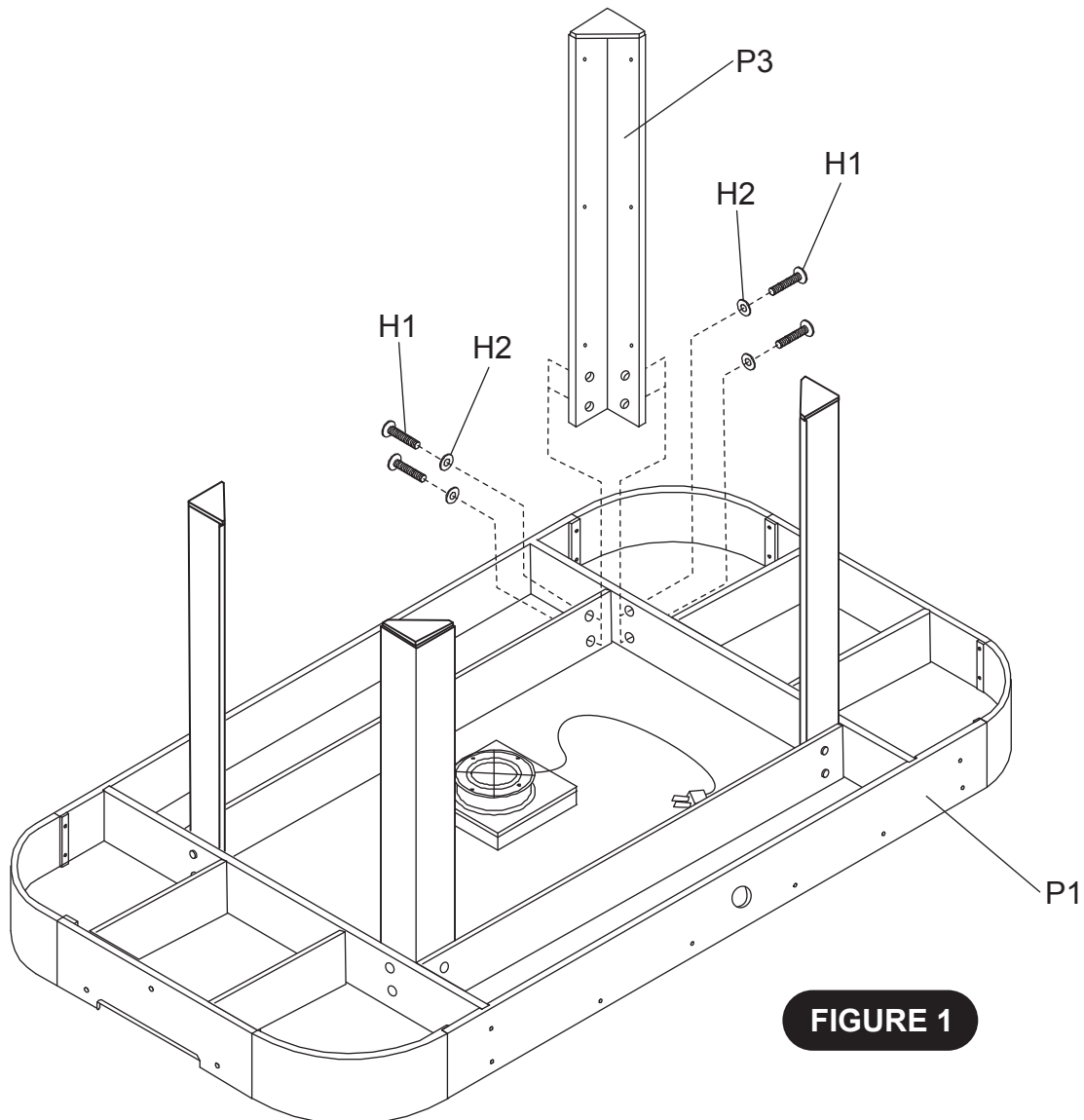
1 pc - **P1** Air Hockey Table Cabinet
4 pcs - **P3** Leg

16 pcs - **H1** Allen Head Bolt
16 pcs - **H2** Flat Washer
1 pc - **A3** Allen Wrench

STEP 1:

Leave Hockey Table Cabinet **P1** face down in carton to assemble.

Attach Legs **P3** using Allen Head Bolts **H1** with Flat Washers **H2** as shown in **FIGURE 1**.
Use Allen Wrench **A3** to tighten bolts.



PARTS REQUIRED:

12 pcs - **H3** Phillips Round
Head Screw

2 pcs - **P2** Leg End Panel

STEP 2:

With the help of another adult, align the holes in the Leg End Panels **P2** with the pre-drilled pilot holes in the Legs and attach with Phillips Round Head Screws **H3** as shown in **FIGURE 2**.

Important Note: Tighten, but do not strip out H3 screws.

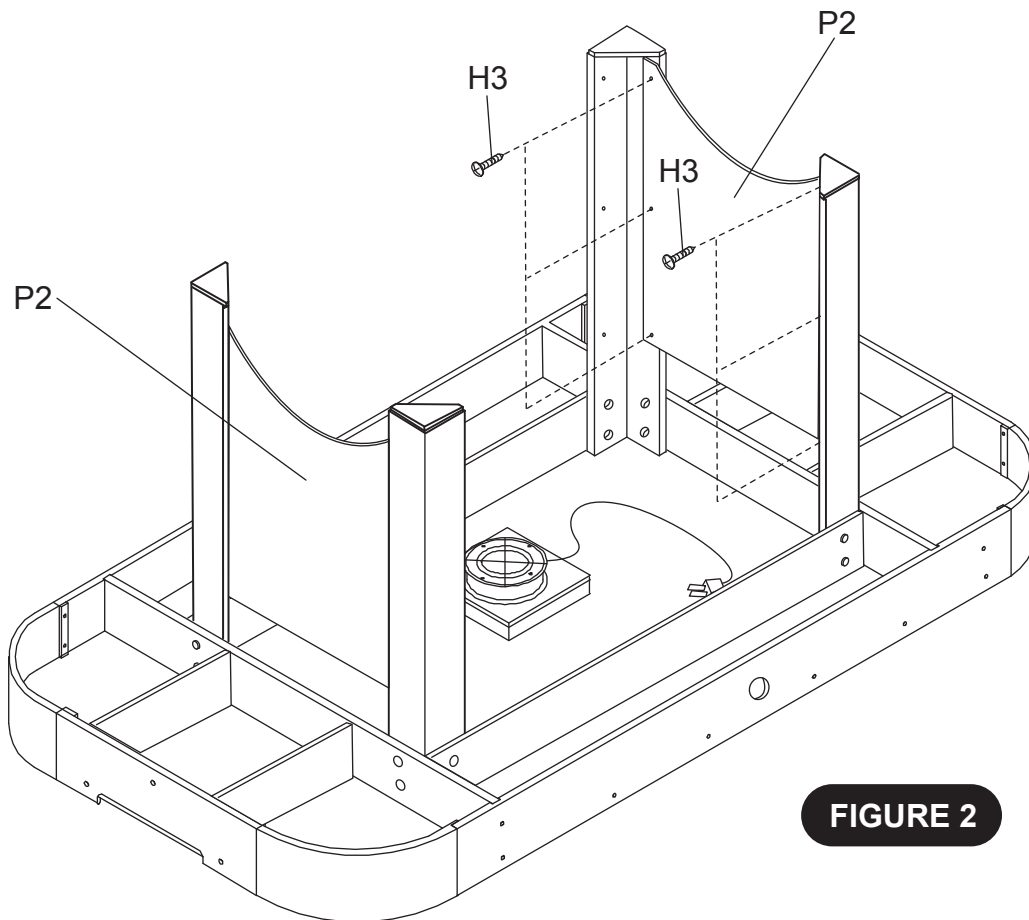

PARTS REQUIRED:

2 pcs - **P5** Goalflex80 Goal
6 pcs - **H3** Phillips Round Head Screw
4 pcs - **H4** Phillips Round Head Screw

WARNING:

THIS STEP REQUIRES TWO OR MORE ADULTS.
VERY CAREFULLY TURN THE TABLE OVER AND SET IT ON ITS LEGS. BE CAREFUL, THE TABLE IS HEAVY.

STEP 3:

With the help of another adult, carefully lift and rotate table into upright position.

First, feed the sensor plug from each Goalflex80 Goal **P5** through each end apron as shown in **FIGURE 3A**.

Next, use pilot holes provided to attach each Goalflex80 Goal **P5** using Phillips Round Head Screws **H3** and Phillips Round Head Screws **H4** as shown in **FIGURE 3B**.

Important Note: Tighten, but do not strip out H3 and H4 Screws.

Next, feed the plugs through underneath support beams and through long side apron as shown in **FIGURE 3C**.

PARTS REQUIRED:

- 1 pc - **P6** Goalflex80 Scoring Console
- 1 pc - **P7** Scoring Console Holder
- 2 pcs - **H4** Phillips Round Head Screw

STEP 4:

First, feed the sensor plugs from Goalflex80 Scoring Console **P6** through Scoring Console Holder **P7** as shown in **FIGURE 4**.

Attach Goalflex80 Scoring Console **P6** to Scoring Console Holder **P7** using Phillips Round Head Screws **H4** as shown in **FIGURE 4**.

Important Note: Tighten, but do not strip out H4 Screws.

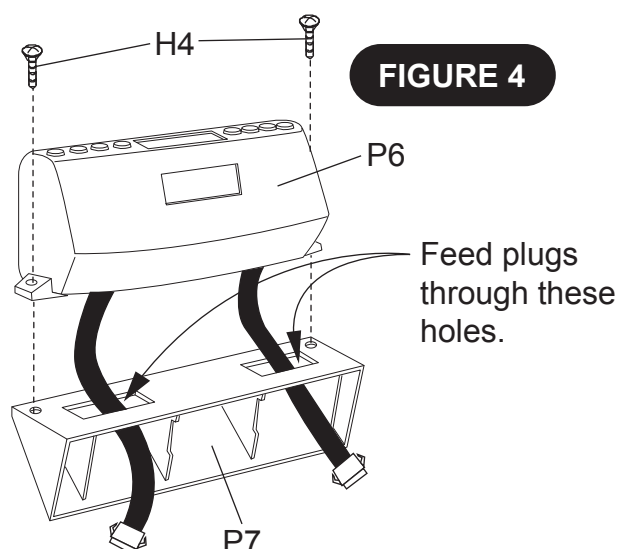

STEP 5:

Carefully connect **P6** Console male connectors to **P5** Goal female connectors as shown in **FIGURE 5**.

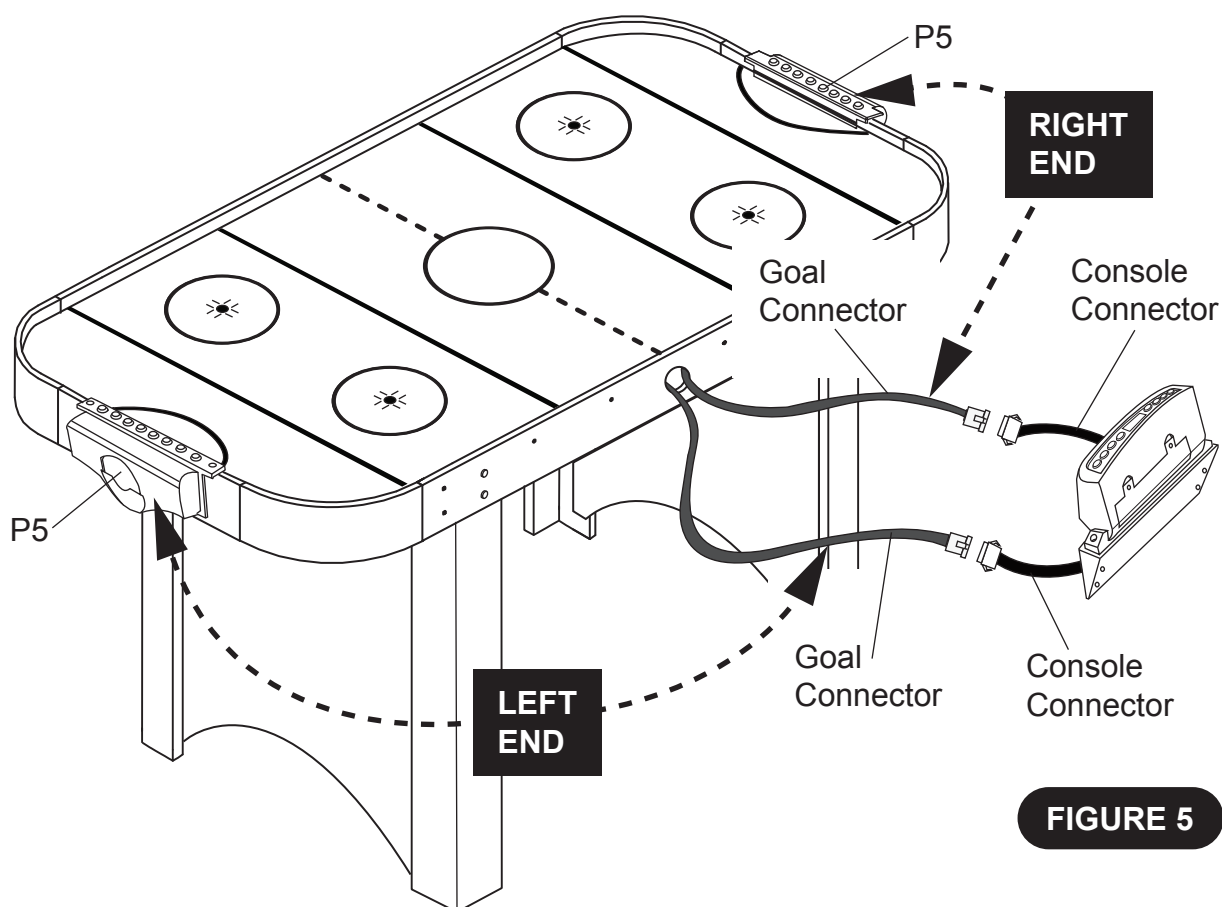

PARTS REQUIRED:

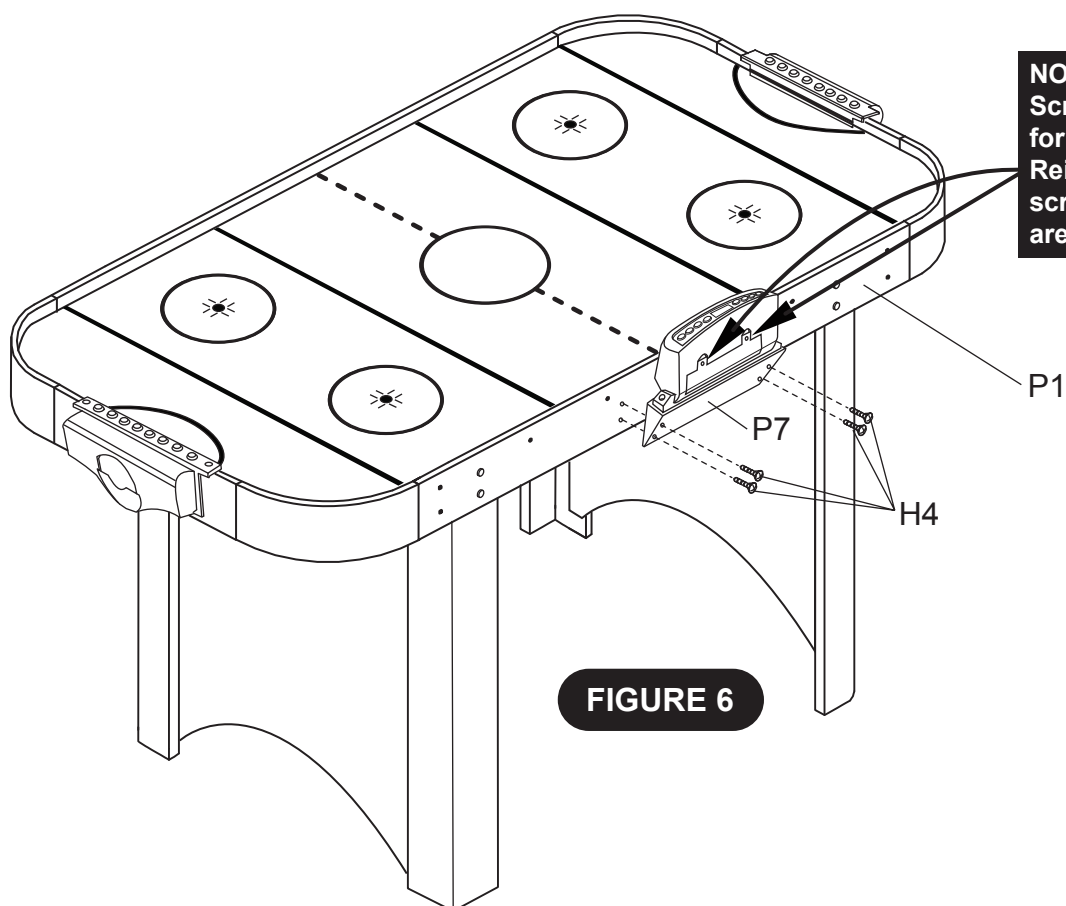
4 pcs - **H4** Phillips Round Head Screw

STEP 6:

First, feed the connectors back through hole on Side Apron **P1** and attach Scoring Console Holder **P7** using Phillips Round Head Screws **H4** as shown in **FIGURE 6**.

Important Note: Tighten, but do not strip out H4 Screws.

Install 3 “C” size batteries (not included) into Goalflex80 Scoring Console **P6**.



NOTE: Remove these 2 Screws to remove cover for battery installation. Reinstall cover + cover screws after batteries are installed.

Congratulations! You have now assembled your Hockey Table. Please note the Care and Use instructions below to ensure many years of trouble free use of your Hockey Table.

CARE AND USE OF YOUR HOCKEY TABLE

1. Use only a suitable 120v AC household outlet, and insure the cord is not a trip hazard.
2. For long life and best play from your air hockey table, apply spray furniture polish to clean cloth and wipe down the playfield with air motor running to make the pucks slide faster before first play and frequently thereafter.
3. This product is intended for **INDOOR** use only.
4. **DO NOT** operate the motor if the cord is damaged in any way.
5. **DO NOT** sit, climb or lean on the table.
6. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the legs.
7. **DO NOT** set drinks on the table.
8. It is suggested that this table be placed close to wall thus allowing the air motor cord to **NOT** be a trip hazard. Always turn air motor off when table is not in use.

GOALFLEX ELECTRONIC SCORER OPERATION:

POWER ON/OFF = Press ON/OFF button to start the Goalflex scoring unit. Long press ON/OFF button to turn off the Goalflex scoring unit.

GAME TYPE = Press GAME TYPE button to select POWER PLAY, SOLO or DOUBLE game type.

GOAL SIZE = Press GOAL SIZE button to adjust your goal size.

HANDICAP = Press HANDICAP button to select versus mode handicap options.

TIME = Press TIME button to select time options 20 , 15 , 10 or 5 minutes.

AFTER GOAL DELAY = Press AFTER GOAL DELAY button to turn off NON-STOP scores mode.

MUTE = Press MUTE button to turn the sound ON or OFF.

START/PAUSE = Press START/PAUSE button to START or PAUSE the game.

NOTE: If NO GAME TYPE has been select or the START/PAUSE button is not pressed for 3 minutes, the scoring unit will automatically turn off. However we suggest turning the power off when the game will not be used for an extended period of time.
