Before You Begin

- Observe all local plumbing and building codes.
- Shut off the main water supply.
- Kohler Co. reserves the right to make revisions in the design of faucets without notice, as specified in the Price Book.



1. Faucet Installation

- Insert the spout into the countertop or lavatory hole.
- Secure the faucet by installing the tapered gasket, brass spacer washer (thin-wall surfaces), and the hex nut to the faucet shank.
- Tighten the hex nut.

NOTE: For thin-wall mounting surfaces, use the brass spacer washer so the flared end faces upward.

- Use the provided coupling nut for ground-joint connections.
- Turn on the water supply, and inspect for leaks.
