





General Assembly Guidelines


- I. Ensure that all parts and hardware are available before beginning assembly.

Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from tip-over. To help prevent tip-over, install tip restraints per instructions. If using to support a television or monitor:


- For use with televisions weighing 50lbs (22.67Kg) or less and no wider than this product. Use with heavier televisions may result in instability causing tip over resulting in death or serious injury.
- Death or serious injury may occur when children climb on audio/or video equipment furniture. Remote control or toys placed on the furnishing may encourage a child to climb on the furnishing and as a result the furnishing.
- Do not place TV near front the edge of the product.

To further reduce the risk of serious injury and death from tip-overs:

- Place heaviest items in the lowest compartments or drawers.
- Never allow children to climb or hang on drawers, doors or shelves.
- Never open more than one drawer at a time.

The use of tip-over restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate the risk of tip-over.

For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e., plaster, drywall, concrete, etc). Mount to wood studs whenever possible. **Note: if you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting the method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.**
