

# Mounting


The mounting bar and screw clamps are specifically designed for use with Weaver bases.

To install, first remove front screw, clamp, and locking nut. Next, fit rear clamp onto rear Weaver base, making sure screw fits into groove, and tighten locking nut. Next, insert screw in proper hole of mounting bar so that it positions the clamp directly above the front Weaver base. The screw will remain above the base and need not fit into the groove. Tighten both locking nuts securely.

# **Bore sighting**

Remove the bolt and place weapon on solid, flat surface. Aim the weapon (by looking through the bore) at a small distant target.

Move the eye from the bore to the sight, being careful not to move the weapon. When looking through the



sight, the red point should be on target. If not, adjust the sight for windage and/or elevation until red point is on After carefully bore sighting, the bullet should strike within 20-30 centimeters (8-12 inches) of target at a distance of 100 meters. (110 vards)

Final adjustment is made in the normal way of shooting at a target. Be sure to re-tighten locking nuts after first few shots

#### Windage adjustment

Each click of the windage adjustment knob is equal to 1 centimeter (1/2 inch) movement of the point of impact at a distance of 100 meters. (110 yards). Adjustment is made by fitting hexagonal key into center of the windage adjustment screw and turning in the direction the point of impact is to be moved.

#### Elevation adjustment

Each mark on the elevation adjustment scale is equal to 1 centimeter (1/2 inch) of movement of the point of impact at a distance of 100 meters. (110 yards).

Adjustment is made by fitting hexagonal key into the center of the elevation adjustment screw and turning in the direction the point of impact is to be moved.

# Maintenance

Your Aimpoint sight is a precision optical and electronic instrument. It is manufactured and inspected to meet the highest standards. The only maintenance required is a regular change of batteries and dry agent cartridge, which should be done yearly. The change should be done indoors to avoid unwanted moisture entering battery compartment.

Check to insure the battery lid and contact surfaces of the batteries have not become oxidized.

# Polarizing filters

The Aimpoint sight is equipped with polarizing filters to help eliminate problems caused by glare.

The front filter is mounted on the sight at the factory. The rear filter is pushed into position and the contrast effect is adjusted by turning the rear filter right or left. Adjust the rear filter to eliminate any reflected or glaring light. Then set the intensity of the red point to the desired level. When hunting at night or in heavy rain, remove both filters; the rear filter is pulled off, the front filter is screwed off.

## Accessories

Batteries which are to be used are designated PX1/RM1N or EPX-1 and are available from your gun dealer or your local camera shop.

Note: The batteries must not be plastic coated. For winter use, or in extreme cold, the PX1/RM1N are recommended

The dry agent cartridge is supplied in a fully sealed glass vial. When changing the cartridge, break the vial, and immediately place the cartridge in the battery lid.

#### PROCEDURE FOR REMEDY DEFECTS

If any Aimpoint Sight contains or develops a defect covered by this Warranty during the warranty period, the buyer shall take the following steps in order to remedy that defect:

If the above procedure is followed and if Aimpoint USA, Inc. determines that a defect covered by this Warranty exists, Aimpoint USA, Inc. will, within a reasonable time, at its option and expense, either repair the defect or replace the Almpoint Sight, and, at its ex-pense, return the repaired or replacement Aimpoint Sight to the buyer. Aimpoint USA, Inc. is the only person authorized to perform repairs under this Warranty.
