In addition, many of our solid wood cribs are bench-made in small shops using traditional joinery techniques that cannot be accomplished in mass production. For other cribs, we employ precise CNC milling that allows us to realize designs that were previously unimaginable. This combination of the latest fabrication technology with traditional techniques and our cutting-edge designs is unique to Nursery Works. Low- and no-VOC finishes are used across all our products and our products are tested to governmental standards on an annual basis.

Please note that due to the handcrafted nature of our products and our use of solid woods, each piece is unique and may possess color variations and irregular wood grain or surface texture. These natural characteristics are part of the beauty of real wood, are not considered manufacturing defects and do not merit replacements.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

To preserve the quality of your Nursery Works furniture we recommend periodically wiping with a damp, lint-free cotton cloth. Avoid getting the wood wet. Avoid furniture polish or cleaning sprays as they may change the sheen of the wood finish. Wood expands and contracts with temperature and humidity. Avoid placing the furniture in direct sunlight or near a heating or air conditioning vent.

MARNING

Parents should ensure a safe environment for the child by checking regularly, before placing the child in the product, that every component is properly and securely in place.

- The product, including side rails, must be fully erected prior to use.
- Strings can cause strangulation! Never place items with a string around a child's neck such as hood strings or pacifier cords.
 Never suspend strings over product or attach strings to toys.
- Discontinue use of the product when child is able to climb out or reaches the height of 35in. (90cm).

- Check proper fit of mattress. Should be not more than 5 inches thick. The maximum gap between mattress and inside of crib border (or edge) should be no more than 1 inch.
- Always provide the supervision necessary for the continued safety of your child. When used for playing, never leave child unattended.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS and suffocation, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their back to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.

- Never use this product if there are any loose or missing fasteners, loose joints, broken parts, or torn mesh/fabric. Check before assembly and periodically during use. Contact Nursery Works for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.
- Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers not sold and intended for that purpose. They can cause suffocation.
- Never use a water mattress with this product.
- If refinishing, use a nontoxic finish specified for children's products.

GRADIENT BASSINET CONVERSION



A WARNING

- If a sheet is used with the pad, use only the one provided by the bassinet or cradle manufacturer or one specifically designed to fit the dimensions of the bassinet or cradle mattress.
- Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a bassinet or cradle or attach strings to toys.
- Do not place this bassinet near a window or a patio door where a child could reach the cord of a blind or curtain and be strangled.
- Check this bassinet regularly before using it and do not use it if any parts are loose or missing or if there are any signs of damage.
- Do not substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer if replacement parts or additional instructions are needed.

To help prevent falls, do not use this product when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached manufacturer's recommended maximum weight 17.5 lbs (7.9 kg), whichever comes first.
