<b>Select PC Port</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Right-click the <b>KVM Switching Software</b> icon to bring up the <b>Operation Menu</b>. Select the desired <b>PC Port</b>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select <b>PC Port</b> to switch to.</li> </ul>
<b>Define Hotkey Sequence</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Right-click the <b>KVM Switching Software</b> icon to bring up the <b>Operation Menu</b>. Change the hotkey sequence to the desired keys. Select <b>"OK"</b>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Change the <b>hotkey sequence</b> to <b>"Ctrl + Alt"</b> if desired, or if no <b>Scroll Lock</b> key is available on the keyboard.</li> </ul>
<b>Start Autoscan</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Right-click the <b>KVM Switching Software</b> icon to bring up the <b>Operation Menu</b>. Select <b>"Start Autoscan"</b>. Select <b>"OK"</b>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enable <b>Autoscan</b> featuring, which automatically switches between <b>PC Ports</b>.</li> </ul>
<b>Define Autoscan Interval</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Right-click the <b>KVM Switching Software</b> icon to bring up the <b>Operation Menu</b>. Select <b>Settings</b>. Beside <b>"Autoscan Period"</b> use the dropdown to select the interval. Select <b>"OK"</b>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enable <b>Autoscan</b> featuring, which automatically switches between <b>PC Ports</b> at the defined rate.</li> </ul>
<b>Stop Autoscan</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Press any key on the <b>Keyboard</b>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stops the <b>Autoscan</b> feature on the current <b>PC Port</b>.</li> </ul>
<b>Keep in Dock (macOS Only)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Right-click the <b>KVM Switching Software</b> icon to bring up the <b>Operation Menu</b>. Select <b>"Keep in Dock"</b>. Select <b>"OK"</b>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>KVM Switching Software</b> icon will appear in the <b>System Tray</b> on the <b>Desktop</b>.</li> </ul>
<b>Open at Login (macOS Only)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Right-click the <b>KVM Switching Software</b> icon to bring up the <b>Operation Menu</b>. Select <b>"Open at Login"</b>. Select <b>"OK"</b>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>KVM Switching Software</b> will open after logging into the <b>Computer</b>.</li> </ul>
<b>Fix Audio Port</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Right-click the <b>KVM Switching Software</b> icon to bring up the <b>Operation Menu</b>. Select <b>Settings</b>. Beside <b>"Fix Audio to:"</b> use the dropdown to select the desired computer. Select <b>"OK"</b>.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enabling this feature will bind the <b>Mic/Speakers</b> to one <b>PC Port</b>. The <b>Audio</b> will not switch <b>PC Ports</b> with the <b>USB Devices</b> or <b>Video</b> until the feature is disabled.</li> </ul>
