OWNER'S MANUAL

1. **Read this manual carefully before starting assembly.** Read each step completely before beginning each step.
2. **Some smaller parts may be shipped inside larger parts. Check inside all parts and cartons before assembling or ordering parts.**
3. If hardware is tightened too soon, mounting holes may not align and parts may not easily fit together. Leave bolts slightly loose until you are instructed to tighten them.
4. **Tools required for assembly:** Wrench H9 (included).
5. To make assembly as easy as possible, place all parts of the table tennis table in a cleared area and remove the packaging material. Organize all parts as per parts identifier in the assembly manual. Do not dispose of the packing material until assembly is completed.
6. Avoid scratching table tennis top and metal tube parts during the assembly process.
7. Assemble product on a clean, level and flat surface.
8. **Take time to correctly orientate parts exactly as each assembly diagram.**
9. **Save this manual in the event that the manufacturer has to be contacted for replacement parts.**

First Time Battery Installation:

Remote Control

- On the back of the remote control, slide the battery cover in the direction of the arrow to remove it.
- Insert 2 AAA batteries in the correct orientation according to the +/- labels inside the remote control.
- Reinstall battery cover on the back of the remote control.

Install new batteries only after reading the "Battery Information NOTICE" !

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

Please retain this information for future reference. Batteries must be installed / replaced by an adult .

Notice: FOR REMOTE CONTROL BATTERIES ONLY

1. Remove and replace batteries when the electrical features of this product work slowly or are not functional.
2. Do not mix old and new batteries.
3. Do not mix different types of batteries : Alkaline , Standard (Carbon-Zinc) , or rechargeable (Nickel-Cadmium batteries).
4. Use Alkaline Batteries for maximum performance.
5. Do not use damaged batteries.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

You have purchased a quality product that will give you years of enjoyment. By following these simple maintenance steps, you will add to the life of your new table.

THE TABLE TOP

The top (playing surface) of your table is made of mid-density board. Like all products made of wood, it can be affected by atmospheric changes in both temperature and humidity. This may cause a slight sag or distortion as the top expands or contracts. This is normal and should not cause concern as it does not detract from the play or utility value of the table. After assembly of the table, you can minimize the effects of temperature and humidity changes by storing the table in a dry area when table is not in use.

STORAGE OF YOUR TABLE

This table must be stored indoors to prevent damage to the playing surface. Dampness and extreme temperature changes can cause the wood to warp, swell, crack or blister. When your table is not in use, it should be stored in a dry area. Due to the nature of mid-density board, table top may bow. Damp and humid conditions will amplify this. This is normal and will not affect playability of table.

CLEANING YOUR TABLE

To clean your table use a soft, damp (NOT WET) cloth only. To prevent damage to your table's playing surface, DO NOT USE ANY CHEMICALS, ABRASIVE OR CLEANING PRODUCTS on your table's playing surface.

MAINTENANCE OF YOUR TABLE

This table must be kept indoors to prevent damage to the playing surface. Dampness and extreme temperature changes, which occur on patios or similar areas, can cause wood to warp, swell, crack or blister.

UNEVEL FLOORS

If table does not seem level, it is probably due to uneven or unlevel floors. Set the table in its PLAYING POSITION and move table several inches in different directions to find the best location for the table. If the floor is extremely unlevel, table may not play or operate properly. If table is high in the center, shim up under the outer legs. The table has leg levelers - Adjust leg levelers as required.
