

Easy Fold 3 Step Ladder

Please retain instructions for future reference.

CARE AND USE

Max. weight: 150 kg.

Warning: There is danger of falling from the ladder.

Electricity hazard. Identify any electrical risks in the work area, such as overhead lines or other exposed electrical equipment and do not use the ladder where electrical risks occur.

Please read all of the instructions carefully and retain for future reference.

Pay special attention to all warnings and measures for optimum health and safety.

The distributor must make sure that the usage information is provided together with the ladder.

The owner of the ladder must make sure that the information is available to the ladder user.

There is danger of falling from the ladder.

Always inspect the ladder visually before every use to check it is not damaged and safe to use.

Max. total load of 150 kgs.

Do not use the ladder on uneven bases.

Do not overreach.

Do not erect or use the ladder on contaminated ground.

Do not lean the ladder on unsuitable surfaces (e.g. oil, mud).

Keep a secure grip on the ladder when ascending and descending.

Maintain a handheld tool to a minimum when practical and not exceed a maximum load of 2kg.

Do not carry equipment which is heavy or difficult to handle.

Do not wear unsuitable footwear when climbing a ladder.

Do not use the ladder if you are not fit enough.

Certain medical conditions or medication, alcohol or drug abuse could make ladder use unsafe.

Identify any electrical risk in the work area such as overhead lines or other exposed electrical equipment and do not use the ladder as a bridge.

Ladder is not needed for domestic use only.

Do not step off the ladder onto open shelves.

Open the ladder fully before use.

Do not use the ladder in wet or windy conditions.

Ensure the ladder is secure.

Do not use the ladder on leading ladder unless it is designed to do so.

Do not stand on the top steps/rungs of a standing ladder without a platform.

Do not stand on the top three steps/rungs of a leaning ladder.

Repair, maintenance and storage: Repairs must be carried out by a suitable person and be in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

Please contact the manufacturer for repair or spare parts (for example, stops, feet).

Store the ladder according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Do not store the ladder in rooms which could accelerate the deterioration of the ladder (e.g. humidity, excessive heat, etc.).

Keep the ladder in the correct position (e.g. use a suitcase cannot complement the ladder).

Keep the ladder in a way that avoids obstacles which could cause the ladder to twist or tip hazard.

Store the ladder in a way that prevents the possibility of use for criminal purposes.

Keep the ladder in restricted spaces that prevent unauthorised use (e.g. out of reach of children).

During regular checks, observe the following: Check the integrity of the legs and structure to make sure they are not twisted, scratched, dented or rusted.

Check the safety of the fastenings of the legs and the condition of the hinges (rivets, screws, etc.).

Check the feet and ensure that the fastening devices have not been removed.

Check the joints on the hinges in the front and rear sections, check the absence of rust and the strength of the lock to the ladder, the strength of the joint, absence of damage and rust, and the condition of the guide supports, that there is no rust damage, the rust and the strength of the fixation to the leg.

Check the condition of the ferrules, their fixation, absence of rust and damage.

Check the absence of dirt on the ladder (for example, mud, paint, oil) or grease.

Check the operation of the locking device (if installed) and the absence of defects such as rust.

Check the condition of all the parts and fixings elements on the platform (if applicable) and the absence of cracks in it.

It is PROHIBITED to use the ladder if one or more of the above points are not met.

Use of the ladder: Do not spend a lot of time on the ladder while working (risk of slipping).

Position the ladder correctly when transporting it to avoid damage.

Make sure that the ladder is suitable for the task at hand.

Do not use a dirty ladder, remove dirt, such as paint, oil or snow.

Do not use the ladder in adverse weather conditions, for example, strong winds.

Use caution when placing the ladder.

Take into account the risk of collision with people or objects (e.g. passersby, cars or doors).

In the work area, block the doors (except emergency exits) and windows where possible.

Use a ladder made of non-conductive material for electrical work.
