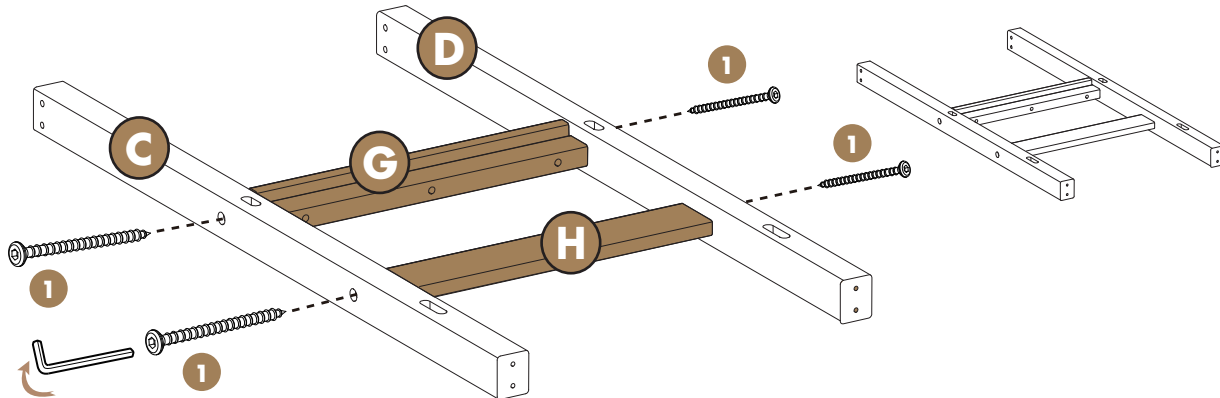
Please refer back to this image during the assembly process for part placement.

Step 1: Assemble the Rails and Table Legs

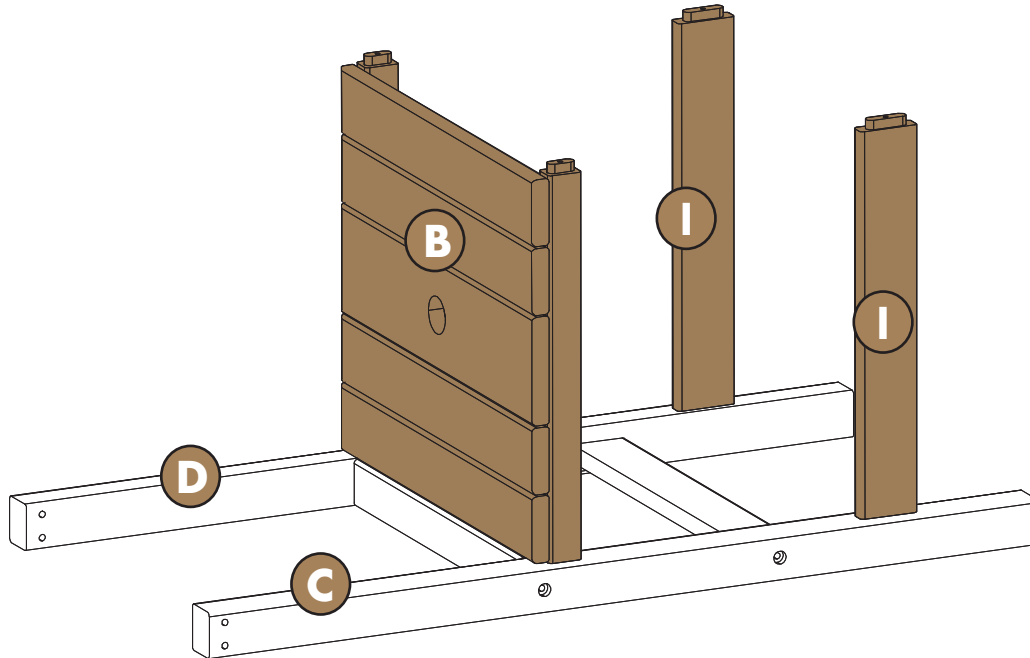
- Place **Table Legs (Part C and Part D)** on a flat, stable surface with the slots facing upward.
- Attach **Part G (Border Rail)** and **Part H (Side Rail I)** to **Table Legs (Part C and Part D)** using **4 - M6 Screw (#1)** (see image below).
- Do the same to attach another **Part G (Border Rail)** and **Part H (Side Rail I)** to **Table Legs (Part C and Part D)** (see image below).
- Do not fully tighten the bolts yet. Tighten them to approximately 70% to allow for adjustments during final assembly.

Step 2: Attach the Shelf and Side Rails

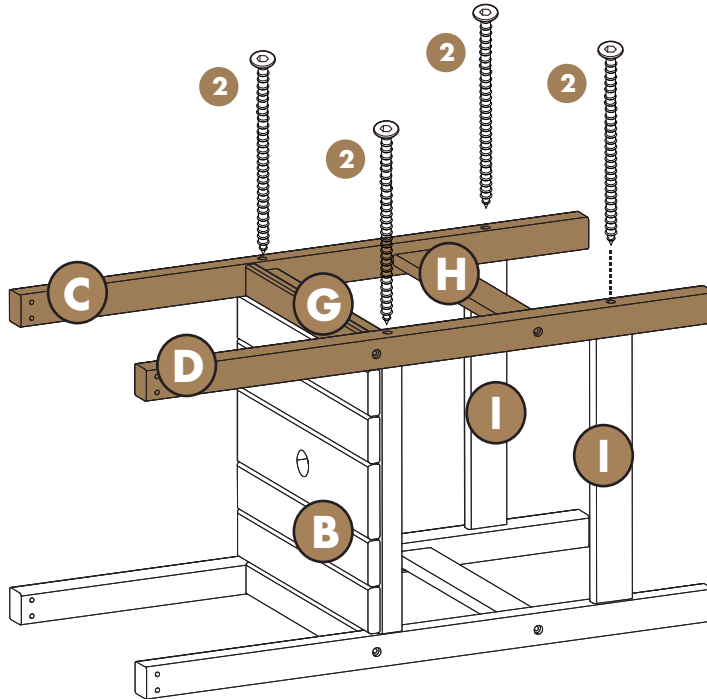
- Insert the ends on **Part B (Shelf)** and **2 - Part I (Side Rail II)** to the slots in **Part C** and **Part D (Table Legs)** (see image below).

Step 3: Secure the Legs and Rails

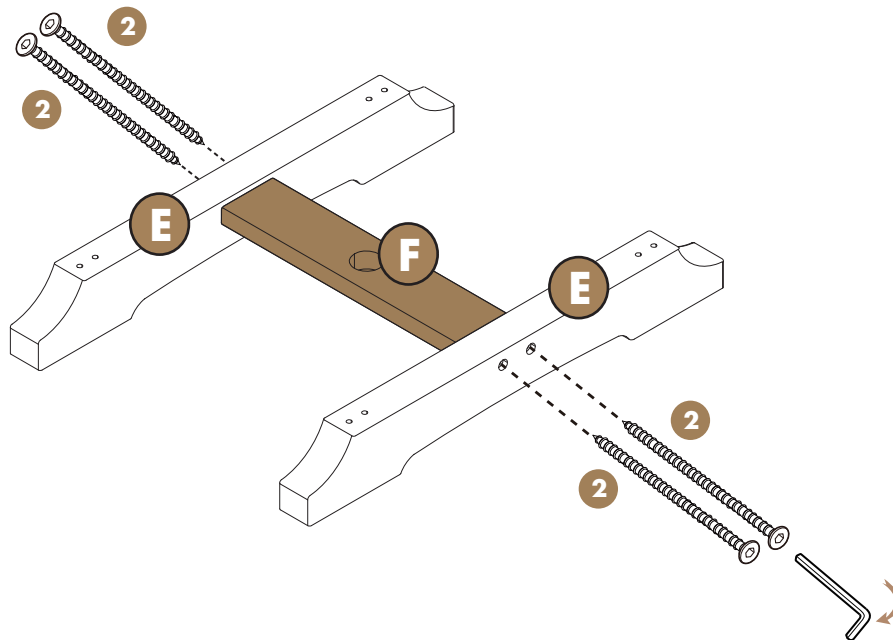
- Attach **Assembled Legs (Part C, Part D, Part G and Part H)** to **Part B (Shelf)** and **2 - Part I (Side Rail II)** using **4 - M6 Screw (#2)** (see image below).
- Do the same to attach the pre-installed **Legs (Part C, Part D, Part G and Part H)** (Step 2).

Step 4: Attach the Bottom Rail to the Foot Base

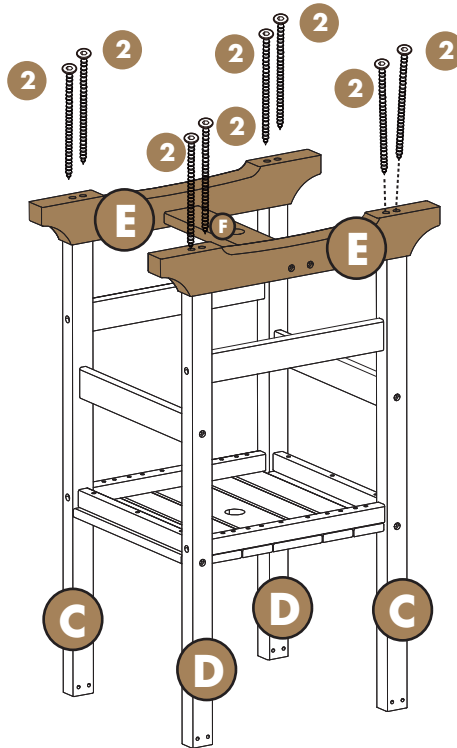
- Attach **Part F (Bottom Rail)** to **2 - Part E (Foot Base)** using **4 - M6 Screw (#2)** (see image below).

Step 5: Attach the Assembled Foot Base to the Assembled Frame

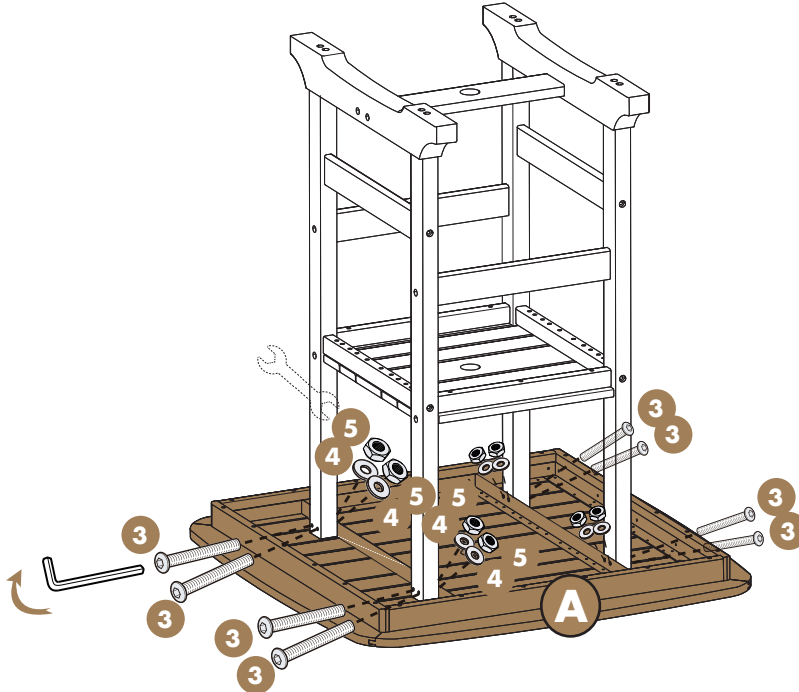
- Place the assembled frame upside down on flat surface and attach the **Foot Base (Part E, Part F and Part E)** to the **Assembled Legs (Part C and Part D)** using **8 - M6 Screw (#2)** (see image below).

Step 6: Attach the Table Top to the Assembled Frame

- Place **Part A (Table Top)** upside down on flat surface and attach it to the assembled frame. This requires **8 - sets** of the **M6 Bolt (#3)**, **M6 Washer (#8)**, and **M6 Nut (#7)** (see image below).

Step 7: Final Tightening and Stability Check

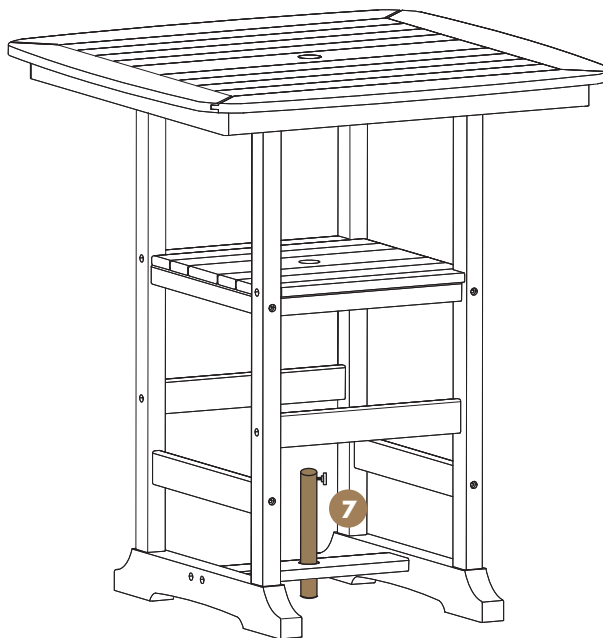
- Tighten all previously installed screws, bolts, and nuts. Check every connection to ensure the chair is steady and stable.

Tips: Extending the Height of your Umbrella

- Insert the **Umbrella Extension Pole (#7)** into the opening on the **Part F (Bottom Rail)** to increase your umbrella's height.

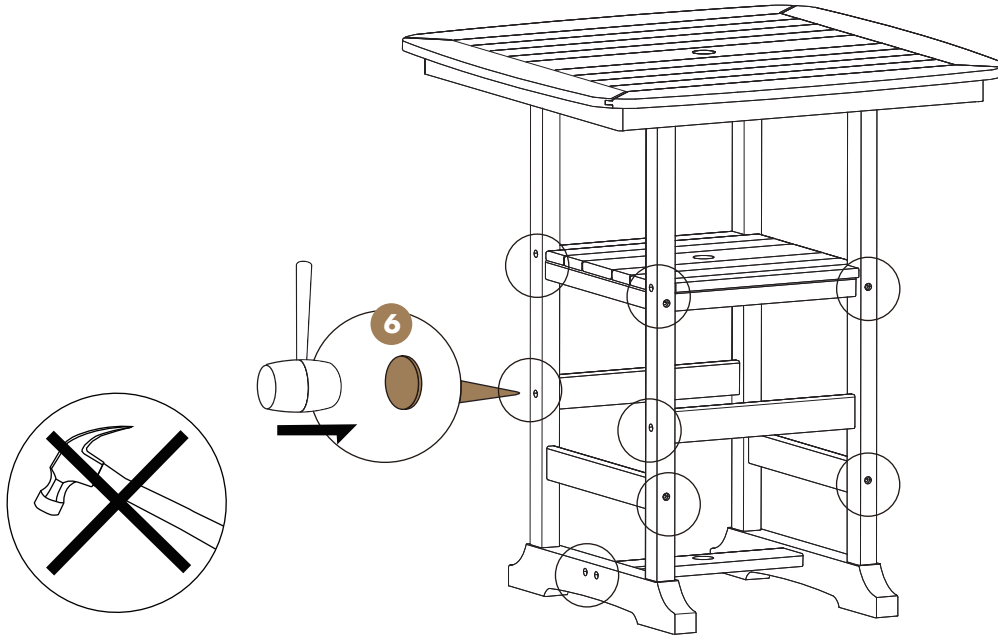

Step 8: Apply the Screw Hole Plugs

- Cover all exposed screw holes using **20 - Screw Hole Plug (#6)**. Insert all plugs into the exposed screw holes. Gently tap each plug into place using a rubber mallet to prevent damage. Ensure each plug is fully seated and flush with the table surface (see image below).

ATTENTION: Do not use a metal hammer as it will damage the poly lumber.



- **REGULAR CLEAN:** Mix **warm water** and **mild soap**. Use **a soft bristle brush** to gently scrub the surface and remove any dirt or stains.
- **QUICK CLEAN:** Simply wipe the furniture down using a damp cloth.

Tip: Cleaning your furniture regularly helps maintain its aesthetic appeal and extends its lifespan.
