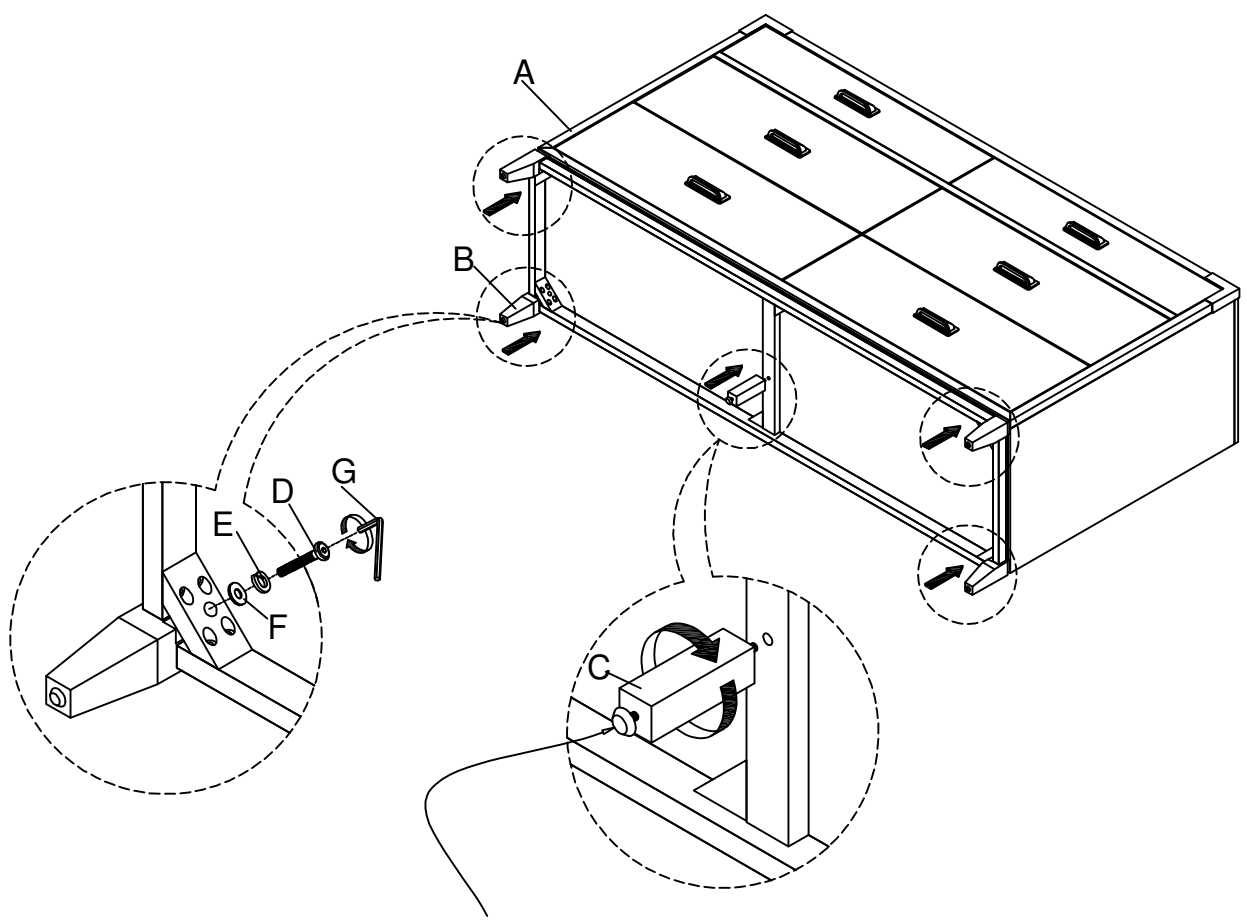
IMPORTANT NOTE:

1. Do not tighten all screws / bolts until all completely assembled.
2. Keep all hardware parts out of reach of children.

1 Take out the box of Leg (B) and hardware pack from the bottom drawer of Dresser (A).



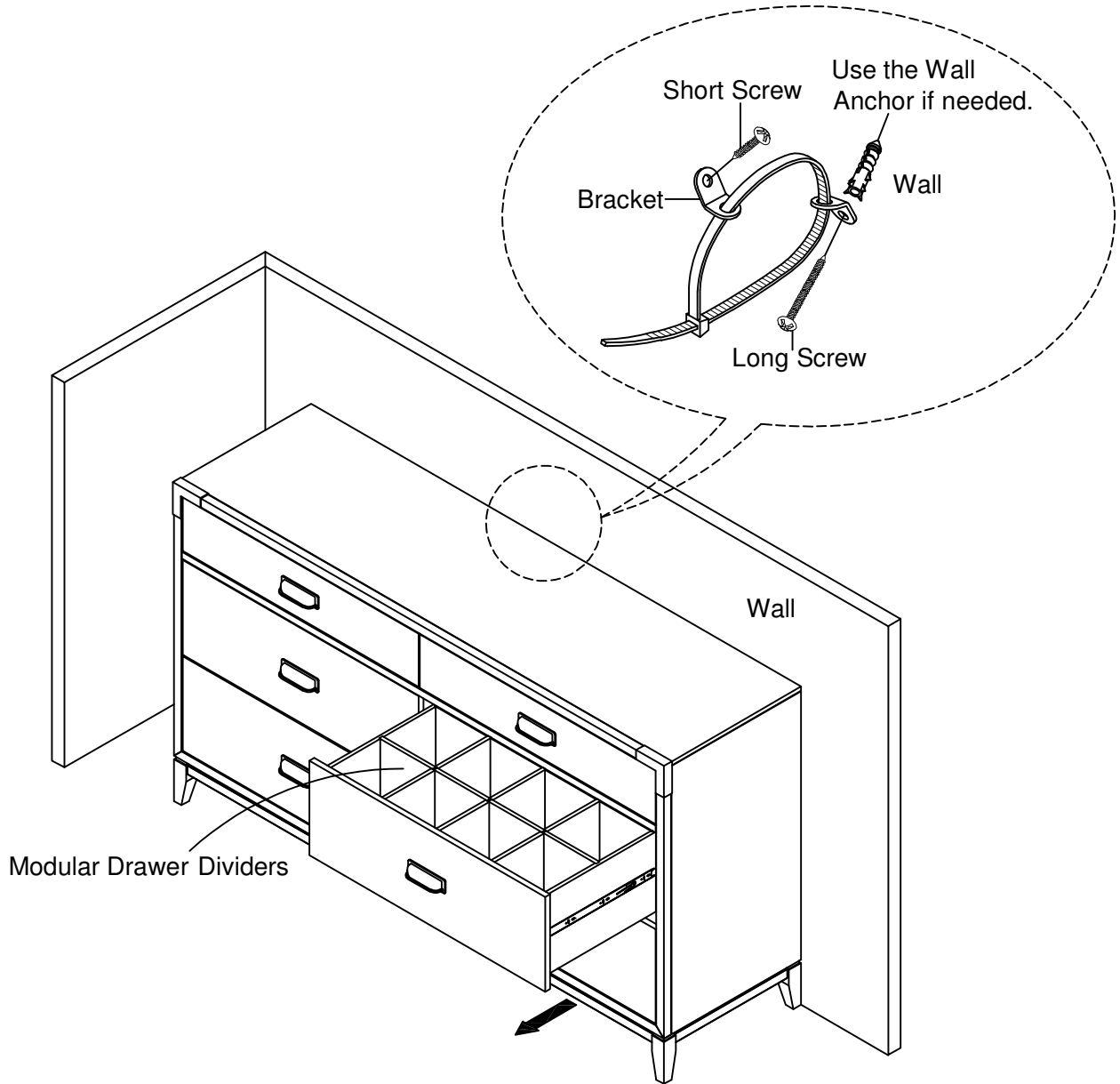
2 Attach Leg (B) to the Dresser (A) and tighten JCBC Bolt (D), Spring Washer (E) and Flat Washer (F) with Allen Key (G). Align and fasten the Support Leg (C) to Dresser (A).



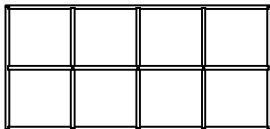
Adjust the Leveler if the Dresser is uneven.

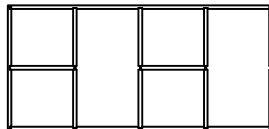
Attach Anti-Tipping Kit (H) to the wall. Attach the bracket (vertically) to the wall using the long screw provided. Attach the bracket (vertically) to the back of the furniture with the short screw provided. Place the bracket as close to the center of the back of the furniture as possible in relation to the wall stud and the desired position in the room. Move the furniture to its final position. Thread the strap through each bracket and pull it tight.



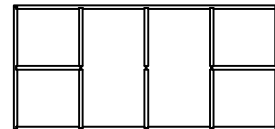

Cleaning & Care
