

Dispenser Quick Start Guide

Refer to Manufacturer's User Manual for more details.

Preparation

- 1. Refrigerate the Califia Farms product. It must be chilled to 41°F or below before loading into the dispenser.
- 2. Determine the dispenser installation location.
 - There must be a standard power outlet within 5 feet of the installation location.
 - There must be 22 inches of available counter width at the installation location. The dispenser is 16 inches wide and requires 3 inches of clearance on each side.
- 3. Inspect the dispenser box and document any damage.
- 4. Remove the dispenser box from the pallet.

Installation

- 1. Preserve the packaging until the dispenser is operating correctly.
- 2. Plug in the dispenser and turn on the power switch on the left side. Confirm that the "POWER" light on the front of the dispenser and the backlit display are illuminated.
- 3. Wait 1 hour for the dispenser to chill.
- 4. Confirm that the "READY" light is illuminated, and the thermometer reads 41°F or below before loading in product.
- 5. Refer to Manufacturer's User Manual for full installation details and product loading instructions.

Operations Advice

1. Ice Buildup

- Some ice buildup is normal. Removing ice after two weeks of operation is standard procedure. If ice is building up more quickly check to see if the door is correctly sealed and try to minimize the time during which the door is open.
- 2. Temperature Measurement
 - The best way to measure the temperature is to dispense some milk into a glass and measure the temperature with a quick-read thermometer. A thermometer in the dispenser cabinet does not accurately reflect the temperature of the milk.
- 3. Dispenser Ready Light
 - The dispenser measures its temperature electronically and fully illuminates the green "READY" light on the front of the dispenser when it measures below 41°F. The dispenser flashes the "READY" light when it measures between 42°F and 46°F.

4. Chill Product Before Loading

- Product must be chilled before loading into the dispenser. Cooling can take up to 2 days in the cooler.
- Please check the temperature of milk right after being loaded into the dispenser.
