
- 1** Assembling Middle Rail (D) to Leg (B), rotate Bolt (J) to Leg (B) Firstly, then attach Middle Rail (D) to Leg (B) through then Bolt (J). Next using Half Moon Nut (K) and Hex Nut (L) to lock with Bolt (J) by Spanner (M) as below shown.



- 2** Attach Side Rail (C) to Leg (B) & Middle Rail (D), using Bolt (F), Flat Washer (G) and Lock Washer (H) by Allen Key (I) as below shown.



- 3** Attach Leg (B) to Top (A), using Bolt (E), Flat Washer (G) and Lock Washer (H) by Allen Key (I) as below shown.



Cleaning & Care

Treat surface with care. Surface is resistant to scratches but is not scratch resistant. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.






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1 Attach the Front Leg (B) to Chair Body (A) with Lock Washer (D), Flat Washer (E) and Bolt (F) by Allen Key (H).



2 Attach the Back Leg (C) to Chair Body (A) with Lock Washer (D), Flat Washer (E) and Bolt (G) by Allen Key (H).

Stand chair up on an even surface and check that it is balanced. If there is a slight wobble, apply downward pressure in the corner where a leg is uneven. Keeping pressure in that corner, tighten all bolts. If balanced, apply downward pressure evenly in the center and tighten all bolts. Do not over-tighten beyond hole depth.



Helpful Tip:
-Instead of applying downward pressure while reaching under to tighten bolts, have someone sit in the chair while you tighten the bolts.

Put the bench (A) on a smooth flat surface, attached one leg (B) to the bench (A) use bolt (E), lock washer (C) and flat washer (D) on both of hole of bench. Turn the allen wrench (F) in bolt (E). But not too tight.

Take the Allen Wrench, and turn the bolts until the legs are secure.
DO NOT TIGHTEN COMPLETELY.
Stop when you feel you are adding force to tighten the bolt.



Stand chair up on an even surface and check that it is balanced.
If there is a slight wobble, apply downward pressure in the corner where a leg is uneven. Keeping pressure in that corner, tighten all bolts.
If balanced, apply downward pressure evenly in the center and tighten all bolts.
Do not over-tighten beyond hole depth.

Helpful Tip:

-Instead of applying downward pressure while reaching under to tighten bolts, have someone sit in the chair while you tighten the bolts.
