




Attach three part J upper hinge receivers to the part 1 base with six part C screws. Two screws per receiver.

Attach two part 2 base supports to the part 11 base with two part A screws.


Insert two part F dowels into the part 3 skirt, then attach the skirt to the part 1 base with two part A screws.




Attach two part M door catches to the part 10 long divider with four part C screws, two screws per door catch.

Flip the long divider and attach one part O shelf support with one part C screw.






Attach the part 12 sink back to part 11 & 13 sink sides with two part F dowels and two part A screws, and then slide the part 14 sink bottom.




Attach two part O shelf supports and one part M door catch to the part 15 short divider with four part C screws.

Flip the short divider and attach one part part M door catch with two part C screws.


Insert one part F dowel to the part 12 sink back, and then attach the sink assembly to the part 15 short divider with one part A screws.


Hammer three part L counter supports into the part 21 countertop, then secure with three part C screws.

Flip the countertop and attach the part R faucet with two part B screws.





Attach the part 21 counter top to the part 15 long divider with one part B screw and one part F dowel.


Insert three part F dowels to the part 21 countertop, then attach the countertop assembly to the part 10 long divider with one part A screw and two part B screws.

Slide in one part 22 short back panel between the part 10 & 5 dividers.


Insert four part F dowels to the part 1 base, then attach the base to the dividers with four part A screws.

Attach two part I upper hinges to the part 20 counter panel with four part C screws, two screws per hinge.

Hammer one part L counter supports into the part 20 counter panel, then secure with one part C screw.






Insert four part F dowels to the part 11 & 13 sink sides.

Insert one part F dowels to the part 15 short divider.


Insert one part F dowel to the part 20 counter panel, then attach the panel to the sink assembly with one part A screw and one part B screw.


Slide in one part 22 short back between the part 1 base and part 21 countertop.


Attach two part P bar holders to part S long bar, then attach the bar assembly to the part 23 lower shelf with two part B screws.

Insert two part F dowels to the part 23 upper shelf, then attach the shelf to the part 10 long divider with one part A screw.

Slide in the part 24 countertop back between the part 21 countertop and the part 23 upper shelf.






Insert two part G cam bolts to the part 26 hood strip.

Attach the part Q hood center to the part 27 hood bottom with two part D screws.

Insert two part H cam locks to the part 27 hood bottom, then attach the part 26 hood strip to the hood bottom.


NOTE: Use a screwdriver to turn the cam lock to secure the cam bolt.







Attach two part O shelf supports to the part 32 right side with two part C screws.





Insert six part F dowels to the hood assembly, then attach it between the part 25 upper mid panel and the part 32 right side with two part A screws.






Attach the right side assembly with eight part F dowels and seven part A screws.

Attach one part J upper hinge receiver to the part 5 espresso machine top with four part ${\bf C}$ screws.


Insert two part F dowels to the part 6 espresso machine front, then attach the panel and the part 7 spout with three part A screws.

Attach the part 8 microwave upper panel, the espresso machine assembly, and the part 35 tray with three part F dowels and three part A screws.


Slide in the part 16 refrigerator back between the part 4 espresso machine bottom and the part 1 base.





Attach one part N door insert and two part K hinge pegs to the part 34 micowave door with four part C screws.


Flip the door and attach two part P bar holders and the part W short bar with two part B screws.


Attach one part N door insert, two part K hinge pegs, and the part T ice dispenser to the part 17 refrigerator door with twelve part C screws.

Flip the door and attach two part P bar holders and the part S long bar with two part B screws.






Slide in the part 33 espresso machine back and the part 29 upper shelf back. Attach the part 34 micowave door and part 17 refrigerator door.

Insert three part F dowels to the part 30 top, then attach the panel to the part 31 top board with two part A screws.



Insert four part F dowels to the part 31 top board, then attach the board to the right section assembly with two part A screws.


Insert nine part F dowels to the part 9 left side, then attach the panel to the left section assembly with seven part A screws. (32)Ø Ø Ø S 0 0

Slide in the part 36 microwave back between the part 9 left side and the part 10 long divider.






Insert six **part F dowels** to the **part 38 mircowave top**, then attach the panel on top of the microwave assembly with four **part A screws**.





Attach one part N door insert and one part K hinge pegs to the part 18 sink cupboard door with four part C screws.

Flip the door and attach two part P bar holders and the part S long bar with two part B screws. Repeat the steps for the part 19 oven door.






Insert the hinge peg on the part 18 sink cupboard door into the opening on the part 20 counter panel. Insert one part K hinge peg into the opening on the part 1 base, and secure to the part 18 cupboard door with two part C screws. Repeat the steps for the part 19 oven door.

Attach two part X burners and the part 37 oven rack into the stove.


WALL MOUNTING: Combine the part E wall nail, part U wall spacer, and part V wall anchor and use a hammer to drive the nail into the wall through the opening on the part 36 microwave back.





Attach two part J upper hinge receivers to the part 39 island base with four part C screws, two screws per receiver.


Flip the base and then insert four part G cam bolts.


Attach one part M door catch and two part O shelf support to the part 45 island divider with four part C screw.

Flip the divider and attach another one part M door catch and one part O shelf support to the part 45 island divider with three part C screws.





Hammer one part L counter support into the part 41 island left back, then secure with one part C screw. Repeat the step for the part 42 island right back.






Attach the part 41 & 42 island backs to the part 39 island base with two part F dowels and two part A screws.


Attach the part 45 island divider to the part 39 island base with two part F dowels and two part A screws.






Attach two part 40 island skirts to the bottom of the part 39 island base with six part F dowels and four part H cam locks.


NOTE: Use a screwdriver to turn the cam lock to secure the cam bolt.







Secure two part B screws to the part 45 island divider.




Insert three part G cam bolts into the part 44 island left side, then attach two part O shelf support with two part C screws. Repeat the step for part 46 island right side.


Flip the part 46 island right side attach two part P bar holders and the part S long bar with two part B screws.



Attach two part 44 island left side to the part 41 island left back and the part 1 island base with four part F dowels and four part H cam locks. Repeat the step on the other side for the part 46 island right side.

NOTE: Use a screwdriver to turn the cam lock to secure the cam bolt.








Attach two part J upper hinge receivers to the part 47 island top with four part C screws, two screws per receiver.

Hammer one part L counter support into the part 47 island top, then secure with one part C screw.


Insert four part G cam bolts into the part 47 island top.

Attach two part 47 island top to the part 44 island left side, part 45 island divider, and part 46 right side with seven part F dowels, four part H cam locks, and one part B screw.


NOTE: Use a screwdriver to turn the cam lock to secure the cam bolt.





Attach one part N door insert and one part K hinge peg to the part 48 island left door with four part C screws.


Flip the door and attach two part P bar holders and the part S long bar with two part B screws. Repeat the steps for the part 49 island right door.





Insert the hinge peg on the part 48 island left door into the opening on the part 47 island top. Insert one part K hinge peg into the opening on the part 39 island base, and secure to the part 48 island left door with two part C screws. Repeat the steps for the part 49 island right door.

Attach two part 43 island shelves into the island.
