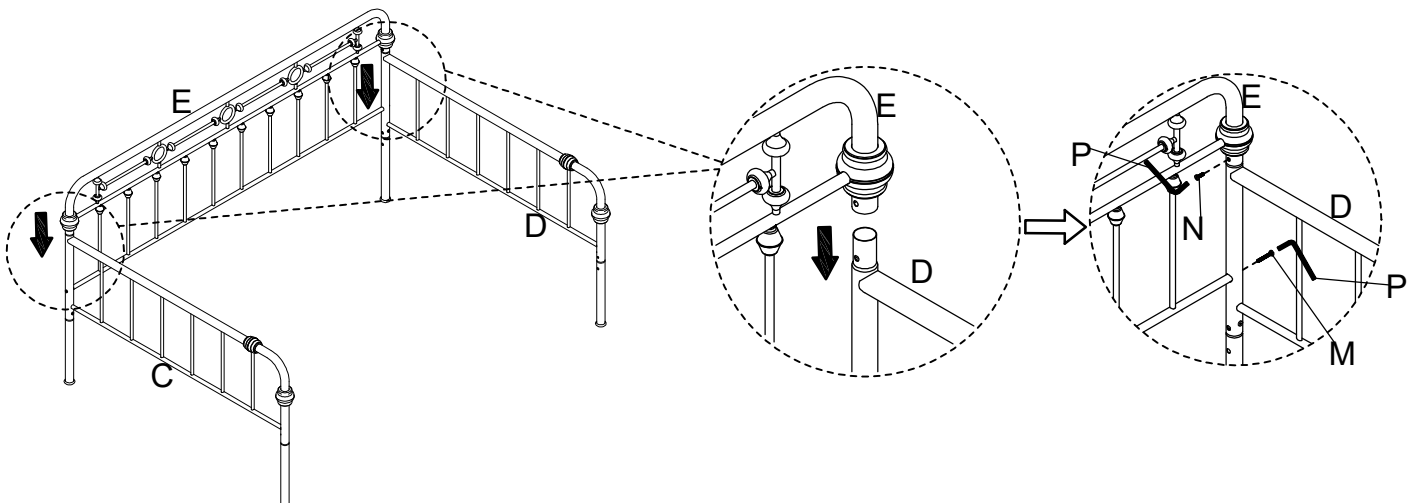
Attach Left Arm Post Leg (A) & Right Arm Post Leg (B) into the Lsf Arm (C), insert the Bolt (N), turn the L-Allen Key (P) to tighten them.

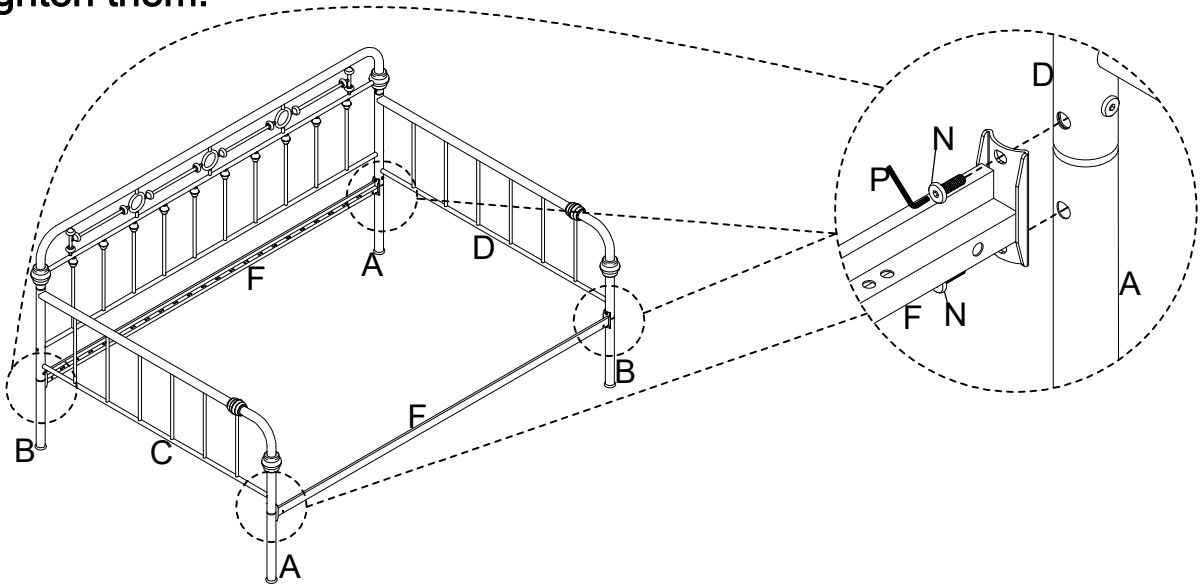
Attach Left Arm Post Leg (A) & Right Arm Post Leg (B) into the Rsf Arm (D), insert the Bolt (N), turn the L-Allen Key (P) to tighten them.

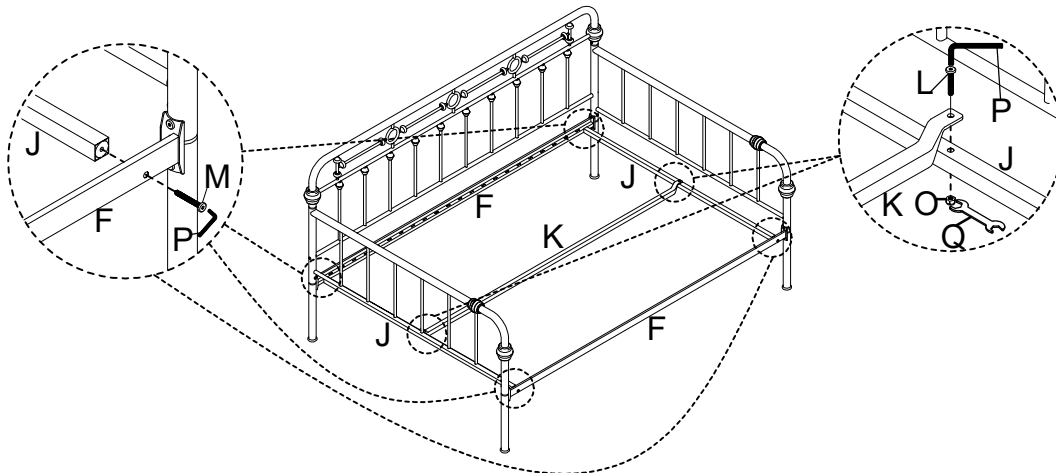
Attach the Back Frame (E) into the Lsf Arm (C) and Rsf Arm (D), insert the Bolt (M) and the Bolt (N), turn the L-Allen Key (P) to tighten them.



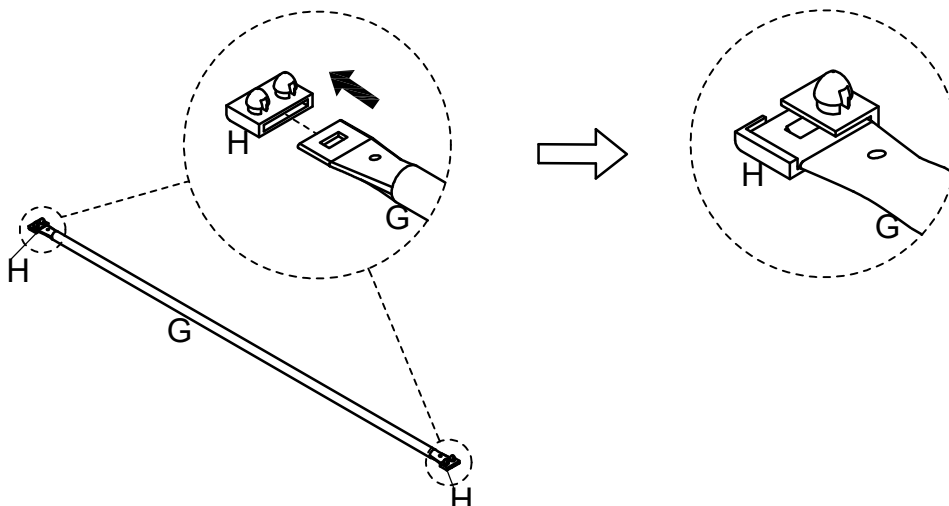
- 4** Attach Rail (F) to the Lsf Arm (C) and the Rsf Arm (D), Left Arm Post Leg (A) & Right Arm Post Leg (B), insert the Bolt (N), turn the L-Allen Key (P) to tighten them.



- 5** Attach the Lsf / Rsf Support Bar (J) to the Rail (F), insert the Bolt (M), turn the L-Allen Key (P) to tighten them. Attach the Center Support Bar (K) to the Lsf / Rsf Support Bar (J), insert the Bolt (L) and Nut (O), turn the L-Allen Key (P) and the Wrench (Q) to tighten them.

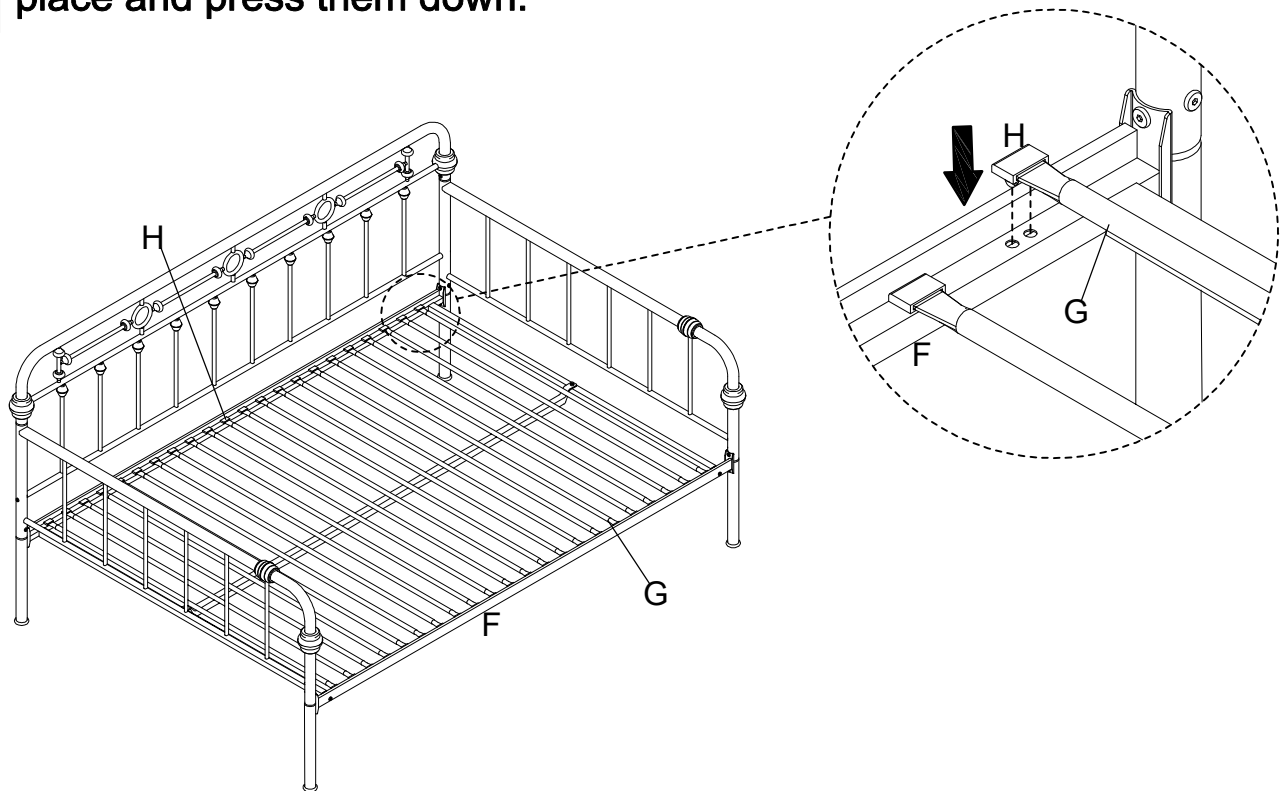


- 6** Insert the Slat Connector (H) to the both sides of Slat (G), press the Slat (G) into the correct place.



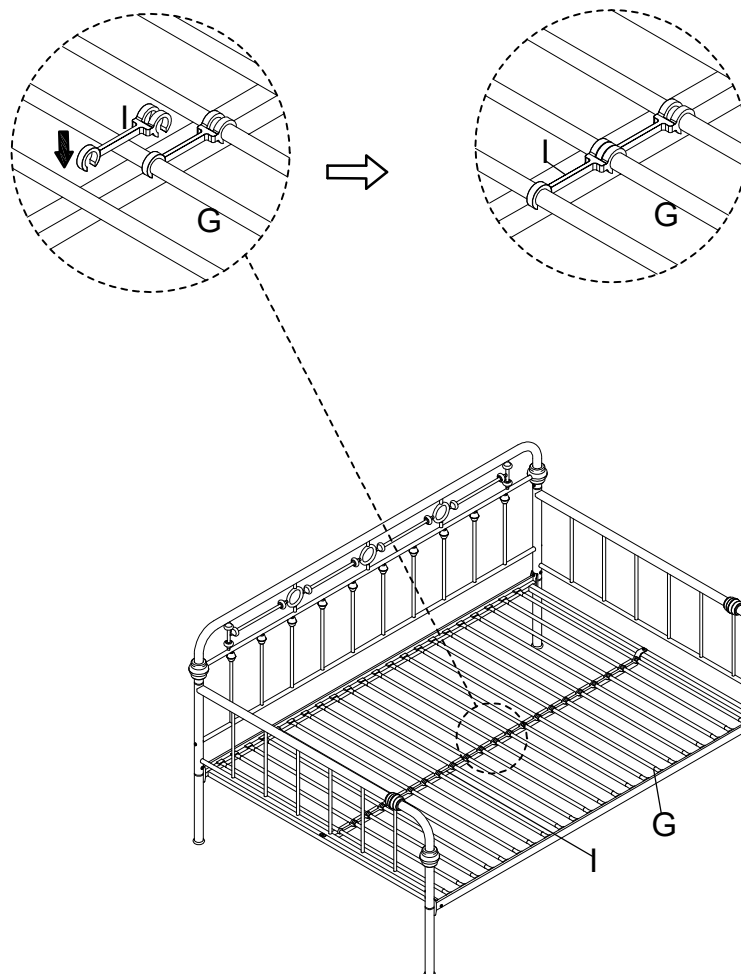

Make the Spacer (I) to connect two slats as below instruction.












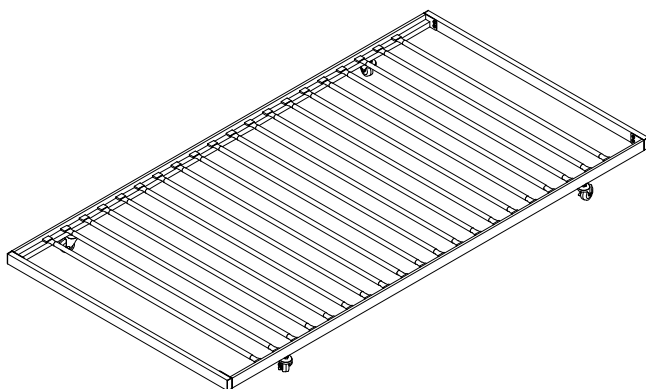
Cleaning & Care

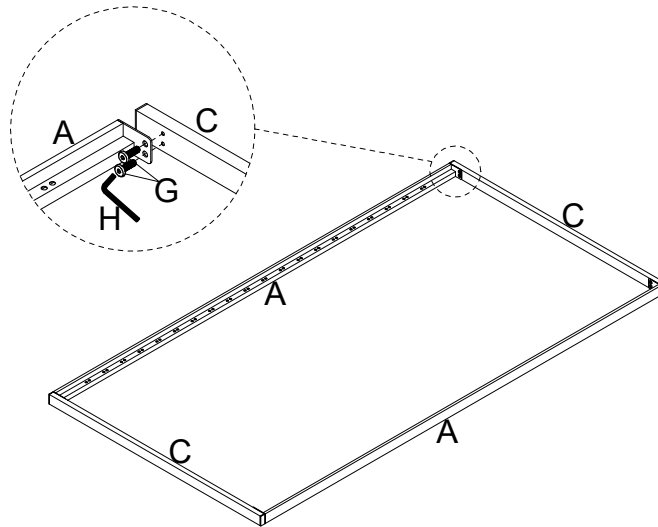

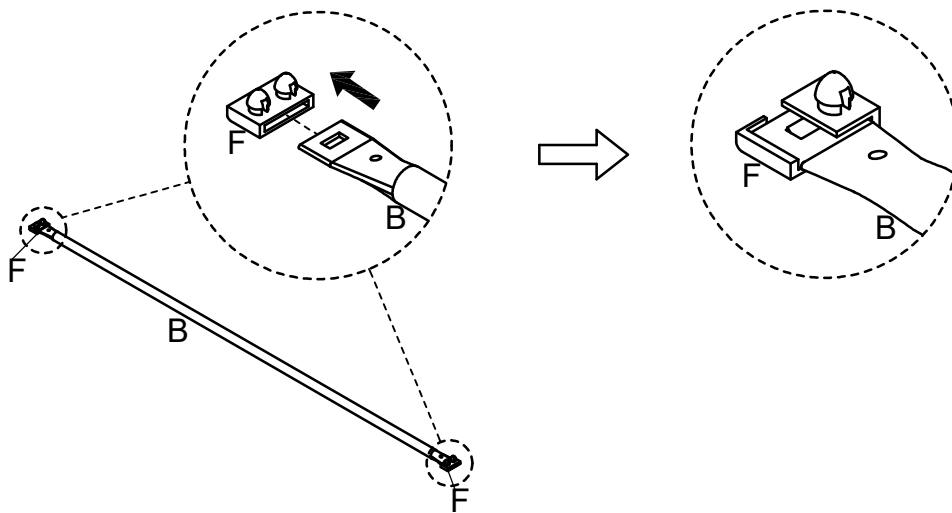

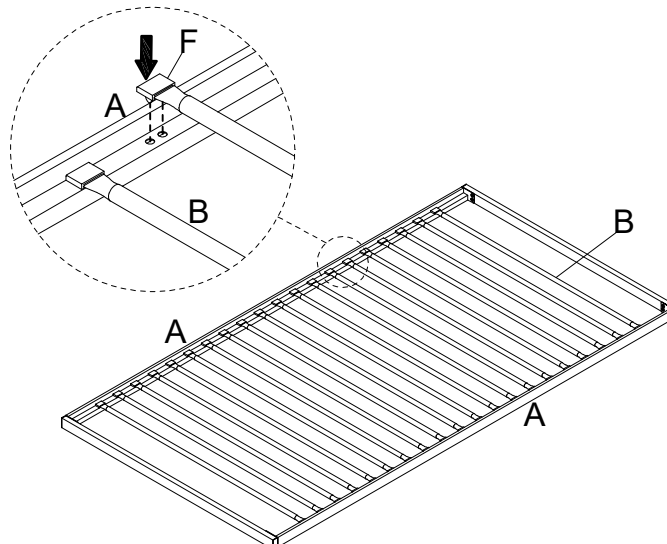
Attach the Long Rail (A) to the Short Rail (C), insert the Bolt (G), turn the L-Allen Key (H) to tighten them.

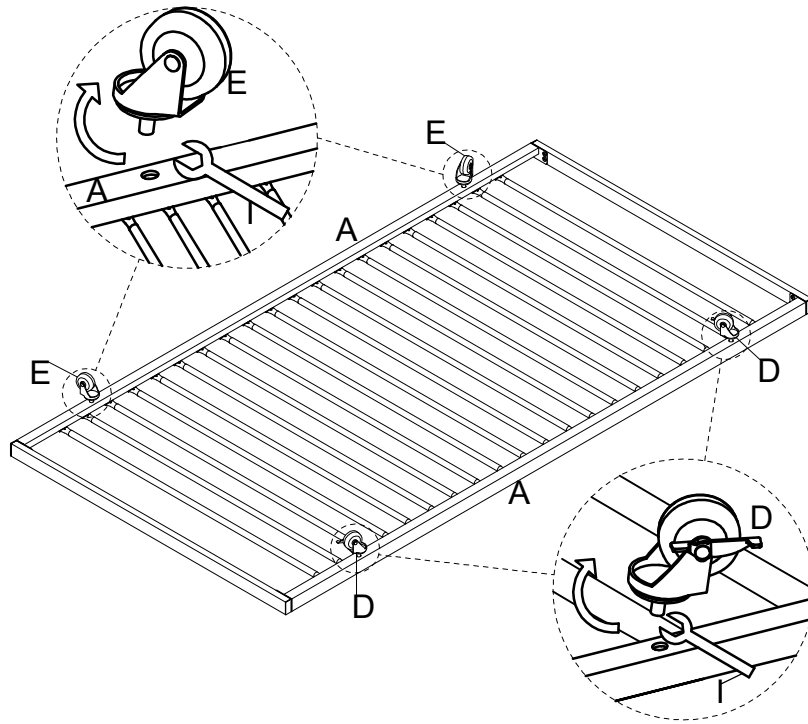
Insert the Slat Connector (F) to the both sides of Slat (B), press the Slat (B) into the correct place.

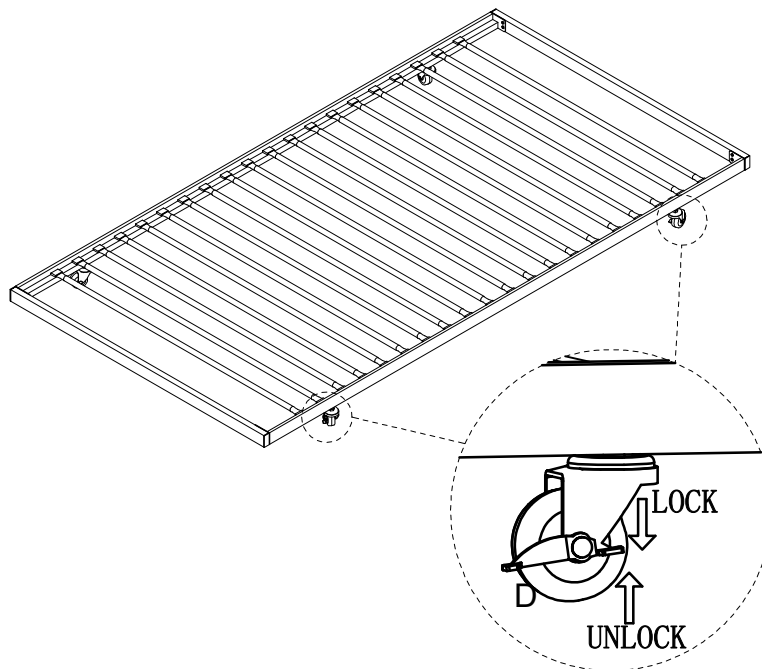
Attached the Slat (B) to the rails, put the Slat Connector (F) into the correct place and press them down.



- 4** Turn over the assembled trundle. Attach the Wheel (E) to one side of Long Rail (A), turn the Wrench (I) to tighten them. Attach the Lock Wheel (D) to another side of Long Rail (A), turn the Wrench (I) to tighten them.



- 5** Turn over the assembled trundle. Press the lock button of Lock Wheel (D), and the trundle will not move. Release the lock button, and the trundle will move.
